

Isaiah 35

King James Version (KJV)

(This chapter is about God's kingdom, during the Millennium)

35 The wilderness and the solitary place shall be glad for them; and the desert shall rejoice, and blossom as the rose. (This is during the Millennium)

(Roses don't grow in the desert. The deserts will be transformed into a garden)

²It shall blossom abundantly, and rejoice even with joy and singing: the glory of Lebanon shall be given unto it, the excellency of Carmel and Sharon, they shall see the glory of the LORD, and the excellency of our God. (The earth will become a lush garden in paradise)

³Strengthen ye the weak hands, and confirm the feeble knees. (Those of us who know the truth need to comfort & strengthen the people with this good news. Most people don't know what is coming. We do)

⁴Say to them that are of a fearful heart, Be strong, fear not: behold, your God will come with vengeance, even God with a recompence; he will come and save you. (This is the Second Advent when Jesus will return as the King of kings, Lord of lords. HE will punish the guilty and reward the innocent)

⁵Then the eyes of the blind shall be opened, and the ears of the deaf shall be unstopped. (In our spiritual bodies, we will see the truth. All people will be healthy. We will have total recall – all the way back to the First Age)

⁶Then shall the lame man leap as an hart, and the tongue of the dumb sing: for in the wilderness shall waters break out, and streams in the desert. (hart = a deer) (The sick and crippled people will become healthy and vibrant. The whole earth will become fertile and lush)

⁷And the parched ground shall become a pool, and the thirsty land springs of water: in the habitation of dragons, where each lay, shall be grass with reeds and rushes. (parched = miraged - bad translation; the mirage in the desert will become a real pool of water)

(Dragons are symbolic for the enemy <Satan and his fallen angels>. They won't be there. Their lair will become a lush field of reeds and grass)

⁸And an highway shall be there, and a way, and it shall be called The way of holiness; the unclean shall not pass over it; but it shall be for those: the wayfaring men, though fools, shall not err therein. (fools = simple ones – better translation; Even simple people won't get lost, or go astray)

⁹No lion shall be there, nor any ravenous beast shall go up thereon, it shall not be found there; but the redeemed shall walk there: (No flesh will exist in the Millennium. Even the animals will no longer be flesh, so there won't be any predators) 1Corinthians-15:20-26

¹⁰And the ransomed of the LORD shall return, and come to Zion with songs and everlasting joy upon their heads: they shall obtain joy and gladness, and sorrow and sighing shall flee away. (They are the Elect – those who remained faithful to God, through the tribulation of Satan)
