- ²Send thee help from the sanctuary, and strengthen thee out of Zion;
- ³ Remember all thy offerings, and <u>accept</u> thy burnt sacrifice; Selah. (accept- turn to ashes)
- ⁴Grant thee according to thine own heart, and fulfill all thy counsel.
- ⁵ We will rejoice in thy salvation, and in the name of our God we will set up our <u>banners</u>: the LORD fulfill all thy petitions. Our <u>banner-> see</u> Isaiah-9:22
- ⁶ Now know I that the LORD saveth his anointed; he will hear him from his holy heaven with the saving strength of his right hand.
- ⁷Some trust in chariots, and some in horses: but we will remember the name of the LORD our God. (David faced Goliath, and won with God's help)
- *They are brought down and fallen: but we are risen, and stand upright.
- Save, LORD: let the king hear us when we call. (aka- God save the king)
