Psalm 148

King James Version (KJV)

- 148 <u>Praise ye the LORD</u>. Praise ye the LORD from the heavens: praise him in the heights. (Hallelujah) then see Job-16:19, Job-25:2
- ²Praise ye him, all his angels: praise ye him, all his <u>hosts</u>. (hosts-God's army)
- ³ Praise ye him, sun and moon: praise him, all ye stars of light.
- ⁴Praise him, ye heavens of heavens, and ye waters that be above the heavens.
- ⁵Let them praise the name of the LORD: for he commanded, and they were created. (God made Hezekiah's sundial go back 10 degrees)
- ⁶He hath also stablished them for ever and ever: he hath made a decree which shall not pass.
- ⁷Praise the LORD from the earth, ye <u>dragons</u>, and all deeps: (dragons-creatures of the deep oceans)
- ⁸ Fire, and hail; snow, and vapours; stormy wind fulfilling his word:
- 9 Mountains, and all hills; fruitful trees, and all cedars:
- ¹º Beasts, and all cattle; creeping things, and flying fowl:
- ¹¹ Kings of the earth, and all people; princes, and all judges of the earth:
- ¹² Both young men, and maidens; old men, and children:
- ¹³ Let them praise the name of the LORD: for his name alone is excellent; his glory is above the earth and heaven. (excellent= exalted)
- ¹⁴ He also exalteth the horn of his people, the praise of all his saints; even of the children of Israel, a people near unto him. Praise ye the LORD. Leviticus-21:21, Exodus-25

Some believe that these last 5 Psalms form a group – each psalm is equivalent to one of the 5 Books of Moses – from-Genesis to Deuteronomy. Also they all begin and end with Hallelujah.
