

## Jeremiah 5

King James Version (KJV)

(Investigate for yourself. Learn the truth. God wants people to think for themselves; instead of just believing man's propaganda)

**5** Run ye to and fro through the streets of Jerusalem, and see now, and know, and seek in the broad places thereof, if ye can find a man, if there be any that executeth judgment, that seeketh the truth; and I will pardon it. (Go look; try to find an honest politician, judge or priest – there were none. Corruption and perversion were everywhere then, just as they are now)

<sup>2</sup>And though they say, The LORD liveth; surely they swear falsely. (They are false preachers; teaching the traditions of men, instead of the true Word of God)

<sup>3</sup>O LORD, are not thine eyes upon the truth? thou hast stricken them, but they have not grieved; thou hast consumed them, but they have refused to receive correction: they have made their faces harder than a rock; they have refused to return. (God tried over and over to wake them up to the truth, but they refused to cooperate and learn)

NOTES: (Today, Christianity is seen as a cult by the rest of the world. Christians are ridiculed by others)

(Most Christians are taught false doctrine by corrupt preachers, and they think that they are in good shape with God. They aren't. Most Christian preachers will tell you that the world is only 6,000 years old. They teach "Rapture Theory"; yet many people believe it)

<sup>4</sup>Therefore I said, Surely these are poor; they are foolish: for they know not the way of the LORD, nor the judgment of their God. (False religion produces Biblical ignorance)

<sup>5</sup>I will get me unto the great men, and will speak unto them; for they have known the way of the LORD, and the judgment of their God: but these have altogether broken the yoke, and burst the bonds.

(Investigate for yourself. Do your own research. Don't listen to preachers that read one verse of God's Word, and then go into a one hour sermon that they wrote. You will learn nothing from them)

(Read God's Word for yourself, and learn the truth. Study with truly wise teachers who will help you through the English translation errors.)

Those errors were made when the monks translated the Hebrew and Greek manuscripts into English; but there are many books available to help us to correct those errors)

<sup>6</sup>Wherefore a lion out of the forest shall slay them, and a wolf of the evenings shall spoil them, a leopard shall watch over their cities: every one that goeth out thence shall be torn in pieces: because their transgressions are many, and their backslidings are increased. (The lion is Satan posing as antichrist – slaying souls)

(evenings = araba <in the Hebrew> - the people of the desert; the Arabs <Muslims, today>. The evening is the end of the day – the end of this Age)

(the leopard = the Kenites – the sons of Cain; their spot is not our spot – as written in the Song of Moses) Deuteronomy-32:3-5

Genesis-4:17 (Cain's descendants are the builders of cities, bankers, merchants, middle men who control the money supply. They are the Kenites – the house of Rechab) 1Chronicles-2:55, Jeremiah-35:2-14

<sup>7</sup>How shall I pardon thee for this? thy children have forsaken me, and sworn by them that are no gods: when I had fed them to the full, they then committed adultery, and assembled themselves by troops in the harlots' houses. (Their ignorance will lead them to be deceived by the antichrist. God sees idolatry the same way that we see adultery)

See Mark-13 (Woe to those that are with child when I return – Jesus was speaking spiritually. These are the people that will have been unfaithful to God. Those that will be seduced by antichrist at the 6<sup>th</sup> Trump)

<sup>8</sup>They were as fed horses in the morning: every one neighed after his neighbour's wife. (Adultery = idolatry – they are the same thing in God's eyes)

(Like well fed horses in the morning - they have too much time on their hands; so that they get themselves into trouble. Yet, it is God's grace that fed them well in the first place)

<sup>9</sup>Shall I not visit for these things? saith the LORD: and shall not my soul be avenged on such a nation as this? (The answer is yes)

<sup>10</sup> Go ye up upon her walls, and destroy; but make not a full end: take away her battlements; for they are not the LORD's. (Their battlements and their trust are in the ways of the world, not in God. They will have no defense against Satan and his lies, because they abandoned God)

Revelation-9 (The antichrist is coming. He will deceive the whole world for 5 months – the season of the locust)

<sup>11</sup> For the house of Israel and the house of Judah have dealt very treacherously against me, saith the LORD. (They have corrupted their religion with traditions of men; and also with idol worship of the false gods of the heathen peoples)

<sup>12</sup> They have belied the LORD, and said, It is not he; neither shall evil come upon us; neither shall we see sword nor famine: (We live in a powerful country. We won't see the trouble, misery and poverty that the other nations see)

NOTES: (We say the same thing today in the US. The American people trust in the government and in the riches of our country to keep them living in luxury. They don't put their trust in God. It is God who blessed this country that we live in. Without His blessings, the spoiled lives of the wealthy will fall apart quickly)

(In the end days, Christians are taught by false preachers that they will be raptured out of here when antichrist shows up. None of that is true. God wants us to stand against antichrist, not "fly away" in some delusion)

<sup>13</sup> And the prophets shall become wind, and the word is not in them: thus shall it be done unto them. (Wind bags - they preach and preach; yet they teach nothing of God's Word. Instead, they preach sermons that they wrote from their own imagination. The result is that their flocks remain Biblically ignorant)

<sup>14</sup> Wherefore thus saith the LORD God of hosts, Because ye speak this word, behold, I will make my words in thy mouth fire, and this people wood, and it shall devour them. (Because of the false prophets words, God will put His Words in Jeremiah's mouth as fire; and the false prophets as wood; and it shall devour them – proper translation)

<sup>15</sup> Lo, I will bring a nation upon you from far, O house of Israel, saith the LORD: it is a mighty nation, it is an ancient nation, a nation whose

language thou knowest not, neither understandest what they say.  
(This was Babylon then. They were coming to take Judah captive)

(Today they may be the Muslim nations, maybe the communists, maybe the Kenites, maybe the fallen angels – maybe all four. Either way, they are coming for us because we have abandoned God)

<sup>16</sup> Their quiver is as an open sepulchre, they are all mighty men. (Their weapons are as the grave, to spiritually kill souls with their false teachings and their false religion)

<sup>17</sup> And they shall eat up thine harvest, and thy bread, which thy sons and thy daughters should eat: they shall eat up thy flocks and thine herds: they shall eat up thy vines and thy fig trees: they shall impoverish thy fenced cities, wherein thou trustedst, with the sword.  
(You trusted in your weapons and not in God)

(The enemy will eat up everything that we have – through taxation, imports, outsourcing jobs and usury. Our corrupt leaders have stolen all of our national wealth; which God had blessed us with. Our leaders have the minds of children)

See Isaiah-3:4 (And I will give children to be their princes, and babes shall rule over them)

<sup>18</sup> Nevertheless in those days, saith the LORD, I will not make a full end with you. (By the grace of Almighty God, there has always been a remnant that love God and study His Word. They have passed down God's Word from generation to generation. That is why we are still able to learn His Word if we so choose to do)

(That is one of the greatest blessings that we have today. It is a shame that people can't see it)

(Regardless of what happens to the nation, God will love and protect His faithful followers. Daniel was a great example of that)

<sup>19</sup> And it shall come to pass, when ye shall say, Wherefore doeth the LORD our God all these things unto us? then shalt thou answer them, Like as ye have forsaken me, and served strange gods in your land, so shall ye serve strangers in a land that is not your's. (People blame God for the collapse of the Christian nations. They bring it upon themselves. God didn't do it)

NOTE: (40 years ago, the US was the richest nation in the world. Today we are drowning in debt and people live in poverty; while the rich get richer. Our nation is tens of trillions of dollars in debt. We are loosing our country to the people that we borrow from; who are actually our enemies)

<sup>20</sup> Declare this in the house of Jacob, and publish it in Judah, saying, (This concerns both houses – all 12 tribes)

<sup>21</sup> Hear now this, O foolish people, and without understanding; which have eyes, and see not; which have ears, and hear not: (Clueless idiots. Most people have already been deceived for decades)

Spiritually: (They go to church and hear traditions of men, and think that they are hearing God's Word)

Physically: (They hear nothing but propoganda from their own governments; and they think that they know what is really going on)

<sup>22</sup> Fear ye not me? saith the LORD: will ye not tremble at my presence, which have placed the sand for the bound of the sea by a perpetual decree, that it cannot pass it: and though the waves thereof toss themselves, yet can they not prevail; though they roar, yet can they not pass over it? (Fear = revere – They are the same word in the Hebrew. Return to God and He will bless you again)

(God is in control of all nature. He created the entire universe. People concern themselves with the physical things of this world; instead of concerning themselves with the One who created and controls all of it)

<sup>23</sup> But this people hath a revolting and a rebellious heart; they are revolted and gone. (They refuse to accept God. They trust in the ways of the world - in money; in the power of nations; in false religions and in false doctrine of preachers)

<sup>24</sup> Neither say they in their heart, Let us now fear the LORD our God, that giveth rain, both the former and the latter, in his season: he reserveth unto us the appointed weeks of the harvest. (fear = revere – it's the same word in Hebrew) (God will provide the harvest, physically and spiritually, to His faithful children)

<sup>25</sup> Your iniquities have turned away these things, and your sins have withholden good things from you. (You choose to miss out on God's

blessings. You do it to yourselves, and then you complain in your misery)

<sup>26</sup> For among my people are found wicked men: they lay wait, as he that setteth snares; they set a trap, they catch men. (They are the false preachers; crooked business men; greedy financiers, bankers, usurers; corrupt tax collectors; and other conmen. They are the ones who prosper in the corrupt ways of the world while honest working people get poorer and poorer)

<sup>27</sup> As a cage is full of birds, so are their houses full of deceit: therefore they are become great, and waxen rich. (They trap the innocent people to steal their wealth. They get rich at the expense of those that they deceive. Their riches are ill gotten gains)

<sup>28</sup> They are waxen fat, they shine: yea, they overpass the deeds of the wicked: they judge not the cause, the cause of the fatherless, yet they prosper; and the right of the needy do they not judge. (Crooked judges and government leaders prosper at the expense of the citizens. The judges accept bribes to excuse the guilty ones. And thus, they subvert the very justice that they were hired to dispense)

(False preachers, who teach traditions of men instead of God's Word, are just as guilty on a spiritual basis)

<sup>29</sup> Shall I not visit for these things? saith the LORD: shall not my soul be avenged on such a nation as this? (Yes it will be avenged. God will pour out the cup of His wrath upon these people) Revelation-16

<sup>30</sup> A wonderful and horrible thing is committed in the land; (wonderful = astonishing, astounding – better translation)

<sup>31</sup> The prophets prophesy falsely, and the priests bear rule by their means; and my people love to have it so: and what will ye do in the end thereof? (Don't be fooled by the evils of the world; and by false preachers that teach traditions of men as if it was God's Word)

(Investigate and learn the truth for yourself. Learn what the Bible says <properly translated> and know the truth. Knowledge is power. God gave us power over all of our enemies)

Luke-10:19 (Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you)
