

Isaiah 32

King James Version (KJV)

32 Behold, a king shall reign in righteousness, and princes shall rule in judgment. (On the Lord's Day) (The King is Jesus; the princes are the Elect. They will rule by teaching the Word of God to everyone)

²And a man shall be as an hiding place from the wind, and a covert from the tempest; as rivers of water in a dry place, as the shadow of a great rock in a weary land. (That man is our Lord Jesus Christ <God in the form of a flesh man>. HE is our rest, our rock and our protection)

³And the eyes of them that see shall not be dim, and the ears of them that hear shall hearken. (Those who know the truth will have eyes to see and ears to hear - spiritually)

⁴The heart also of the rash shall understand knowledge, and the tongue of the stammerers shall be ready to speak plainly. (the rash = the hasty) (plainly = eloquently)

(The ones that were previously deceived will finally get it. When the Elect are called up to testify before antichrist, they will finally wake up many of the people to the truth) see Luke-21

⁵The vile person shall be no more called liberal, nor the churl said to be bountiful. (vile = foolish) (liberal = noble <in the Hebrew>) (churl = a miser)

NOTES: (It's funny that the vile are called liberal in this verse, although it is a mistranslation. It pretty much fits today's liberals)

(Today, the liberals are the vile ones – with sexual perversion, atheism, communism, feminism, abortion and whatever other twisted philosophies they can dream up)

(The liberals are all for sexual perversion, calling it "inclusion". They are most of the atheists. Yet, they are the ones who insist on recognizing Islam as a religion for the western world; while they condemn Christianity as the "radical right")

(Islam is a repressive cult that was founded by a murderer and a rapist in the Middle East named Mohammad. It has nothing to do with God, or liberty and personal freedom)

⁶For the vile person will speak villany, and his heart will work iniquity, to practise hypocrisy, and to utter error against the LORD, to make empty the soul of the hungry, and he will cause the drink of the thirsty to fail. (vile = foolish; villany= foolishness; hypocrisy= play acting; error = lies) (The left hates God. They hate Christianity)

(The propaganda of the vile ones, in the end days, will cause most people to think that antichrist is messiah. Those seeking to learn the truth will be deceived by the liberal left, the Kenites and antichrist, himself. Their quest for knowledge will fail)

⁷The instruments also of the churl are evil: he deviseth wicked devices to destroy the poor with lying words, even when the needy speaketh right. (churl= covetous miser) (wicked devices – usury, propaganda)

(Today, the billionaires rule the people covertly through governmental corruption, bribes and corporate monopolies. The banks engage in usury with predatory loans, usually aimed at the poor. Truth is being silenced through censorship and propaganda)

⁸But the liberal deviseth liberal things; and by liberal things shall he stand. (liberal = noble – bad translation) (The truly noble persons do noble works. They are blessed for their good works)

(The word liberal means something completely different today. It is synonymous with perversion, communism, atheism and socialism)

⁹Rise up, ye women that are at ease; hear my voice, ye careless daughters; give ear unto my speech. (They are at ease following antichrist; because they have been fooled into believing that he is Jesus, returned)

(The careless daughters are the ones who blindly follow anyone who speaks “feel good” doctrine. They never bothered to read God’s Word and to learn what it means. They are the blind, following the blind)

¹⁰Many days and years shall ye be troubled, ye careless women: for the vintage shall fail, the gathering shall not come. (They won’t be blessed because they did not learn the Word of God. They believed traditions of men and the doctrine of antichrist)

¹¹Tremble, ye women that are at ease; be troubled, ye careless ones: strip you, and make you bare, and gird sackcloth upon your loins.

(These are signs of being in mourning) (Mourn; because you have been seduced by antichrist. Judgment is coming for you)

¹² They shall lament for the teats, for the pleasant fields, for the fruitful vine. (They will lament for the days of bounty and blessings)

¹³ Upon the land of my people shall come up thorns and briers; yea, upon all the houses of joy in the joyous city: (Thorns & briers burn very fast. They make a very hot fire, but it doesn't last long. They are useless for heating a house or for cooking over)

¹⁴ Because the palaces shall be forsaken; the multitude of the city shall be left; the forts and towers shall be for dens for ever, a joy of wild asses, a pasture of flocks; (forsaken - neglected and in shambles; inhabited by wild animals, not fit for human habitation) (This city is Jerusalem)

VERSE 19 here (It may have been misplaced by a copyist error)

¹⁵ Until the spirit be poured upon us from on high, and the wilderness be a fruitful field, and the fruitful field be counted for a forest. (spirit = the Holy Spirit of God)

(Spiritually, this happened at Pentecost. The Holy Spirit spoke through the people. It will happen again in the end days. HE will do it again when the Elect testify before the whole world) Joel-2, Acts-2

(God will make the wilderness produce more than any of our fruitful fields – better translation)

¹⁶ Then judgment shall dwell in the wilderness, and righteousness remain in the fruitful field. (The world will be rejuvenated when God takes over. HE is in control because He created everything)

¹⁷ And the work of righteousness shall be peace; and the effect of righteousness quietness and assurance for ever. (We can get peace of mind today; if we study God's Word and live by what it teaches)

¹⁸ And my people shall dwell in a peaceable habitation, and in sure dwellings, and in quiet resting places;

¹⁹ When it shall hail, coming down on the forest; and the city shall be low in a low place. (IN THE MANUSCRIPTS - This verse belongs after the 14th verse) (The city here is Nineveh – the capital city of the

Assyrians. Antichrist is also called the Assyrian in many Books of the Bible. When antichrist sits in Jerusalem, claiming to be God, the city will be brought low – in total degradation – just like Nineveh)

²⁰ Blessed are ye that sow beside all waters, that send forth thither the feet of the ox and the ass. (Blessed are those who plow – today, those who do works for God. Blessed are those who help spread the Word of God to the people who need to hear it)
