

## Isaiah 33

King James Version (KJV)

**33** Woe to thee that spoilest, and thou wast not spoiled; and dealest treacherously, and they dealt not treacherously with thee! when thou shalt cease to spoil, thou shalt be spoiled; and when thou shalt make an end to deal treacherously, they shall deal treacherously with thee. (Senachareb was the type for this verse – he was the king of Syria)

(The spoiler in the end days will be Satan, as antichrist. When his treachery upon the people is over, he will be punished by God)

<sup>2</sup>O LORD, be gracious unto us; we have waited for thee: be thou their arm every morning, our salvation also in the time of trouble. (These are the people who waited for Christ to return at the 7<sup>th</sup> Trump; not the hasty ones that will jump on antichrist's wagon at the 6<sup>th</sup> Trump)

<sup>3</sup>At the noise of the tumult the people fled; at the lifting up of thyself the nations were scattered.

<sup>4</sup>And your spoil shall be gathered like the gathering of the caterpillar: as the running to and fro of locusts shall he run upon them. (The punishers will, in turn, be punished by God)

(God stripped the Syrian army when they attacked Israel. HE will strip antichrist's one world system after he has led the world into confusion and sin)

<sup>5</sup>The LORD is exalted; for he dwelleth on high: he hath filled Zion with judgment and righteousness. (God will set things right. Moral correctness will replace political correctness. Righteousness and morality will replace sin and perversion)

<sup>6</sup>And wisdom and knowledge shall be the stability of thy times, and strength of salvation: the fear of the LORD is his treasure. (fear = reverence – it's the same word in the Hebrew)

Proverbs-1:7 (All wisdom comes from the reverence of God)

<sup>7</sup>Behold, their valiant ones shall cry without: the ambassadors of peace shall weep bitterly. (Antichrist won't be interested in peace; just as Senachareb wasn't interested in peace, when he invaded Judah)

<sup>8</sup>The highways lie waste, the wayfaring man ceaseth: he hath broken the covenant, he hath despised the cities, he regardeth no man. (The Assyrian <the antichrist> will promise peace and prosperity to everyone who will worship him. But there will be no peace. His promises are all lies)

<sup>9</sup>The earth mourneth and languisheth: Lebanon is ashamed and hewn down: Sharon is like a wilderness; and Bashan and Carmel shake off their fruits. (These were all fertile places. Now, they will be languishing in shame and in sin after antichrist arrives. He will deceive the whole world into sin and degradation)

<sup>10</sup>Now will I rise, saith the LORD; now will I be exalted; now will I lift up myself. (Afterwards, Jesus will return to set things right. HE will arrive as the true Messiah at the 7<sup>th</sup> Trump)

<sup>11</sup>Ye shall conceive chaff, ye shall bring forth stubble: your breath, as fire, shall devour you. (Your own breath of fire will destroy the stubble that you produced. Your false doctrine will cause you to fail on judgment day)

(Those who side with antichrist will produce nothing but stubble. They will eventually destroy themselves with their own words. It makes no sense to follow antichrist, when you can wait for the true Messiah)

<sup>12</sup>And the people shall be as the burnings of lime: as thorns cut up shall they be burned in the fire. (They will be completely consumed as if by lime, or as thorns in a fire)

(Our flesh bodies will all be consumed in the blink of an eye, at the 7<sup>th</sup> Trump. There will be no flesh left during the Millennium. We will return into our spiritual bodies – just as we were during the First Age)

<sup>13</sup>Hear, ye that are far off, what I have done; and, ye that are near, acknowledge my might. (God will wake people up; both the believers and the unbelievers)

<sup>14</sup>The sinners in Zion are afraid; fearfulness hath surprised the hypocrites. Who among us shall dwell with the devouring fire? who among us shall dwell with everlasting burnings? (There won't be any more doubters. All people will know that God is the King. Those who oppose Him have good reason to be afraid)

<sup>15</sup> He that walketh righteously, and speaketh uprightly; he that despiseth the gain of oppressions, that shaketh his hands from holding of bribes, that stoppeth his ears from hearing of blood, and shutteth his eyes from seeing evil; (Those are people who live by God's Word, and not the ways of the world. The people who love Him and live by His commandments will receive blessings and grace)

<sup>16</sup> He shall dwell on high: his place of defence shall be the munitions of rocks: bread shall be given him; his waters shall be sure. (God will protect and feed the people who are faithful to Him)

<sup>17</sup> Thine eyes shall see the king in his beauty: they shall behold the land that is very far off. (God's appearance is magnificent. HIS kingdom is a beautiful place)

<sup>18</sup> Thine heart shall meditate terror. Where is the scribe? where is the receiver? where is he that counted the towers? (receiver = the tax collector)

<sup>19</sup> Thou shalt not see a fierce people, a people of a deeper speech than thou canst perceive; of a stammering tongue, that thou canst not understand. (None of the enemy will be there)

<sup>20</sup> Look upon Zion, the city of our solemnities: thine eyes shall see Jerusalem a quiet habitation, a tabernacle that shall not be taken down; not one of the stakes thereof shall ever be removed, neither shall any of the cords thereof be broken. (On the Lord's Day and in the eternity, afterwards; God's kingdom will last forever)

<sup>21</sup> But there the glorious LORD will be unto us a place of broad rivers and streams; wherein shall go no galley with oars, neither shall gallant ship pass thereby. It will be a place of plenty for all; peaceful waters without warships)

<sup>22</sup> For the LORD is our judge, the LORD is our lawgiver, the LORD is our king; he will save us. (God's Law <the Ten Commandments> will never change. It is the same Law that God gave Moses)

<sup>23</sup> Thy tacklings are loosed; they could not well strengthen their mast, they could not spread the sail: then is the prey of a great spoil divided; the lame take the prey. (The ship of the Assyrian will be helpless) (the lame are those who were disadvantaged or crippled by the wicked, when they were in the flesh)

(The ships of the evil ones will be so disadvantaged that even those who were lame will be able to take what they want from them. The persecutors will become the prey)

<sup>24</sup>And the inhabitant shall not say, I am sick: the people that dwell therein shall be forgiven their iniquity. (At the 7<sup>th</sup> Trump, we will all be back in our spiritual bodies. There will be no sickness, no aging)
