

Jeremiah 28

King James Version (KJV)

28 And it came to pass the same year, in the beginning of the reign of Zedekiah king of Judah, in the fourth year, and in the fifth month, that Hananiah the son of Azur the prophet, which was of Gibeon, spake unto me in the house of the LORD, in the presence of the priests and of all the people, saying, (**Hananiah = gift of Yah**)

²Thus speaketh the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel, saying, I have broken the yoke of the king of Babylon. (**Hananiah was a false prophet. God never said that. HE said that they should go into Babylonian captivity for 70 years**)

NOTE: (Satan's MO will be to pretend to be Jesus, returned as messiah. He will deceive the whole world. The Kenites already pretend to be Christian preachers. Biblically ignorant people are fooled by them, because they have never read the Bible. Instead, they sit in a church pew and listen to sermons that were written by men)

³Within two full years will I bring again into this place all the vessels of the LORD's house, that Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon took away from this place, and carried them to Babylon: (**He is telling the people whatever they want to hear. God said that they won't be back for 70 years**)

⁴And I will bring again to this place Jeconiah the son of Jehoiakim king of Judah, with all the captives of Judah, that went into Babylon, saith the LORD: for I will break the yoke of the king of Babylon. (**God took His name out of the name Jeconiah and called him Coniah because of his evil deeds**) (**Jeconiah = chosen by God**) (**Coniah = chosen**)

(**Yet Hananiah <a false prophet> is putting God's name back into that deposed, corrupt and evil ex-king. This shows that he had no idea of what God wants from them. God never sent him**)

⁵Then the prophet Jeremiah said unto the prophet Hananiah in the presence of the priests, and in the presence of all the people that stood in the house of the LORD, (**Jeremiah is calling Hananiah out. He is mocking him publicly**)

⁶Even the prophet Jeremiah said, Amen: the LORD do so: the LORD perform thy words which thou hast prophesied, to bring again

the vessels of the LORD's house, and all that is carried away captive, from Babylon into this place. (Jeremiah is mocking Hananiah)

⁷ Nevertheless hear thou now this word that I speak in thine ears, and in the ears of all the people; (Now hear the truth from God)

⁸ The prophets that have been before me and before thee of old prophesied both against many countries, and against great kingdoms, of war, and of evil, and of pestilence.

⁹ The prophet which prophesieth of peace, when the word of the prophet shall come to pass, then shall the prophet be known, that the LORD hath truly sent him. (Jeremiah is telling Hannaniah - If your prophecy comes true, you will be proven a prophet. If not, you will be exposed as a fake)

NOTE: (How will we know the difference when antichrist is here; selling us his false doctrine of peace and prosperity? Obey what God says in the Bible. Don't listen to antichrist and his false teachers)

See Mark-13, Matthew-24 (It's all there, laid out for us by Jesus Christ, Himself. God's Word never changes or "evolves". Will you believe antichrist or Jesus Christ? That is the test of the end times)

¹⁰ Then Hananiah the prophet took the yoke from off the prophet Jeremiah's neck, and brake it. (It was God, who told Jeremiah to put that yoke on his neck. Hananiah, taking action against God and His prophet is not a good idea. God will avenge Jeremiah)

¹¹ And Hananiah spake in the presence of all the people, saying, Thus saith the LORD; Even so will I break the yoke of Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon from the neck of all nations within the space of two full years. And the prophet Jeremiah went his way. (He was putting on a good show. None of it would happen of course)

¹² Then the word of the LORD came unto Jeremiah the prophet, after that Hananiah the prophet had broken the yoke from off the neck of the prophet Jeremiah, saying,

¹³ Go and tell Hananiah, saying, Thus saith the LORD; Thou hast broken the yokes of wood; but thou shalt make for them yokes of iron. (Life will get much harder for those who choose to believe Hananiah)

¹⁴ For thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; I have put a yoke of iron upon the neck of all these nations, that they may serve Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon; and they shall serve him: and I have given him the beasts of the field also. (God's has judged all of those nations. HIS plan will happen. No one will stop it)

Future: (the antichrist will come at the 6th Trump, and no one will be raptured out. We will be called up to witness against him, before the whole world. The Holy Spirit will speak through us; and many people will wake up out of their stupor)

¹⁵ Then said the prophet Jeremiah unto Hananiah the prophet, Hear now, Hananiah; The LORD hath not sent thee; but thou makest this people to trust in a lie. (A false prophet can cause people to go against God. Killing souls is far worse than killing bodies)

¹⁶ Therefore thus saith the LORD; Behold, I will cast thee from off the face of the earth: this year thou shalt die, because thou hast taught rebellion against the LORD. (God's judgment on Hananiah)

¹⁷ So Hananiah the prophet died the same year in the seventh month. (This chapter started in the 5th month. Hananiah was dead 2 months later, because he for defied God)
