King James Version (KJV)

- **116** I love the LORD, because he hath heard my voice and my supplications.
- ²Because he hath inclined his ear unto me, therefore will I call upon him as long as I live.
- ³The <u>sorrows</u> of death compassed me, and the pains of hell gat hold upon me: I found trouble and sorrow. (sorrows- cords; better translation)
- ⁴Then called I upon the name of the LORD; O LORD, I beseech thee, deliver my soul.
- ⁵ Gracious is the LORD, and righteous; yea, our God is merciful.
- ⁶The LORD preserveth the <u>simple</u>: I was brought low, and he helped me. (simple- less intelligent also means sincere from the old English)
- ⁷Return unto thy rest, O my soul; for the LORD hath dealt bountifully with thee.
- For thou hast delivered my soul from <u>death</u>, mine eyes from tears, and my feet from falling. (death- the devil -> Hebrews-2:14)
- °I will walk before the LORD in the land of the living.
- ¹⁰ I believed, therefore have I spoken: I was greatly <u>afflicted</u>: (By men)
- ¹¹ I said in my haste, All men are liars.
- 12 What shall I render unto the LORD for all his benefits toward me?
- ¹³ I will take the cup of salvation, and call upon the name of the LORD.
- ¹⁴ I will pay my vows unto the LORD now in the presence of all his people.
- ¹⁵ <u>Precious</u> in the sight of the LORD is the death of his saints. (Precious-valuable, of great worth- This word is only used 5 times in the Bible)

- ¹⁶ O LORD, truly I am thy servant; I am thy servant, and the son of thine handmaid: thou hast loosed my bonds.
- ¹⁷ I will offer to thee the sacrifice of thanksgiving, and will call upon the name of the LORD.
- ¹⁸ I will pay my vows unto the LORD now in the presence of all his people.
- ¹⁹ In the courts of the LORD's house, in the midst of thee, O Jerusalem. <u>Praise ye the LORD</u>. (Sometimes translated- Halleluiah)
