- **29** Give unto the LORD, O ye mighty, give unto the LORD glory and strength. (mighty= sons of God. The angels)
- ²Give unto the LORD the glory due unto his name; worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness.
- ³The voice of the LORD is upon the waters: the God of glory thundereth: the LORD is upon many waters. (thundereth= thunder, but also any low pitch, loud rumbling...earthquake, tornado, etc)
- ⁴The voice of the LORD is powerful; the voice of the LORD is full of majesty.
- ⁵The voice of the LORD breaketh the cedars; yea, the LORD breaketh the cedars of Lebanon.
- ⁶He maketh them also to skip like a calf; Lebanon and <u>Sirion</u> like a young <u>unicorn</u>. (<u>unicorn= wild ox or bull</u>) (<u>Sirion= Mt. Hermon</u>)
- ⁷The voice of the LORD divideth the flames of fire.
- ⁸The voice of the LORD shaketh the wilderness; the LORD shaketh the wilderness of Kadesh.
- The voice of the LORD maketh the hinds to calve, and discovereth the forests: and in his temple doth every one speak of his glory.
- ¹⁰ The LORD sitteth upon the <u>flood</u>; yea, the LORD sitteth King for ever. (flood= specifically the flood of Noah, in the Hebrew) (Prophetically the flood of lies from Satan)
- ¹¹The LORD will give strength unto his people; the LORD will bless his people with peace.

Psalms 26 -> 29 were written when David was escaping Absalom to avoid a civil war.
