- ² It is like the precious ointment upon the head, that ran down upon the beard, even Aaron's beard: that went down to the skirts of his garments; Leviticus-8:12
- ³ As the dew of <u>Hermon</u>, and as the dew that descended upon the mountains of Zion: for there the LORD commanded the blessing, even life for evermore. (In David's case- let the dew on Hermon, in the north be as blessed as the dew on Zion, in the south) (Hermon refers to the 10 tribes to the north, so it also applies when Hezekiah invited them to the great Passover in Jerusalem, under his rule)

Written when David returned to Jerusalem, after the rebellion of his son Absalom had ended.

Also in Ezekiel-37, Israel will be re-joined as one people.
