

Isaiah 49

King James Version (KJV)

(The promise of Messiah)

49 Listen, O isles, unto me; and hearken, ye people, from far; The LORD hath called me from the womb; from the bowels of my mother hath he made mention of my name. (This is prophecy for the coming of Jesus) Isaiah-7:14

(God never asked us to do something the He wouldn't do Himself. In the First Age, when He said – Let us make man in OUR image, He included Himself)

(We became flesh people in our own image <of our spiritual bodies> and Jesus became man in God's image. Jesus is one of God's many offices. HE is God in the flesh)

(Jesus said – If you've seen me, you've seen the Father) John-14:9

²And he hath made my mouth like a sharp sword; in the shadow of his hand hath he hid me, and made me a polished shaft; in his quiver hath he hid me; (Jesus lived a quiet life in Nazareth, until He was ready to begin His ministry)

(The sharp sword of His mouth is His Word) Revelation-19:15-16

³And said unto me, Thou art my servant, O Israel, in whom I will be glorified. (Israel = Prince of God – this word should have been translated, and not transliterated from the Hebrew. It is speaking of Jesus Christ as the Prince of God)

⁴Then I said, I have laboured in vain, I have spent my strength for nought, and in vain: yet surely my judgment is with the LORD, and my work with my God. (Some people might say that Jesus failed at the First Advent – He didn't. HE came as Savior to all who would listen. It's all a part of God's plan. When He returns at the Second Advent, He will come as King of kings, Lord of lords. HE will rule with a rod of iron)

⁵And now, saith the LORD that formed me from the womb to be his servant, to bring Jacob again to him, Though Israel be not gathered, yet shall I be glorious in the eyes of the LORD, and my God shall be my strength.

⁶And he said, It is a light thing that thou shouldest be my servant to raise up the tribes of Jacob, and to restore the preserved of Israel: I will also give thee for a light to the Gentiles, that thou mayest be my salvation unto the end of the earth. (The preserved of Israel are the remnant. They carry God's Word, unchanged, down from generation to generation. They are the reason that we can learn God's Word even today – 2000 years later)

(Even the greatest evils of this corrupt world cannot stop Christianity from going forward. That's because the salvation of Jesus Christ is for ALL peoples who choose to believe in Him)

⁷Thus saith the LORD, the Redeemer of Israel, and his Holy One, to him whom man despiseth, to him whom the nation abhorreth, to a servant of rulers, Kings shall see and arise, princes also shall worship, because of the LORD that is faithful, and the Holy One of Israel, and he shall choose thee. (This will happen on the first day of the Millennium)

Revelation-3:9 (Even the Kenites will bow to Jesus Christ)

⁸Thus saith the LORD, In an acceptable time have I heard thee, and in a day of salvation have I helped thee: and I will preserve thee, and give thee for a covenant of the people, to establish the earth, to cause to inherit the desolate heritages; (God created everything. HE will provide for the faithful)

⁹That thou mayest say to the prisoners, Go forth; to them that are in darkness, Shew yourselves. They shall feed in the ways, and their pastures shall be in all high places. (Jesus frees people spiritually, through the truth of His Word) John-8:32, John-21:15-17

(When we know the truth, we can see this world for what it really is; and not be corrupted by it)

¹⁰They shall not hunger nor thirst; neither shall the heat nor sun smite them: for he that hath mercy on them shall lead them, even by the springs of water shall he guide them. Psalms-121

¹¹And I will make all my mountains a way, and my highways shall be exalted. (Jesus is the only way to salvation. Follow Him and be saved)

John-14:6 (Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me)

¹² Behold, these shall come from far: and, lo, these from the north and from the west; and these from the land of Sinim. (Sinim is believed to be China and the Far East)

¹³ Sing, O heavens; and be joyful, O earth; and break forth into singing, O mountains: for the LORD hath comforted his people, and will have mercy upon his afflicted. (Heaven and earth itself will rejoice when Messiah returns to be our King of kings, Lord of lords)

¹⁴ But Zion said, The LORD hath forsaken me, and my Lord hath forgotten me. (They think that God has forgotten them. He never forgets us. It was Israel who turned their backs to God with their idolatry and perversion)

(All people have to do is repent; and return to living by God's Word, and be blessed. God makes it easy for us. He paid an awful price for our salvation on that Roman cross. We should be grateful and loyal to Him. The choice is ours to make)

Revelation-3:20 (Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me)

¹⁵ Can a woman forget her sucking child, that she should not have compassion on the son of her womb? yea, they may forget, yet will I not forget thee. (God will never forget His children, even if they have forgotten Him. Why don't we believe Him?)

¹⁶ Behold, I have graven thee upon the palms of my hands; thy walls are continually before me. (A figure of speech - God never forgets us)

¹⁷ Thy children shall make haste; thy destroyers and they that made thee waste shall go forth of thee. (When God reclaims Zion, the destroyers will leave in a hurry)

¹⁸ Lift up thine eyes round about, and behold: all these gather themselves together, and come to thee. As I live, saith the LORD, thou shalt surely clothe thee with them all, as with an ornament, and bind them on thee, as a bride doeth. (God took an oath in His own name)

¹⁹ For thy waste and thy desolate places, and the land of thy destruction, shall even now be too narrow by reason of the inhabitants, and they that swallowed thee up shall be far away. (There

will be so many souls that will return home, in the Millennium. The enemy will be gone far away)

²⁰The children which thou shalt have, after thou hast lost the other, shall say again in thine ears, The place is too strait for me: give place to me that I may dwell. (These are the people of the ten northern tribes that were scattered abroad. They will all return)

(It also includes all of the Gentiles who choose Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior. Jesus said – whosoever will believe in me, the same shall be saved) Matthew-24:13, John-3:15-17

(The number of souls that will return to God will be so great, that they will be almost impossible to count. And Yet, God knows each and every one of us by name)

²¹Then shalt thou say in thine heart, Who hath begotten me these, seeing I have lost my children, and am desolate, a captive, and removing to and fro? and who hath brought up these? Behold, I was left alone; these, where had they been? (In the Millennium, all Israel will be reunited as one people. HE never lost a single soul – even throughout all of the centuries)

²²Thus saith the Lord GOD, Behold, I will lift up mine hand to the Gentiles, and set up my standard to the people: and they shall bring thy sons in their arms, and thy daughters shall be carried upon their shoulders. (Jesus Christ <God in flesh form> is our standard. That is why we call ourselves Christians) see Isaiah-7:14

(All the ethnos <the ethnic peoples> that love God will arrive as well. God loves all of His children)

²³And kings shall be thy nursing fathers, and their queens thy nursing mothers: they shall bow down to thee with their face toward the earth, and lick up the dust of thy feet; and thou shalt know that I am the LORD: for they shall not be ashamed that wait for me. (These are the people that didn't fall off to the false messiah, at the 6th Trump. All faithful peoples will bow to Jesus Christ on the first day of the Millennium)

²⁴Shall the prey be taken from the mighty, or the lawful captive delivered?

²⁵ But thus saith the LORD, Even the captives of the mighty shall be taken away, and the prey of the terrible shall be delivered: for I will contend with him that contendeth with thee, and I will save thy children. (God will free all of his children from the captors, no matter how strong the captors are. No one can stand against Almighty God. HE can defeat them all with a single Word)

²⁶ And I will feed them that oppress thee with their own flesh; and they shall be drunken with their own blood, as with sweet wine: and all flesh shall know that I the LORD am thy Saviour and thy Redeemer, the mighty One of Jacob. (sweet wine= new wine, not fully finished)
(Everyone will finally know that there is a God in heaven. HIS name is Yahoveh – YHVH = I Am That I Am)
