

Isaiah 4

King James Version (KJV)

(Isaiah - means Yahoveh's salvation)

4 And in that day seven women shall take hold of one man, saying, We will eat our own bread, and wear our own apparel: only let us be called by thy name, to take away our reproach. (This is prophecy for the end days. The 7 women are the 7 thousand Elect, who take the name of Christ – they are called Christians. The true Christians are the spiritual wife of Our Lord Jesus Christ. HE is the Living Word, the bread of life) see Revelation-19:6-9, John-6:35

(And the gospel armor is our apparel) see Ephesians-6:10-20

(In the end days, the Elect won't partake of the bread of the world, nor wear the apparel of the world. They will become a hated minority in the eyes of the world; but they will be loved by God)

²In that day shall the branch of the LORD be beautiful and glorious, and the fruit of the earth shall be excellent and comely for them that are escaped of Israel. (The branch of the Lord is Jesus Christ, returning at the Second Advent)

(They escaped the hour of temptation by antichrist, because they had the true Word of God in their minds. They know who antichrist truly is. They are not tempted in the least by him) see Ezekiel-33:21

³And it shall come to pass, that he that is left in Zion, and he that remaineth in Jerusalem, shall be called holy, even every one that is written among the living in Jerusalem: (Spiritually living; those who remain faithful to Christ will be rewarded with eternal life with God)

⁴When the Lord shall have washed away the filth of the daughters of Zion, and shall have purged the blood of Jerusalem from the midst thereof by the spirit of judgment, and by the spirit of burning. See 2Thesalonians-2:8 (Jesus, as Messiah, will end the antichrist's rule)

⁵And the LORD will create upon every dwelling place of mount Zion, and upon her assemblies, a cloud and smoke by day, and the shining of a flaming fire by night: for upon all the glory shall be a defense. (defense = a canopy, a covering – bad translation)

(This is just like God did for Moses and Israel, in the wilderness, when they left Egypt. They had a cloud of shade from the desert sun by day; and a pillar of fire for light and protection by night)

⁶And there shall be a tabernacle for a shadow in the day time from the heat, and for a place of refuge, and for a covert from storm and from rain. (God protects His people)
