

Habakkuk 3

King James Version (KJV)

(This chapter is a Psalm to God by Habakkuk)

3 A prayer of Habakkuk the prophet upon Shigionoth. (Shigionoth = Cry it out loud. Let everyone hear this Psalm)

²O LORD, I have heard thy speech, and was afraid: O LORD, revive thy work in the midst of the years, in the midst of the years make known; in wrath remember mercy. Daniel-9:27 (in the middle of the week of years, the desolator <antichrist> will come to deceive the whole world)

(He will do it with false promises of wealth and equality for all. All they have to do is worship him. It's all lies, but people will follow him in droves)

See Mark-13, Matthew-24 (Jesus said – Let no man deceive you)
(Paul also taught this in 2Thessalonians 2:3-17)

³God came from Teman, and the Holy One from mount Paran. Selah. His glory covered the heavens, and the earth was full of his praise. (Teman = a city in the land of Edom, built by and named for Teman, a grandson of Esau)

(mount Paran = mountain ridge in a desert south of Palestine, north of Sinai)

(Selah = Pause, think, meditate - Usually meant to connect two thoughts together. God's coming back at the 7th Trump and we will witness His glory when He arrives)

⁴And his brightness was as the light; he had horns coming out of his hand: and there was the hiding of his power. (Horns are symbolic for power)

(The two powers might be the two witnesses in the end days. They will prophecy against antichrist and torment him, until he kills them both. Many believe that they are Moses and Elijah)

⁵Before him went the pestilence, and burning coals went forth at his feet. (burning coals = burning diseases – fever, sickness) See Deuteronomy-32:24-33 (This is happening to us today)

NOTES: (Today we see the spreading of strange pandemics. The corrupt pharmaceutical industry creates these germs in labs. When these germs are released into the population, the corrupt government forces people to be injected with the “vaccines” that were created by the same pharmaceutical companies. In other words - they create the disease so that they can profit from selling the cure)

(We also see the spreading of disease cause by sexual perversion and promiscuous behavior such as - STD's, AIDS, Ebola, COVID, etc...)

⁶He stood, and measured the earth: he beheld, and drove asunder the nations; and the everlasting mountains were scattered, the perpetual hills did bow: his ways are everlasting. (He = God) (stood and measured = stood and shook – bad translation; God will shake the whole world in the end days of this Age) see Hebrews-12:24-29

(Mountains and hills are symbolic of nations and governments)

⁷I saw the tents of Cushan in affliction: and the curtains of the land of Midian did tremble. (Cushan - means blackness; Median – means strife) (God's enemies will tremble when God has had enough of them)

⁸Was the LORD displeased against the rivers? was thine anger against the rivers? was thy wrath against the sea, that thou didst ride upon thine horses and thy chariots of salvation? (reference – 2:14 of this Book)

(Also see chapter 1 of this Book – the analogy of Christians as little fish, caught in a net by the Kenites. They trap us through false religious doctrine, corrupt government and crooked finances) see Ezekiel-13

⁹Thy bow was made quite naked, according to the oaths of the tribes, even thy word. Selah. Thou didst cleave the earth with rivers. (God will unsheathe His bow and use His arrows against the evil ones)

(Selah – pause & think; meditate on what you read) see Isaiah-43:26

(Rivers are symbolic for refreshing the people with the truth. God is the water of life; the living Word. HIS Word refreshes and re-invigorates those who learn it)

¹⁰The mountains saw thee, and they trembled: the overflowing of the water passed by: the deep uttered his voice, and lifted up his hands on

high. (The nations trembled when God's Word flowed over the world <the water of life>. He made Himself known to all peoples. This is prophetic for when Jesus returns as Messiah)

¹¹ The sun and moon stood still in their habitation: at the light of thine arrows they went, and at the shining of thy glittering spear. (The sun and moon pale in comparison to the brightness of Almighty God)

¹² Thou didst march through the land in indignation, thou didst thresh the heathen in anger. (Threshing separates the wheat from the chaff – separating the good from the bad; just as the shepherd separates the sheep from the goats)

¹³ Thou wentest forth for the salvation of thy people, even for salvation with thine anointed; thou woundedst the head out of the house of the wicked, by discovering the foundation unto the neck. Selah. (the wicked - Satan is the head of the house of the Kenites) Genesis-3:15

¹⁴ Thou didst strike through with his staves the head of his villages: they came out as a whirlwind to scatter me: their rejoicing was as to devour the poor secretly. (The work of the Kenites is to conquer through deception, usury and political correctness. They are back-stabbing two faced hypocrites who pretend to be a friend but work to destroy us)

¹⁵ Thou didst walk through the sea with thine horses, through the heap of great waters. (God goes where He wants to go. No one can stand in His way)

¹⁶ When I heard, my belly trembled; my lips quivered at the voice: rottenness entered into my bones, and I trembled in myself, that I might rest in the day of trouble: when he cometh up unto the people, he will invade them with his troops. (rottenness = restlessness – bad translation)

(We have nothing to worry about if we remain faithful to God. God will come up against the evil ones. HE is almighty and all powerful. The evil ones have a lot to worry about)

¹⁷ Although the fig tree shall not blossom, neither shall fruit be in the vines; the labour of the olive shall fail, and the fields shall yield no meat; the flock shall be cut off from the fold, and there shall be no herd in the stalls: (This means famine)

(Spiritually - The famine of the end times is for hearing the Word of God)

(Physically – Satan will force people to worship him, if they want to be able to buy and sell in his one world system)

¹⁸ Yet I will rejoice in the LORD, I will joy in the God of my salvation.
(God provides for the faithful – He always has and always will)

¹⁹ The LORD God is my strength, and he will make my feet like hinds' feet, and he will make me to walk upon mine high places. To the chief singer on my stringed instruments. (stringed instruments = neg-a-noth <Hebrew> means smiting. God will smite the enemy. HE is our strength. He is our salvation)

(End of the Psalm)
