Mark 12

King James Version (KJV)

12 And he began to speak unto them by parables. A certain man planted <u>a vineyard</u>, and set an hedge about it, and digged a place for the winefat, and built a tower, <u>and let it out to husbandmen</u>, and went into a far country. (This parable is about God and His kingdom <the vineyard>. The man who planted it is God. The grapes wine that is produced is the Word of God)

(The husbandmen are the priests that are supposed to be tending the vineyard, producing wine and making a profit. The profit is the souls that are taught the Word of God and become Christians)

(Over the years, the priests became corrupt. In Jesus' time, they were the corrupt Pharisees and Sadducees) See Isaiah-5

²And at the season he sent to the husbandmen a <u>servant</u>, that he might receive from the husbandmen of the fruit of the vineyard. (These servants are the prophets. The vineyard is in this world)

NOTE: (This is a sharecropping example – the husbandmen do the work and get 2/3 of the profit. The land owner provides the seed and the land and gets 1/3 of the profit)

- ³ And they caught him, and beat him, and sent him away empty. (Reneging on their agreement; the husbandmen are liars and thieves)
- ⁴And again he sent unto them another servant; and at him they cast stones, and wounded him in the head, and sent him away shamefully handled.
- ⁵ And again he sent another; and him they killed, and many others; beating some, and killing some. (These sent servants are all the prophets in the Old Testament. John the Baptist, in the New Testament, was the last prophet, before Messiah. They beheaded him)
- ⁶ Having yet therefore <u>one son, his wellbeloved</u>, he sent him also last unto them, saying, They will reverence my son. (My Begotten this is Jesus Christ)
- ⁷But those husbandmen said among themselves, <u>This is the heir;</u> come, let us kill him, and the inheritance shall be ours.' (Jesus is God

in the flesh – the Begotten One through Mary. God came into the flesh, as Jesus, as the savior of the world)

*And they took him, and killed him, and cast him out of the vineyard. (They knew who Jesus was. They sealed their fate when they murdered Him. They thought that they had defeated Jesus. They thought that they could just go back to doing their commerce in the temple and continue their corruption)

NOTE: (Satan thinks he can pull this off and be the messiah. He already has most of the world eating out of his hand. He will get the remainder in the end days when he comes as antichrist. He will still lose. God and the Elect will destroy his one world system and awaken people to the truth)

- ⁹ What shall therefore the lord of the vineyard do? he will come and destroy the husbandmen, and will give the vineyard unto others. (At the Second Advent, Jesus will return to end antichrist, his angels and the Kenites forever)
- ¹⁰ And have ye not read this scripture; The stone which the builders rejected is become the head of the corner: Psalms-118:22

(Kenites are the builders of cities) see Genesis-4

(The head cornerstone is Jesus Christ – God with us; He will become their stumbling block because they reject Him)

- ¹¹This was the Lord's doing, and it is marvellous in our eyes?
- ¹² And they sought to lay hold on him, but feared the people: for they knew that he had spoken the parable against them: and they left him, and went their way. (These guys are the Kenites. They were trying to find a way to murder Jesus; but they knew that the people would side with Jesus against them. They would later do their dirty work in the dead of night, through treachery, deceit, subversion and lies)
- ¹³ And they send unto him certain of the Pharisees and of the <u>Herodians</u>, to catch him in his words. (Pharisees were the religious leaders and the hierarchy of the synagogues. Herodians were the scripture lawyers SO-called experts who twist God's Word to suit their agenda)

(Both were treacherous corrupt priests and scribes who were in it for the money. The Jewish religion had been totally taken over and corrupted by Kenites. They were behind the scenes, pulling the strings)

NOTE: (They still are today. They are behind the globalist elite who are trying to take our liberty. They want to unite the world under them. They will be the masters and we would be the obedient worker serfs. That is the system that will fail, until Satan is kicked out of Heaven by Michael. Satan, as antichrist, will repair that global system and rule for 5 months. We are very near the end of days)

¹⁴ And when they were come, they say unto him, <u>Master</u>, we know that thou art true, and carest for no man: for thou regardest not the person of men, but teachest the way of God in truth: Is it lawful to give tribute to Caesar, or not? (They called Jesus Master. Like Satan, they work their evil through flattery and backstabbing)

(They thought that Jesus would tell them to give the tribute to the church. That would have made Him seditious to the Roman government. And if He said to give the tribute to Caesar; it would have made Him appear as though He was going against the church. They thought that they had outsmarted Immanuel – God with us. They called Him master, but they were really trying to set Him up for execution)

Note: (Satan's method of operation is to flatter you, and then trip you up with your own words)

- ¹⁵ Shall we give, or shall we not give? But he, knowing their hypocrisy, said unto them, Why tempt ye me? bring me a penny, that I may see it. (Jesus saw right through them; the Romans were in charge of the civil authority; God is in charge of spirituality and salvation)
- ¹⁶ And they brought it. And he saith unto them, Whose is this image and superscription? And they said unto him, Caesar's.
- ¹⁷ And Jesus answering said unto them, Render to Caesar the things that are Caesar's, and to God the things that are God's. And they marvelled at him. (Pay your taxes, do no crimes and be a good citizen. Give God your love and your worship. Be a loyal servant to Him on a spiritual basis. The two aren't mutually exclusive)

- ¹⁸ Then come unto him the Sadducees, which say there is no resurrection; and they asked him, saying, (Just as treacherous as the Pharisees, but these guys didn't believe in life after death. They were a part of the church, who only enjoy a good flesh life of wealth)
- ¹⁹ <u>Master</u>, Moses wrote unto us, If a man's brother die, and leave his wife behind him, and leave no children, that his brother should take his wife, and raise up seed unto his brother. (Master = teacher)

(This is another riddle, trying to trip up Jesus) Deuteronomy-25:3-5

- ²⁰ Now there were seven brethren: and the first took a wife, and dying <u>left no seed</u>. (He left no children)
- ²¹ And the second took her, and died, neither left he any seed: and the third likewise.
- ²² And the seven had her, and left no seed: last of all the woman died also. (She never had children)
- ²³ In the resurrection therefore, when they shall rise, whose wife shall she be of them? for the seven had her to wife. (First of all, Sadducees don't believe in a resurrection. Secondly they don't know that we won't marry in the afterlife. These guys have no idea what they are talking about)
- ²⁴ And Jesus answering said unto them, Do ye not therefore err, because ye know not the scriptures, neither the power of God? (Jesus called them out. They had never read the Word of God. Still, Jesus will teach them)
- ²⁵ For when they shall rise from the dead, they neither marry, nor are given in marriage; but are as the angels which are in heaven. (There are no marriages or any children in Paradise. Our spiritual bodies have no gender. We all go there to await judgment like Lazarus and the rich man) See Luke-16:19-31
- ²⁶ And as touching the dead, that they rise: have ye not read in the book of Moses, how in the bush God spake unto him, saying, I am the God of Abraham, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob? (Abraham, Isaac and Jacob are with God, in Paradise)

(The only ones who have been sentenced to death so far are Satan and his fallen angels; and even they are still alive today)

²⁷ He is not the God of the dead, but the God of the living: ye therefore do greatly err. (Jesus tells the truth. They are ignorant of the Word of God. No one has died yet. Only those who will fail at the great judgment will die at the end of the Millennium)

NOTES: (Satan and his fallen angels were sentenced to death for their rebellion against God. But even they is still alive today)

(Everyone else will be judged at the end of the Millennium. Those who fail at that time will die spiritually along with Satan. The fallen angels will die sooner, when Jesus' feet touch down on Mount of Olives, to begin the Millennium)

- ²⁸ And one of the scribes came, and having heard them reasoning together, and perceiving that he had answered them well, asked him, Which is the first commandment of all? See Exodeus-20
- ²⁹ And Jesus answered him, The first of all the commandments is, Hear, O Israel; <u>The Lord our God is one Lord</u>: (There is one God He has many offices The Father, Jesus, the Holy Spirit, Melchizedek, the Angel of the Lord, etc. God is whoever and whenever He wishes to be)

NOTES: (Preachers today preach the "trinity", like there are three Gods working together. This false doctrine was started by the early Catholic Church and are the traditions of men; namely the popes)

(There is ONE GOD, and Jesus just said it. HE also said – If you've seen me, you've seen the Father – because they are the same God, in different forms. Jesus is God, in the flesh. The Holy Spirit is God in spirit form) see Isaiah-7:14, John-14:9

- ³⁰ And thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength: this is the first commandment. (This verse covers the first 5 commandments – the Spiritual Commandments)
- ³¹ And the second is like, namely this, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. There is none other commandment greater than these. (This verse covers the last 5 commandments the Civil Commandments)

NOTE: (Today, people call the last two verses – the Golden Rule)

- ³² And the scribe said unto him, Well, Master, thou hast said the truth: for <u>there is one God</u>; and there is none other but he: (One God; not a "trinity" as organized religion teaches)
- ³³ And to love him with all the heart, and with all the understanding, and with all the soul, and with all the strength, and to love his neighbour as himself, is more than all whole burnt offerings and sacrifices. (This scribe gets it) see Hosea-6:6
- ³⁴ And when Jesus saw that he answered discreetly, he said unto him, Thou art not far from the kingdom of God. And no man after that durst ask him any question.
- ³⁵ And Jesus answered and said, while he taught in the temple, How say the scribes that Christ is the son of David? (Jesus < God in the flesh, through Mary> was a descendant of King David, through his son Nathan)
- ³⁶ For David himself said by the Holy Ghost, The LORD said to my Lord, Sit thou on my right hand, till I make thine enemies thy footstool. See Psalms-110 <inspired by God, penned by King David>

(The Father and Jesus are different offices of the one God; not separate entities)

(God, as Jesus, has lived and died in a flesh body. HE is qualified to judge us because He lived a perfect life without sin. God has many offices – as many as He wants to have)

- ³⁷ David therefore himself calleth him Lord; and whence is he then his son? And the common people heard him gladly. (People instinctively recognize the truth when they hear it. Jesus always taught the truth)
- ³⁸ And he said unto them in his doctrine, Beware of the scribes, which love to go in long clothing, and love salutations in the marketplaces, (The holy robes of the priests and scribes; they use their wealth and the subordination of people under them to elevate their social status. These are ego maniacs who don't get the first thing about God's Word)
- ³⁹ And the chief seats in the synagogues, and the uppermost rooms at feasts: (They are VIPs, in their own delusional minds. They sat in the uppermost seats in the synagogue)

- Which devour widows' houses, and for a pretence make long prayers: these shall receive greater damnation. (They rip off the people, in the name of religion, to enrich themselves. They should have been humbly teaching the Word of God to the people. That is the job of a priest)
- ⁴¹ And Jesus sat over against the treasury, and beheld how the people cast money into the treasury: and many that were rich cast in much. (They could afford it)
- ⁴² And there came a certain poor widow, and she threw in two mites, which make a farthing. (A mite is the smallest amount of money)
- ⁴³ And he called unto him his disciples, and saith unto them, Verily I say unto you, That this poor widow hath cast more in, than all they which have cast into the treasury: (She gave all that she had)
- ⁴⁴ For all they did cast in of their abundance; but she of her want did cast in all that she had, even all her living. (This woman really loved God. God is not counting money. HE owns everything. He doesn't need our money. He loves us and wants us to love Him also) Hosea-6:6

NOTE: (The reason that we give to a true church is to keep the teaching coming. The teacher is due a fair salary for his time. He is not due a luxurious living at the expense of the congregation. Today, we see poor people giving money to millionaire preachers)
