- **101** I will sing of mercy and judgment: unto thee, O LORD, will I sing.
- ²I will behave myself wisely in a <u>perfect</u> way. O when wilt thou come unto me? I will walk within my house with a <u>perfect</u> heart. (perfect-well intentioned, mature) (perfect- moral innocence)
- ³ I will set no wicked thing before mine eyes: I hate the work of them that turn aside; it shall not cleave to me.
- ⁴A froward heart shall depart from me: I will not know a wicked person. (forward- perverse)
- ⁵ Whoso privily slandereth his neighbour, him will I cut off: him that hath an high look and a proud heart will not I <u>suffer</u>. (suffer- tolerate, endure, accept) Proverbs-6:16
- ⁶ Mine eyes shall be upon the faithful of the land, that they may dwell with me: he that walketh in a <u>perfect</u> way, he shall serve me. (perfect-mature, upright, with integrity)
- ⁷He that worketh deceit shall not dwell within my house: he that telleth lies shall not tarry in my sight.
- *I will early destroy all the wicked of the land; that I may cut off all wicked doers from the city of the LORD. (At Judgment Day)
