- **2** Why do the <u>heathen</u> rage, and the people <u>imagine</u> a vain thing? (heathen= nations)(rage- in their assemblies)(Imagine= meditate)
- ²The kings of the earth set themselves, and the rulers take counsel together, against the LORD, and against his anointed, saying, (They seek council from each other, not from God)
- ³Let us break their bands asunder, and cast away their cords from us. (Working to destroy Christianity) (Christians need to stay clear of their drama and their chains)
- ⁴He that sitteth in the heavens shall laugh: the LORD shall have them in derision.
- ⁵Then shall he speak unto them in his wrath, and <u>vex</u> them in his sore displeasure. (vex- trouble) (When Jesus returns)
- ⁶Yet have I set my king upon my holy hill of Zion. (When Jesus returns)
- ⁷I will declare the decree: the LORD hath said unto me, Thou art my Son; this day have I begotten thee. Matthew-3:17, Acts-13:33
- *Ask of me, and I shall give thee the heathen for thine inheritance, and the uttermost parts of the earth for thy possession.
- ⁹Thou shalt break them with a rod of iron; thou shalt dash them in pieces like a potter's vessel. Revelation-2:27
- ¹⁰ Be wise now therefore, O ye kings: be instructed, ye judges of the earth. (Learn the word of God, before it is too late) (Judge morally, not by precedent)
- ¹¹ Serve the LORD with <u>fear</u>, and rejoice with <u>trembling</u>. (fear-reverence) (Trembling meekly)
- ¹² <u>Kiss the Son</u>, lest he be angry, and ye perish from the way, when his wrath is kindled but a little. Blessed are all they that put their trust in him. (Show your love for Jesus)
