

Jeremiah 46

King James Version (KJV)

46 The word of the LORD which came to Jeremiah the prophet against the Gentiles; **(This is God's message to the heathen nations – both in history & in prophecy)**

²Against Egypt, against the army of Pharaohnecho king of Egypt, which was by the river Euphrates in Carchemish, which Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon smote in the fourth year of Jehoiakim the son of Josiah king of Judah. **(necho = lame; Pharaoh must have been lame or crippled)**

³Order ye the buckler and shield, and draw near to battle.

⁴Harness the horses; and get up, ye horsemen, and stand forth with your helmets; furbish the spears, and put on the brigandines. **(brigandines - a coat of mail – body armor)**

⁵Wherefore have I seen them dismayed and turned away back? and their mighty ones are beaten down, and are fled apace, and look not back: for fear was round about, saith the LORD. **(They will fight against the Babylonians and lose. This was God's judgment; because they were always there to lure Israel closer to them and away from God)**

⁶Let not the swift flee away, nor the mighty man escape; they shall stumble, and fall toward the north by the river Euphrates. **(Euphrates River is the border between our people Israel; and Babylon – the Muslims of today)**

⁷Who is this that cometh up as a flood, whose waters are moved as the rivers? **(It was Babylon then; it is the Muslims today; it will be the locust army of Satan in the end days)**

⁸Egypt riseth up like a flood, and his waters are moved like the rivers; and he saith, I will go up, and will cover the earth; I will destroy the city and the inhabitants thereof. **(The Arab spring of today; the Muslims are responsible for most wars going on in the world today)**

(Islam is a cult of the devil. They live to destroy Judaism and Christianity. They will fail in the end. God will see to that)

⁹Come up, ye horses; and rage, ye chariots; and let the mighty men come forth; the Ethiopians and the Libyans, that handle the shield;

and the Lydians, that handle and bend the bow. (Lydians = Libya of today)

(North Africa today is a den of crime, war, slavery and drugs. It is all perpetuated and controlled by the Muslims)

¹⁰ For this is the day of the Lord GOD of hosts, a day of vengeance, that he may avenge him of his adversaries: and the sword shall devour, and it shall be satiate and made drunk with their blood: for the Lord GOD of hosts hath a sacrifice in the north country by the river Euphrates. (Muslims have been murdering millions of Christians and Jews since they were founded by Mohammad. He murdered tens of thousands of Christians in the city of Medina – the very people who took him in and let him settle there)

(Their religion of Islam is hell-bent on destroying Christians all over the world. The Day of Vengeance will come upon them at the end of this Age. The sword of the Lord is His Word) Revelation-1:15-16

¹¹ Go up into Gilead, and take balm, O virgin, the daughter of Egypt: in vain shalt thou use many medicines; for thou shalt not be cured. See Daniel-11 (Speaks of the king of the north and the king of the south. Could it be Shia Muslims against Sunni Muslims? We will see when it all comes down)

¹² The nations have heard of thy shame, and thy cry hath filled the land: for the mighty man hath stumbled against the mighty, and they are fallen both together. (Their shame is Islam; a false religion of murder, rape and conquest. Allah is not God. Yahoveh is God)

(I Am That I Am = Yahoveh <Hebrew>) See Exodus-3:14

(Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me) John-14:6

¹³ The word that the LORD spake to Jeremiah the prophet, how Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon should come and smite the land of Egypt. (See Josephus Antiquities book 10 for a second witness)

¹⁴ Declare ye in Egypt, and publish in Migdol, and publish in Noph and in Tahpanhes: say ye, Stand fast, and prepare thee; for the sword shall devour round about thee. (This is why God didn't want the remnant of Judah to go to Egypt)

(God wanted that remnant to stay in Judah, and serve the king of Babylon, temporarily; until all Judah could return <70 years later>. They refused to listen, and went into Egypt; only to die there with the Egyptians)

¹⁵ Why are thy valiant men swept away? they stood not, because the LORD did drive them. (They fled to Egypt when God told them to stand fast in Judah)

¹⁶ He made many to fall, yea, one fell upon another: and they said, Arise, and let us go again to our own people, and to the land of our nativity, from the oppressing sword. (It's too late for them. God told them not to go to Egypt. They should have obeyed Him. When Jeremiah tried to tell them the same, they called him a liar)

¹⁷ They did cry there, Pharaoh king of Egypt is but a noise; he hath passed the time appointed. (How difficult is it to defeat a noise? Pharaoh will fall to the Chaldeans. It won't be much of a battle)

¹⁸ As I live, saith the King, whose name is the LORD of hosts, Surely as Tabor is among the mountains, and as Carmel by the sea, so shall he come. (Tabor = a small mound; Carmel = a pleasant place) (Nebuchadnezzar was coming to take it all)

¹⁹ O thou daughter dwelling in Egypt, furnish thyself to go into captivity: for Noph shall be waste and desolate without an inhabitant. (They didn't believe in God, although they knew about Him. They were spiritually dead. Why would the daughters of Israel want to live there?)

²⁰ Egypt is like a very fair heifer, but destruction cometh; it cometh out of the north. (A heifer is a gentle animal, easy to tame, easy to control. The remnant of Judah went to Egypt expecting to find a warhorse; but they only found a heifer that couldn't protect them against Babylon)

²¹ Also her hired men are in the midst of her like fatted bullocks; for they also are turned back, and are fled away together: they did not stand, because the day of their calamity was come upon them, and the time of their visitation. (Her hired men were mercenaries. A paid army has no loyalties. They are in it only for the money. They deserted Egypt when the Babylonians arrived)

²² The voice thereof shall go like a serpent; for they shall march with an army, and come against her with axes, as hewers of wood. (The word serpent here is the same word serpent in the Garden; and the same word serpent that will return as antichrist. It is Satan)

²³ They shall cut down her forest, saith the LORD, though it cannot be searched; because they are more than the grasshoppers, and are innumerable. (Then it was the Babylonians. Today it is the Muslims – the swarmers; the destroyers; the killers)

²⁴ The daughter of Egypt shall be confounded; she shall be delivered into the hand of the people of the north. (It was Babylon then. It will be antichrist and the Kenites in the future)

²⁵ The LORD of hosts, the God of Israel, saith; Behold, I will punish the multitude of No, and Pharaoh, and Egypt, with their gods, and their kings; even Pharaoh, and all them that trust in him: (Today, hundreds of Christian churches are being burned down all over the Muslim world; and millions of Christians are being murdered by them)

²⁶ And I will deliver them into the hand of those that seek their lives, and into the hand of Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon, and into the hand of his servants: and afterward it shall be inhabited, as in the days of old, saith the LORD. (By the Babylonians then; by the Muslims now)

NOTE: (Although Egypt was judged to always be a base nation, it continues to exist. It continues to serve as a barometer for us to know the events that will come about in the end days)

²⁷ But fear not thou, O my servant Jacob, and be not dismayed, O Israel: for, behold, I will save thee from afar off, and thy seed from the land of their captivity; and Jacob shall return, and be in rest and at ease, and none shall make him afraid. (In the last days and on the Lord's Day – those that love and serve Yahoveh will be protected and blessed by Him)

²⁸ Fear thou not, O Jacob my servant, saith the LORD: for I am with thee; for I will make a full end of all the nations whither I have driven thee: but I will not make a full end of thee, but correct thee in measure; yet will I not leave thee wholly unpunished. (We all get what we deserve – God is fair to everyone. We are not without sin, any more than anyone else)

NOTE: (Egypt is one of the oldest nations on earth. It has been a base nation since God judged it, in the days of Moses. It will continue to be a base nation until the end of this Age)
