- **Psalm 36** A Psalm of David, God's servant, by David King James Version (KJV)
- **36** The transgression of the wicked saith within my heart, that there is no fear of God before his eyes. Romans-3:18
- ² For he flattereth himself in his own eyes, until his iniquity be found to be hateful.
- ³The words of his mouth are iniquity and deceit: he hath left off to be wise, and to do good. (iniquity= emptiness, vanity)
- ⁴He deviseth mischief upon his bed; he setteth himself in a way that is not good; he abhorreth not evil.
- ⁵Thy mercy, O LORD, is in the heavens; and thy faithfulness reacheth unto the clouds.
- ⁶Thy righteousness is like the <u>great mountains</u>; thy judgments are a great deep: O LORD, thou preservest man and beast. (great mountains= the mountains of El, of God)
- ⁷How excellent is thy lovingkindness, O God! therefore the children of men put their trust under the shadow of thy wings.
- ⁸They shall be abundantly satisfied with the fatness of thy house; and thou shalt make them drink of the river of thy pleasures. Rev-22:1
- For with thee is the fountain of life: in thy light shall we see light. Jer-2:13, Rev-21:23
- ¹º O continue thy lovingkindness unto them that know thee; and thy righteousness to the upright in heart.
- ¹¹Let not the foot of pride come against me, and let not the hand of the wicked remove me. (the wicked= the wicked one)
- 12 There are the workers of iniquity fallen: they are cast down, and shall not be able to rise. (Prophetic at the white throne judgment) see Rev-20:11
