

Jeremiah 35

King James Version (KJV)

(This Chapter is an insert <in time> from Chapter-25:1 <about the Kenites>. Judah is falling and the Kenites will be around to take over)

35 The word which came unto Jeremiah from the LORD in the days of Jehoiakim the son of Josiah king of Judah, saying, (See 25:1 to synchronize time wise)

²Go unto the house of the Rechabites, and speak unto them, and bring them into the house of the LORD, into one of the chambers, and give them wine to drink. (Rechabites – house of Rechab – the Kenites – the sons of Cain - the son of Satan and Eve) Genesis-3

See 1Chronicles-2:55 (The Kenites had infiltrated Judah long ago, and had wormed their way into political and religious control of Judah. They were also the scribes <record keepers> for Judah)

³Then I took Jaazaniah the son of Jeremiah, the son of Habaziah, and his brethren, and all his sons, and the whole house of the Rechabites; (This Jeremiah is a Kenite – a descendant of Cain)

(Prophet Jeremiah's father was Hilkiah, and they were from Anathoth, in Benjamin) see Chapter1:1

NOTES: (These are 2 Jeremiahs with completely different agendas and masters)

(Today, Christians need to know the difference between antichrist, who will appear at the 6th Trump and claim to be messiah; and Jesus who won't return until the 7th Trump as the true Messiah)

(Like the 2 Jeremiahs with two agendas back then; there will be 2 messiahs with different agendas in the end days of this Age)

⁴And I brought them into the house of the LORD, into the chamber of the sons of Hanan, the son of Igdaliah, a man of God, which was by the chamber of the princes, which was above the chamber of Maaseiah the son of Shallum, the keeper of the door:

⁵And I set before the sons of the house of the Rechabites pots full of wine, and cups, and I said unto them, Drink ye wine.

⁶But they said, We will drink no wine: for Jonadab the son of Rechab our father commanded us, saying, Ye shall drink no wine, neither ye, nor your sons for ever: (Kenites do not drink wine) 1Chronicles-2:55

NOTES: (Through the centuries, the Muslims also don't drink alcohol. Only one house of the Kenites infiltrated Judah – the house of Rechab. The rest of the Kenites are probably the people that we call the Muslims today – my opinion only)

(Unlike Zedekiah and his ilk, these Kenites would not break their word to their father. Even these Kenites were more credible than Zedekiah and the Jews)

(Wine would later become symbolic for the blood of Christ, when we take communion. The Kenites won't go near it because they are of Satan's lineage)

⁷Neither shall ye build house, nor sow seed, nor plant vineyard, nor have any: but all your days ye shall dwell in tents; that ye may live many days in the land where ye be strangers. (God cursed them with these same words when Cain killed Abel. The earth will not yield her produce for them, because of the righteous blood of Abel) see Genesis-4:9-15

⁸Thus have we obeyed the voice of Jonadab the son of Rechab our father in all that he hath charged us, to drink no wine all our days, we, our wives, our sons, nor our daughters; (Jonadab = Yahoveh the greatest)

(This is a deliberate insult to God, by the Kenites; a man calling himself god the greatest)

(Rechab – a descendant of Cain was one of the Kenite families. There are many Kenite families throughout the world. These people are all Kenites. See Matthew-13:24-30, 36-42 (the parable of the tares)

Matthew-7:16-20 (Jesus said – You will know them by their fruits – by their deeds)

⁹Nor to build houses for us to dwell in: neither have we vineyard, nor field, nor seed:

¹⁰But we have dwelt in tents, and have obeyed, and done according to all that Jonadab our father commanded us. (God commanded them,

not Jonadab. Whether the Kenites like it or not, we are ALL subject to God's judgments. Even His enemies are subject to God's will)

¹¹ But it came to pass, when Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon came up into the land, that we said, Come, and let us go to Jerusalem for fear of the army of the Chaldeans, and for fear of the army of the Syrians: so we dwell at Jerusalem. (The Kenites infiltrated Judah. They subverted the country for control; and to steal their wealth. They had been infiltrating Judah since Israel arrived at the Promised Land in the days of Joshua) 1Chronicles-2:55 also see Revelation-2:9 & 3:9

NOTES: (The Kenites are still here today. They are the world's bankers, city builders, and money men and the politicians. Some are Christian pastors)

(We even see the changes that these "scribes" make every year. Every new publication of the Bible is more and more watered down, to become more politically correct. Without the reference materials available to us to properly correct translation errors or deliberate changes, it would not be possible to fully understand the Word of God)

(You will know good pastors by the way that they teach the Word of God – chapter by chapter, verse by verse. The writers of "sermons" are fakes. We need to learn what God says, not what some pastor wrote down)

Jeremiah-23:21 (God said - I have not sent these prophets, yet they ran: I have not spoken to them, yet they prophesied)

¹² Then came the word of the LORD unto Jeremiah, saying,

¹³ Thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Go and tell the men of Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem, Will ye not receive instruction to hearken to my words? saith the LORD.

¹⁴ The words of Jonadab the son of Rechab, that he commanded his sons not to drink wine, are performed; for unto this day they drink none, but obey their father's commandment: notwithstanding I have spoken unto you, rising early and speaking; but ye hearkened not unto me. (God is pointing out the obedience and respect that the Kenites show their father; while Israel refuses to give God the same respect and obedience)

NOTE: (Muslims are forbidden to drink alcohol. The Kenites have infiltrated many peoples around the world. The word Arab means mixed)

¹⁵ I have sent also unto you all my servants the prophets, rising up early and sending them, saying, Return ye now every man from his evil way, and amend your doings, and go not after other gods to serve them, and ye shall dwell in the land which I have given to you and to your fathers: but ye have not inclined your ear, nor hearkened unto me. (God sent them prophet after prophet to teach them. They deliberately refused to obey God's Word. That is why they lost their country and their blessings)

¹⁶ Because the sons of Jonadab the son of Rechab have performed the commandment of their father, which he commanded them; but this people hath not hearkened unto me:

¹⁷ Therefore thus saith the LORD God of hosts, the God of Israel; Behold, I will bring upon Judah and upon all the inhabitants of Jerusalem all the evil that I have pronounced against them: because I have spoken unto them, but they have not heard; and I have called unto them, but they have not answered. (evil = tumult, trouble – better translation)

(When God takes His blessings away, the world will close in on them and bring them all sorts of trouble. God isn't giving them trouble. HE is letting the world do it)

See Job-1:6-11 (Job did not curse God when he lost his blessings, but he let nay-sayers lead him down the path of confusion and depression for 37 chapters)

Job-38 (Finally, God called Job out and told him to stand up like a man and retake his life for the better. Job obeyed god and regained his blessings from God two fold)

¹⁸ And Jeremiah said unto the house of the Rechabites, Thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Because ye have obeyed the commandment of Jonadab your father, and kept all his precepts, and done according unto all that he hath commanded you: (God respects loyalty; even in His enemies)

¹⁹ Therefore thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Jonadab the son of Rechab shall not want a man to stand before me for ever.
(They will be successful in life. They will always have good leadership)

(Our leaders in the end days will be fools) See Isaiah-3:4

NOTE: (Jehu, king of Judah, took Jonadab up into his own chariot. He didn't recognize one of the fathers of the Kenite families, because he was ignorant of God's Word. What a disgrace for a king of Judah to be made such a fool of. This is an example to people today, so that we know who we are dealing with) 2Kings-10:15
