John 12

King James Version (KJV)

12 Then Jesus six days before the passover came to Bethany, where Lazarus was, which had been dead, whom he raised from the dead. (This was the Passover that the Kenites would murder Jesus. They framed Him in the Roman court and then demanded His execution by crucifixion)

(By now, Jesus' ministry was about three years old. HE had taught and healed many people)

- ²There they made him a supper; and Martha served: <u>but Lazarus was one of them that sat at the table with him</u>. (Jesus truly raised Lazarus from the dead. He wasn't a spirit. He was back in his flesh body, having supper with Jesus and his sisters. This family was good friends with Jesus)
- ³Then took Mary a pound of ointment of <u>spikenard</u>, very costly, and anointed the feet of Jesus, and wiped his feet with her hair: and the house was filled with the odour of the ointment. (Spikenard was a very expensive ointment. She was anointing Jesus for His death, prior to the crucifixion. No one knew it at the time, except Jesus, that this would be His last Passover)
- ⁴Then saith one of his disciples, Judas Iscariot, Simon's son, which should betray him,
- ⁵ Why was not this ointment sold for three hundred pence, and given to the poor? (Judas was the greedy purse carrier for Jesus' church. It is believed that he was a Kenite but there's no proof of that)
- ⁶This he said, not that he cared for the poor; but because he was a thief, and had the bag, and bare what was put therein. (Judas was driven by greed and theft)

NOTE: (Kenites have become the bankers and merchants of the world. They have monopolized their businesses to exert usury upon normal working people. They bribe corrupt government officials and judges to remain in power)

See Revelation-17 (The great harlot, Babylon, is symbolic for their corrupt worldwide system)

- ⁷Then said Jesus, Let her alone: against the day of my burying hath she kept this. (Jesus was informing the disciples as to what was going to happen)
- *For the poor always ye have with you; but me ye have not always. (The greatest gift to all people is Messiah; not alms for the poor. HE gave us salvation and eternal life with God in the Third Age. That includes the poor)
- ⁹ Much people of the Jews therefore knew that he was there: and they came not for Jesus' sake only, but that they might see Lazarus also, whom he had raised from the dead. (The word was spreading about how Jesus had power over life and death. They all knew what Jesus did for Lazarus. He was living proof that Jesus is God)
- ¹⁰ But the chief priests consulted that they might put Lazarus also to death; (They wanted to kill everyone involved, so that they could return to business as usual. They were losing temple membership <and tithes> to Jesus because of all these miracles)
- ¹¹ Because that by reason of him many of the Jews went away, and believed on Jesus. (Jesus' resurrection of Lazarus converted many people to Christianity. How could anyone deny that only God has the power over life and death?)

(The corrupt priests knew that also. They were not innocent. They wanted to commit first degree murder in order to keep their filthy money coming in. That's the mark of a Kenite)

- ¹²On the next day much people that were come to the feast, when they heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem, (This was now 5 days before Passover. Jesus was making His way to Jerusalem)
- ¹³ Took branches of palm trees, and went forth to meet him, and cried, <u>Hosanna</u>: Blessed is <u>the King of Israel</u> that cometh in the name of the Lord. (Hosanna = save us now)

Psalms-118:25 (This became Palm Sunday, celebrated today by Catholics)

NOTE: (Calling Jesus King of Israel will get the attention of the Romans. The people said it; Jesus never did. The Kenites will try to use this against Jesus in the Roman court)

- ¹⁴ And Jesus, when he had found a young ass, sat thereon; as it is written,
- ¹⁵ Fear not, daughter of Sion: behold, thy King cometh, sitting on an ass's colt. Zechariah-9:9 (This is prophecy for the First Advent; Jesus coming humbly into the world, as our savior)

Zechariah-9:10 (This is prophecy for the Second Advent; Jesus returning at the end of this Age on a warhorse as King of kings, Lord of lords)

- ¹⁶ These things understood not his disciples at the first: but when Jesus was glorified, then remembered they that these things were written of him, and that they had done these things unto him. (Hindsight is 20/20. They only understood all of these events after Jesus had been crucified and was resurrected)
- ¹⁷The people therefore that was with him when he called Lazarus out of his grave, and raised him from the dead, bare record.
- ¹⁸ For this cause the people also met him, for that they heard that he had done this miracle. (The many miracles that Jesus performed were undeniable. The Kenite Pharisees were getting desperate)
- ¹⁹ The Pharisees therefore said among themselves, Perceive ye how ye prevail nothing? behold, the world is gone after him. (We're losing our power over the people. We're losing our ability to get their money)
- ²⁰ And there were certain Greeks among them that came up to worship at the feast: (These are Israelites that spoke Greek Hellenists)
- ²¹ The same came therefore to Philip, which was of Bethsaida of Galilee, and desired him, saying, Sir, we would see Jesus.
- ²² Philip cometh and telleth Andrew: and again Andrew and Philip tell Jesus.
- ²³ And Jesus answered them, saying, The hour is come, that the Son of man should be glorified. (It was time that God would open Christianity and salvation to all who believe in Him)
- ²⁴ Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except a corn of wheat fall into the ground and die, it abideth alone: but if it die, it bringeth forth much fruit. (The Bible uses many agricultural metaphors to teach us. By

resurrecting Lazarus, Jesus' ministry grew greatly throughout the region)

(Now, He was also speaking of Himself. Jesus' death on the Roman cross and His resurrection would bring Christianity to exponentially more people, all over the world. It is the basis of Christianity today. The cross is our sign. Christianity brings eternal life to all those who believe)

²⁵ He that loveth his life shall lose it; and he that hateth his life in this world shall keep it unto life eternal. (Choose a spiritual life over a flesh life. That is where our priority should be)

(Don't take part in the sin, lusts and perversions of this world. These are just empty temptations that lead to a spiritual death)

²⁶ If any man serve me, let him follow me; and where I am, there shall also my servant be: if any man serve me, him will my Father honour. (Jesus is God <in the flesh>. Serve Him and you serve God)

²⁷ Now is my soul troubled; and what shall I say? Father, save me from this hour: but for this cause came I unto this hour. (That's the reason that He came to Earth. His death and resurrection bought our salvation. Jesus had no intention of changing that)

(Jesus was asking that the cup of God's wrath pass away from those who will murder Him. It won't. Those who hate God will drink of that cup on judgment day)

²⁸ Father, glorify thy name. <u>Then came there a voice from heaven</u>, saying, I have both glorified it, <u>and will glorify it again</u>. (This voice came directly from Heaven. People there all heard it)

(God will be glorified again at the end of this Age; when He returns as Jesus – King of kings, Lord of lords)

²⁹ The people therefore, that stood by, and heard it, said that it thundered: others said, An angel spake to him. (God's voice is awesome. Very few have heard it while still alive)

³⁰ Jesus answered and said, This voice came not because of me, but for your sakes. (Jesus = God with us. HE wasn't speaking to Himself. God was speaking to the people all around so that they would hear and believe)

³¹ Now is the judgment of this world: now shall the prince of this world be cast out. (Satan is the prince of this world. We are put here on earth to be tested – do we choose to follow God or do we choose the ways of the world) see Revelation-12:6-7

(This thunder will also be the seven thunders that God told John not to write down) Revelation-10:4-7

- ³² And I, if I be lifted up from the earth, will draw all men unto me. (The crucifixion and resurrection of Jesus will begin Christianity; and the salvation of the whole world)
- ³³ This he said, signifying what death he should die. (Jesus was telling them of the coming crucifixion and resurrection)
- ³⁴ The people answered him, We have heard out of the law that Christ abideth for ever: and how sayest thou, The Son of man must be lifted up? who is this Son of man? (They misunderstood. They thought that Jesus, as Christ, would live forever in the flesh)
- ³⁵ Then Jesus said unto them, Yet a little while is the light with you. Walk while ye have the light, lest darkness come upon you: for he that walketh in darkness knoweth not whither he goeth. (The prince of darkness is one of Satan's names. Darkness is symbolic for ignorance and confusion that can lead to death) John-8:12
- ³⁶ While ye have light, believe in the light, that ye may be the children of light. These things spake Jesus, and departed, and did hide himself from them. (Learn the truth while there is time)
- ³⁷ But though he had done so many miracles before them, <u>yet they believed not on him</u>: (The Kenites want Jesus dead. It's not about believing. If they wanted to believe, the miracles would have convinced them)

(The rest of the Jews were so ingrained into the Old Testament ways and traditions of men that they doubted Jesus, regardless of His wisdom and of the many miracles that He performed)

- ³⁸ That the saying of Esaias the prophet might be fulfilled, which he spake, Lord, who hath believed our report? and to whom hath the arm of the Lord been revealed? Isaiah-53:1-3
- ³⁹ Therefore they could not believe, because that Esaias said again,

⁴⁰ He hath blinded their eyes, and hardened their heart; that they should not see with their eyes, nor understand with their heart, and be converted, and I should heal them. Isaiah-6:9-10 (God is keeping the weak willed people ignorant; and therefore, innocent of His murder)

NOTE: (He will do that again in the end days. so that they don't lose their salvation to antichrist. They will not make the first resurrection. But, they will be taught during the Millennium and will have a chance at the second resurrection)

- ⁴¹ These things said Esaias, when he saw his glory, and spake of him.
- ⁴² Nevertheless among the chief rulers also <u>many believed on him</u>; but because of the Pharisees they did not confess him, lest they should be put out of the synagogue: (Nicodemus, Joseph of Aramathea, etc.) (The Kenite priests threatened the people. If they believed on Jesus, they would be thrown out of the synagogue)
- ⁴³ For they loved the praise of men more than the praise of God. (They chose men over God. Never side with men against God. Don't side with antichrist and his one world system against God)
- ⁴⁴ Jesus cried and said, He that believeth on me, believeth not on me, but on him that sent me. (If you've seen me, you've seen the Father) John-14:9-11
- ⁴⁵ And he that seeth me seeth him that sent me. (I and my Father are one) John-10:30

Genesis-1:26 (Let us make man in our image. God made Jesus <a flesh body> in His image. We made our flesh bodies in our image. We were in our spiritual bodies in the First Age. We were there with God)

Also see Isaiah-7:14

 46 I am come a light into the world, that whosoever believeth on me should not abide in darkness. (The name of God: I am; YHVH = I Am that I Am) Exodus-3:14

(Darkness is symbolic for sin, false doctrine and confusion. Light is symbolic for the knowledge of the truth and the wisdom to follow it)

NOTE: (God's name is YHVH <Yahoveh>, not YHWH <Yahweh>; see the Book of Ester. It is written in there 5 times)

⁴⁷ And if any man hear my words, and believe not, I judge him not: for I came not to judge the world, but to save the world. (God will judge all people after the Millennium; after they have all had a real chance to learn God's Word and decide for themselves)

(Most people today go to church and only hear traditions of men instead of God's Word, chapter by chapter, verse by verse. They are Biblically ignorant)

⁴⁸ He that rejecteth me, and receiveth not my words, hath one that judgeth him: <u>the word</u> that I have spoken, the same shall judge him in the last day. (God will judge all of us after the Millennium)

John-1:1 (The Word was with God; the Word was God)

⁴⁹ For I have not spoken of myself; but the Father which sent me, he gave me a commandment, what I should say, and what I should speak. (Jesus is God in the flesh; not His son. HE is His begotten in the flesh)

(We only use 10% of our brain capacity in these flesh bodies. Jesus came into the flesh just like us. HE had a mission – to teach people the Word of God and to open salvation to all people. HE did both flawlessly and perfectly for us; and He did it in a flesh and bones body and mind, just like ours)

⁵⁰ And I know that his commandment is life everlasting: whatsoever I speak therefore, even as the Father said unto me, so I speak. (Jesus taught us by example. Obey the father and be blessed)
