

Isaiah 51

King James Version (KJV)

(Smarten up. Listen to God's advice)

51 Hearken to me, ye that follow after righteousness, ye that seek the LORD: look unto the rock whence ye are hewn, and to the hole of the pit whence ye are digged. (God is righteousness; follow Him)

(Jesus Christ is the Rock on which our faith stands. It is never shaken nor moved; even in the most tumultuous of times) Deuteronomy-32:4, Deuteronomy-32:31

²Look unto Abraham your father, and unto Sarah that bare you: for I called him alone, and blessed him, and increased him. (Sarah was 90 & Abraham was 100 when they had Isaac. Isaac = laughter)

(God made a covenant with Abraham. HE changed their names from Abram and Sarai to Abraham and Sarah. HE blessed them greatly because they remained faithful to Him for all of their lives)

³For the LORD shall comfort Zion: he will comfort all her waste places; and he will make her wilderness like Eden, and her desert like the garden of the LORD; joy and gladness shall be found therein, thanksgiving, and the voice of melody. (On the Lord's Day)

⁴Hearken unto me, my people; and give ear unto me, O my nation: for a law shall proceed from me, and I will make my judgment to rest for a light of the people. (The law is the Ten Commandments; rest = Sabbath <Hebrew>; Jesus is the light of the world)

John-8:12 (Jesus said – "I am the light of the world.")

(Jesus is God in the flesh. I AM = Yah <Hebrew>; that is God's name, short for Yahoveh = I AM That I Am) see Exodus-3:14

⁵My righteousness is near; my salvation is gone forth, and mine arms shall judge the people; the isles shall wait upon me, and on mine arm shall they trust. (God's righteousness is the Lord Jesus Christ. We will trust in God's wisdom to judge us fairly and righteously)

⁶Lift up your eyes to the heavens, and look upon the earth beneath: for the heavens shall vanish away like smoke, and the earth shall wax old like a garment, and they that dwell therein shall die in like manner: but my salvation shall be for ever, and my righteousness

shall not be abolished. (In the Third Age, the earth and heavens will change. All will be rejuvenated) Revelation-20

(At the beginning of the Millennium, all flesh will die instantly. We will all be changed back into our spiritual bodies) 1Corinthians-15:49-54

⁷Hearken unto me, ye that know righteousness, the people in whose heart is my law; fear ye not the reproach of men, neither be ye afraid of their revilings. (men = enosh – flesh men)

(To those who love and follow God – don't fear flesh men or their threats. Stay true to God and do what is right)

⁸For the moth shall eat them up like a garment, and the worm shall eat them like wool: but my righteousness shall be for ever, and my salvation from generation to generation. (The flesh will pass away; but God lives forever)

⁹Awake, awake, put on strength, O arm of the LORD; awake, as in the ancient days, in the generations of old. Art thou not it that hath cut Rahab, and wounded the dragon? (Rahab- means insolence, pride; it usually refers to Egypt and the Arabs)

(The dragon – a Nile crocodile; this again refers to Egypt. Also, Satan is called that old dragon in Revelation)

¹⁰Art thou not it which hath dried the sea, the waters of the great deep; that hath made the depths of the sea a way for the ransomed to pass over? (God parted the Red Sea to protect Moses and the Israelites, when He freed them from Pharaoh. HE then used the same Red Sea to destroy the Egyptian army that was pursuing them)

¹¹Therefore the redeemed of the LORD shall return, and come with singing unto Zion; and everlasting joy shall be upon their head: they shall obtain gladness and joy; and sorrow and mourning shall flee away. (On the Lord's Day – the good people will be rewarded. The evil ones will be gone forever, after Judgment Day)

¹²I, even I, am he that comforteth you: who art thou, that thou shouldest be afraid of a man that shall die, and of the son of man which shall be made as grass; (Man = enosh <Hebrew>; the flesh man is mortal, like the grass)

(The second word man = Adam <Hebrew>; he shall also die in the flesh, just like the grass)

(The Comforter is the Holy Spirit of God Himself. After God <as Jesus> ascended back into heaven, He came back to us as the Comforter <the Holy Spirit>; to help us and to guide us in our daily lives) John-14:26, Act-1:8

¹³ And forgettest the LORD thy maker, that hath stretched forth the heavens, and laid the foundations of the earth; and hast feared continually every day because of the fury of the oppressor, as if he were ready to destroy? and where is the fury of the oppressor? (The oppressor is the antichrist <Satan>)

(People fear Satan and forget all about God. God made everything including Satan. HE only allows Satan to test us while we are in this world. God will end Satan when his task is done. Almighty God doesn't fear anyone or anything; including Satan)

¹⁴ The captive exile hasteneth that he may be loosed, and that he should not die in the pit, nor that his bread should fail. (If you follow Jesus, and live by His Word, you will escape the pit; and he that goes into the pit <Satan>) see Zechariah-9:11

NOTE: (Zechariah-9:9 - the First Advent; Zechariah-9:10 - the Second Advent)

¹⁵ But I am the LORD thy God, that divided the sea, whose waves roared: The LORD of hosts is his name. (God created all of nature. He can control it as He chooses. God divided the Red Sea for Moses and the Israelites to cross over; when HE freed them from Egypt)

¹⁶ And I have put my words in thy mouth, and I have covered thee in the shadow of mine hand, that I may plant the heavens, and lay the foundations of the earth, and say unto Zion, Thou art my people. (God chose Abraham and his progeny <Israel> to bring forth Jesus Christ <God in the flesh>)

¹⁷ Awake, awake, stand up, O Jerusalem, which hast drunk at the hand of the LORD the cup of his fury; thou hast drunken the dregs of the cup of trembling, and wrung them out. (This cup of God's wrath will be poured out upon the unfaithful and on the Kenites, at the 7th Trump)

(This is the cup that Jesus asked that it should pass from Him, just before the crucifixion. They murdered Jesus on the cross. And now they will drink the cup of God's wrath)

¹⁸ There is none to guide her among all the sons whom she hath brought forth; neither is there any that taketh her by the hand of all the sons that she hath brought up. (This is speaking of Jerusalem)

(Jerusalem will become the center of Satan's one world system in the end days. He will set up his throne there; and the whole world will worship him as if he was Jesus. That is known as the Great Apostasy)

¹⁹ These two things are come unto thee; who shall be sorry for thee? desolation, and destruction, and the famine, and the sword: by whom shall I comfort thee? (Without God, they live in confusion, violence and crime)

Amos-8:11-12 (The famine of the end days is for hearing the Word of God)

²⁰ Thy sons have fainted, they lie at the head of all the streets, as a wild bull in a net: they are full of the fury of the LORD, the rebuke of thy God.

²¹ Therefore hear now this, thou afflicted, and drunken, but not with wine: (They are drunken on false religion and on the ways of the world)

²² Thus saith thy Lord the LORD, and thy God that pleadeth the cause of his people, Behold, I have taken out of thine hand the cup of trembling, even the dregs of the cup of my fury; thou shalt no more drink it again: (the LORD = Yahoveh <Hebrew>)

(This will happen when Christ returns as King of kings, LORD of lords)
Zechariah-14

²³ But I will put it into the hand of them that afflict thee; which have said to thy soul, Bow down, that we may go over: and thou hast laid thy body as the ground, and as the street, to them that went over. (They walked over you for the last time. God will avenge the righteous people on the evil ones <the Kenites>)
