

Matthew 22

King James Version (KJV)

22 And Jesus answered and spake unto them again by parables, and said,

²The kingdom of heaven is like unto a certain king, which made a marriage for his son,

³And sent forth his servants to call them that were bidden to the wedding: and they would not come. (The prophets were sent early – during the Old Testament)

⁴Again, he sent forth other servants, saying, Tell them which are bidden, Behold, I have prepared my dinner: my oxen and my fatlings are killed, and all things are ready: come unto the marriage. (Jesus' apostles were sent later – during the New Testament)

⁵But they made light of it, and went their ways, one to his farm, another to his merchandise: (They were too busy working in the ways of the world to care about God)

⁶And the remnant took his servants, and entreated them spitefully, and slew them. (The remnant as written of here, are the Kenites. They continually try to spoil God's salvation message. They killed as many of God's prophets and His disciples as they could get their hands on)

NOTE: (Today, this could be the falling of the Christian nations to atheists, agnostics and Muslims. The Kenites are always working behind the scene; pulling the strings)

⁷But when the king heard thereof, he was wroth: and he sent forth his armies, and destroyed those murderers, and burned up their city. (This could be the falling of Israel to the Babylonians and to the Assyrians; and later, the destruction of Jerusalem by the Romans)

(Today, it is the Christian nations falling to atheism, communism, sexual perversion, abortion and socialism)

⁸Then saith he to his servants, The wedding is ready, but they which were bidden were not worthy. Revelation-19:7-9 (Many so-called Christians don't know anything about God's Word. They sit in Christian churches and listen to traditions of men; instead of learning the Word of God; chapter by chapter, verse by verse)

⁹Go ye therefore into the highways, and as many as ye shall find, bid to the marriage. (Whosoever will believe in Jesus) John-3:16, Revelation-19:7-9

¹⁰So those servants went out into the highways, and gathered together all as many as they found, both bad and good: and the wedding was furnished with guests. (The bad are also invited; after they have repented and get right with God)

¹¹And when the king came in to see the guests, he saw there a man which had not on a wedding garment: (This is a fake Christian, a hypocrite who tried to sneak in)

(These would be the false Christian preachers who pretend to be sent by God, but never teach His Word. Instead, they teach traditions of men and beg for tithes. It's also the Christian people who attended those churches and ended up worshipping the antichrist)

¹²And he saith unto him, Friend, how camest thou in hither not having a wedding garment? And he was speechless. (He was a holier than thou believer, or a false preacher, pretending to be a real Christian)

(They are usually in it for the money or for the status. They have no righteous acts to their name. These are also people who choose political correctness instead of moral correctness)

¹³Then said the king to the servants, Bind him hand and foot, and take him away, and cast him into outer darkness, there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth. (He didn't make the first resurrection, when Messiah returns)

¹⁴For many are called, but few are chosen. (All people are called <who so ever will>. The Elect were chosen in the First Age; because they sided with God against Satan, when he rebelled) see Revelation-12

¹⁵Then went the Pharisees, and took counsel how they might entangle him in his talk. (They were always plotting to stab Jesus in the back. They wanted to hang Him with His own words)

NOTE: (Imagine the ego and the arrogance to think that they could outsmart God. It's ridiculous)

¹⁶And they sent out unto him their disciples with the Herodians, saying, Master, we know that thou art true, and teachest the way of

God in truth, neither carest thou for any man: for thou regardest not the person of men. (The Herodians were the politicians. They were trying to play on Jesus' ego. Ironically, they were telling the truth about Jesus)

¹⁷ Tell us therefore, What thinkest thou? Is it lawful to give tribute unto Caesar, or not? (This is how Satan works; first the flattery, then the trap)

¹⁸ But Jesus perceived their wickedness, and said, Why tempt ye me, ye hypocrites? (Hypocrites in the Greek means – play actors. They are pretending to be followers of Jesus; so that they can get close enough to Him; in order to set Him up against the Romans)

¹⁹ Shew me the tribute money. And they brought unto him a penny.

²⁰ And he saith unto them, Whose is this image and superscription?

²¹ They say unto him, Caesar's. Then saith he unto them, Render therefore unto Caesar the things which are Caesar's; and unto God the things that are God's. (Stay legal to your government, so that you will remain free. That will allow you can teach the Word of God, which deals with spirituality and salvation)

Ezekiel-18:4 (Behold, all souls are mine; as the soul of the father, so also the soul of the son is mine: the soul that sinneth, it shall die)

²² When they had heard these words, they marvelled, and left him, and went their way. (They were stupid enough to try to outsmart God. Did they learn anything from the experience? No. They will continue to plot in order to murder Him)

²³ The same day came to him the Sadducees, which say that there is no resurrection, and asked him, (Sadducees didn't believe in life after death)

²⁴ Saying, Master, Moses said, If a man die, having no children, his brother shall marry his wife, and raise up seed unto his brother.

²⁵ Now there were with us seven brethren: and the first, when he had married a wife, deceased, and, having no issue, left his wife unto his brother: (having no issue = having no children)

(They are trying to confuse Jesus with a riddle about life after death – which they don't even believe in. This must have been very offensive to Jesus)

²⁶ Likewise the second also, and the third, unto the seventh.

²⁷ And last of all the woman died also.

²⁸ Therefore in the resurrection whose wife shall she be of the seven? for they all had her. (The Sadducees don't even believe in an afterlife. They are trying to set Jesus up with a ridiculous riddle)

²⁹ Jesus answered and said unto them, Ye do err, not knowing the scriptures, nor the power of God.

³⁰ For in the resurrection they neither marry, nor are given in marriage, but are as the angels of God in heaven. (Rather than rebuking them for being the idiots that they are, Jesus decided to teach them something. Will they learn anything? Probably not)

³¹ But as touching the resurrection of the dead, have ye not read that which was spoken unto you by God, saying,

³² I am the God of Abraham, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob? God is not the God of the dead, but of the living. (No one has died yet. No one will die not until Judgment Day; after the Millennium)

Ecclesiastes-12:6-7 (Or ever the silver cord be loosed, or the golden bowl be broken, or the pitcher be broken at the fountain, or the wheel broken at the cistern. Then shall the dust return to the earth as it was: and the spirit shall return unto God who gave it)

³³ And when the multitude heard this, they were astonished at his doctrine. (They should have known this had they read the scriptures. They were Biblically illiterate; probably because they learned nothing from the corrupt temple priests)

³⁴ But when the Pharisees had heard that he had put the Sadducees to silence, they were gathered together. (Now they are going to try to trip Jesus up)

³⁵ Then one of them, which was a lawyer, asked him a question, tempting him, and saying,

³⁶ Master, which is the great commandment in the law?

³⁷ Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind.

³⁸ This is the first and great commandment. (10 Commandments 1-5 covers our relationship with God)

³⁹ And the second is like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. (10 Commandments 6-10 covers our relationship with man)

⁴⁰ On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets. (Jesus covered all Ten Commandments in two verses)

⁴¹ While the Pharisees were gathered together, Jesus asked them,

⁴² Saying, What think ye of Christ? whose son is he? They say unto him, the son of David. Isaiah-53:43

⁴³ He saith unto them, How then doth David in spirit call him Lord, saying,

⁴⁴ The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit thou on my right hand, till I make thine enemies thy footstool? (LORD = YHVH = Yahoveh – properly translated) (my Lord = Jesus Christ) see Psalms-110:1-7

NOTE: (Jesus is God in human flesh form. There is one God. HE has many offices: Yahoveh <the Father, the Creator>, Jesus <the Savior, the Teacher>, Holy Spirit <the Comforter>, Melchizedek <the Chief Priest, King of the just>, Angel of the Lord <God the Messenger>)

⁴⁵ If David then call him Lord, how is he his son? (His begotten – better translation)

Luke-3 (God came into the flesh life through Mary's womb. HE was born and died in the flesh, just like we do. HIS lineage as a flesh man descended through the seed line of David, through Mary)

⁴⁶ And no man was able to answer him a word, neither durst any man from that day forth ask him any more questions. (Since they can't outsmart Jesus, they will now resort to lies and false witnesses. They intend to have Jesus prosecuted and executed by the Romans – whatever it takes. Pathetic religious community, ready to commit murder)
