King James Version (KJV)

- 112 <u>Praise ye the LORD</u>. Blessed is the man that feareth the LORD, that delighteth greatly in his commandments. (Praise ye the LORD-Hallelujah)
- <sup>2</sup> His seed shall be mighty upon earth: the generation of the upright shall be blessed.
- <sup>3</sup> Wealth and riches shall be in his house: and his righteousness endureth for ever. (Wealth- enough... not the wealth of the world in millions of dollars, which is excess) (riches- see Revelation-2:9-10)
- <sup>4</sup>Unto the upright there ariseth light in the darkness: he is gracious, and full of compassion, and righteous. (The upright also have the compassion of the LORD, for others)
- <sup>5</sup>A good man sheweth favour, and <u>lendeth</u>: he will guide his affairs with discretion. (lendeth also means to make merciful acts for others)
- <sup>6</sup> Surely he shall not be moved for ever: the righteous shall be in everlasting remembrance.
- <sup>7</sup>He shall not be afraid of evil tidings: his heart is fixed, trusting in the LORD.
- <sup>8</sup> His heart is established, he shall not be afraid, until he see his desire upon his enemies.
- <sup>9</sup> He hath dispersed, he hath given to the poor; his righteousness endureth for ever; his horn shall be exalted with honour.
- <sup>10</sup> The wicked shall see it, and be grieved; he shall gnash with his teeth, and melt away: the desire of the wicked shall perish.
