

Ezekiel 6

King James Version (KJV)

6 And the word of the LORD came unto me, saying,

² Son of man, set thy face toward the mountains of Israel, and prophesy against them, (Mountains are symbolic for countries)

(This prophecy is about the 10 northern tribes. After they were released by Medial Persia, they migrated over the Caucasus Mountains and became known as Caucasians. Today, they are the countries of Western Europe, Canada and the US <the Christian western nations>)

³ And say, Ye mountains of Israel, hear the word of the Lord GOD; Thus saith the Lord GOD to the mountains, and to the hills, to the rivers, and to the valleys; Behold, I, even I, will bring a sword upon you, and I will destroy your high places. (Ye mountains of Israel - the nations that have been established by the descendants of the 12 tribes <Western Europe, the US and Canada> (Their high places were for the worship of idols))

(Even today, Christians celebrate Easter <a pagan fertility ritual to the false goddess Ishtar>. God told us to celebrate Passover. Celebrating Easter is an insult and an abomination to Almighty God)

⁴ And your altars shall be desolate, and your images shall be broken: and I will cast down your slain men before your idols. (Look at the churches today. They are losing membership because they teach traditions of men instead of God's Word – chapter by chapter, verse by verse)

(People are spiritually dead today. No one knows the true Word of God anymore; because most preachers don't teach the Bible – chapter by chapter, verse by verse)

⁵ And I will lay the dead carcasses of the children of Israel before their idols; and I will scatter your bones round about your altars. (This desecrates their altars)

See Exekiel-37 (The valley of the dry bones – symbolic for the spiritually dead people who don't know God's Word)

⁶ In all your dwellingplaces the cities shall be laid waste, and the high places shall be desolate; that your altars may be laid waste and made

desolate, and your idols may be broken and cease, and your images may be cut down, and your works may be abolished.

⁷ And the slain shall fall in the midst of you, and ye shall know that I am the LORD. (The slain are the spiritually dead; atheists, agnostics, false Christians; who practice traditions of men, like Easter)

(In the end, they will all know that there is a God in Heaven)

⁸ Yet will I leave a remnant, that ye may have some that shall escape the sword among the nations, when ye shall be scattered through the countries. (That remnant is still going strong today. They are teaching God's Word, unchanged; chapter by chapter, verse by verse. They will carry on until the end times; when the Elect will be bought up before antichrist to testify before the whole world) see Romans-11

⁹ And they that escape of you shall remember me among the nations whither they shall be carried captives, because I am broken with their whorish heart, which hath departed from me, and with their eyes, which go a whoring after their idols: and they shall lothe themselves for the evils which they have committed in all their abominations. (they that escape - those people who know God's Word will escape the deception and lies of the antichrist. They will remain true to God)

(Because I **am** broken with their whorish heart = because I **have** broken their whorish hearts – the Aramaic translation. It's a more accurate translation than the Greek or English Bibles)

(which go a whoring after their idols – God sees idol worship the way that we see adultery. It is a betrayal of the worst kind)

¹⁰ And they shall know that I am the LORD, and that I have not said in vain that I would do this evil unto them. (This judgment is for their never-ending sins) (evil = punishment, chastisement, calamity – better translation)

¹¹ Thus saith the Lord GOD; Smite with thine hand, and stamp with thy foot, and say, Alas for all the evil abominations of the house of Israel! for they shall fall by the sword, by the famine, and by the pestilence. (Warn them to get their attention, before judgment falls on them; because Judgment will happen whether they like it or not)

¹² He that is far off shall die of the pestilence; and he that is near shall fall by the sword; and he that remaineth and is besieged shall die by

the famine: thus will I accomplish my fury upon them. (No one can escape God's judgment. Everyone will get what they deserve. The good ones will be rewarded; the evil ones will be punished)

¹³ Then shall ye know that I am the LORD, when their slain men shall be among their idols round about their altars, upon every high hill, in all the tops of the mountains, and under every green tree, and under every thick oak, the place where they did offer sweet savour to all their idols. (Their idols can't save them. Their grove worship will be their death)

NOTE: (Today, grove worship is called Easter. Evil popes brought this pagan spring orgy and grove worship into the church, in order to increase the membership and the tithes. God told us to celebrate Passover, not Easter. God told us to stand against antichrist; not to be "raptured" away before he gets here)

¹⁴ So will I stretch out my hand upon them, and make the land desolate, yea, more desolate than the wilderness toward Diblah, in all their habitations: and they shall know that I am the LORD. (Diblah = fruitful) (They will learn – one way or the other)
