Psalm 149

King James Version (KJV)

- **149** Praise ye the LORD. Sing unto the LORD a new song, and his praise in the congregation of <u>saints</u>. (saints= the elect)
- ²Let Israel rejoice in him that made him: let the children of Zion be joyful in their King.
- ³Let them praise his name in the dance: let them sing praises unto him with the timbrel and harp.
- ⁴ For the LORD taketh pleasure in his people: he will beautify the meek with salvation. Revelation-4:11
- ⁵Let the saints be joyful in glory: let them sing aloud upon their beds.
- ⁶Let the high praises of God be in their mouth, and a <u>two-edged sword</u> in their hand; Hebrews-4:12, Revelation-1:16, (This is the Word of God)
- ⁷To execute vengeance upon the heathen, and punishments upon the people; Deuteronomy-32:35
- ⁸To bind their kings with chains, and their nobles with fetters of iron; Numbers-24:24
- ⁹To execute upon them the judgment written: this honour have all his saints. Praise ye the LORD.

Some believe that these last 5 Psalms form a group – each psalm is equivalent to one of the 5 Books of Moses – from-Genesis to Deuteronomy. Also they all begin and end with Hallelujah.
