BOOK V

Psalm 107

King James Version (KJV)

- **107** O give thanks unto the LORD, for he is good: for his mercy endureth for ever.
- ²Let the redeemed of the LORD say so, whom he hath redeemed from the hand of the enemy; (Let them say thanks to God) (Redeemed by Jesus Christ, from the enemy Satan)
- ³ And gathered them out of the lands, from the east, and from the west, from the north, and from the south. (Prophecy for the last days History for the Israelites who left Egypt)
- ⁴They wandered in the wilderness in a solitary way; they found no city to dwell in.
- ⁵ Hungry and thirsty, their soul fainted in them. (Spiritually see Amos-8:11)
- ⁶Then they cried unto the LORD in their trouble, and he delivered them out of their distresses. (Historically & prophetically)
- And he led them forth by the right way, that they might go to a city of habitation.
- ⁸Oh that men would praise the LORD for his goodness, and for his wonderful works to the children of men!
- ⁹ For he satisfieth the longing soul, and filleth the hungry soul with goodness. Luke-1:53
- ¹⁰ Such as sit in darkness and in the shadow of death, being bound in affliction and iron; Psalm-23:4
- ¹¹ Because they rebelled against the words of God, and contemned the counsel of the most High: (Leave God, HE will leave you)
- ¹²Therefore he brought down their heart with labour; they fell down, and there was none to help. (Because they abandoned God)

- ¹³ Then they cried unto the LORD in their trouble, and he saved them out of their distresses.
- ¹⁴ He brought them out of darkness and the shadow of death, and brake their bands in sunder. (Truth is freedom) (John-8: The truth will set you free)
- ¹⁵ Oh that men would praise the LORD for his goodness, and for his wonderful works to the children of men!
- ¹⁶ For he hath broken the gates of brass, and cut the bars of iron in sunder. (God's Word frees those that follow Him)
- ¹⁷ <u>Fools</u> because of their transgression, and because of their iniquities, are afflicted. (Fools also means perverts)
- ¹⁸ Their soul abhorreth all manner of meat; and they draw near unto the gates of death. Hebrews-5:11-14
- ¹⁹ Then they cry unto the LORD in their trouble, and he saveth them out of their distresses.
- ²⁰ He sent his word, and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions.
- ²¹Oh that men would praise the LORD for his goodness, and for his wonderful works to the children of men!
- ²² And let them sacrifice the sacrifices of thanksgiving, and declare his works with rejoicing.
- ²³ They that go down to the sea in ships, that do business in great waters;
- ²⁴These see the works of the LORD, and his wonders in the deep.
- ²⁵ For he commandeth, and raiseth the stormy wind, which lifteth up the waves thereof.
- ²⁶ They mount up to the heaven, they go down again to the depths: their soul is melted because of trouble.

- ²⁷They reel to and fro, and stagger like a drunken man, and <u>are at their wit's end</u>. (are at their wit's end all their wisdom is swallowed up)
- ²⁸Then they cry unto the LORD in their trouble, and he bringeth them out of their distresses.
- ²⁹ He maketh the storm a calm, so that the waves thereof are still. Mark-4:39->on
- ³⁰ Then are they glad because they be quiet; so he bringeth them unto their desired haven.
- ³¹Oh that men would praise the LORD for his goodness, and for his wonderful works to the children of men!
- ³²Let them exalt him also in the congregation of the people, and praise him in the assembly of the elders.
- ³³ He turneth rivers into a wilderness, and the watersprings into dry ground;
- ³⁴ A fruitful land into <u>barrenness</u>, for the wickedness of them that dwell therein. (barrenness- saltedness.. useless for generations to grow anything)
- ³⁵ He turneth the wilderness into a standing water, and dry ground into watersprings. (For those who obey His commandments and love Him)
- ³⁶ And there he maketh the hungry to dwell, that they may prepare a city for habitation;
- ³⁷ And sow the fields, and plant vineyards, which may yield fruits of increase.
- ³⁸ He blesseth them also, so that they are multiplied greatly; and suffereth not their cattle to decrease.
- ³⁹ Again, they are minished and brought low through oppression, affliction, and sorrow. (They are oppressed by the wicked)
- ⁴⁰ He poureth contempt upon princes, and causeth them to wander in the wilderness, where there is no way. (God avenges the good, upon the wicked)

- ⁴¹ Yet setteth he the <u>poor</u> on high from affliction, and maketh him families like a flock. (poor- the humble before God)
- ⁴²The righteous shall see it, and rejoice: and all iniquity shall stop her mouth. Revelation-20:15
- ⁴³ Whoso is wise, and will observe these things, even they shall understand the lovingkindness of the LORD.
