

2 Kings 11

King James Version (KJV)

(Meanwhile, in Judah)

11 And when Athaliah the mother of Ahaziah saw that her son was dead, she arose and destroyed all the seed royal. (She killed all of her own family so that she could seize power and rule Judah; in her dead son's stead. She is the daughter of Jezebel – pure evil)

² But Jehosheba, the daughter of king Joram, sister of Ahaziah, took Joash the son of Ahaziah, and stole him from among the king's sons which were slain; and they hid him, even him and his nurse, in the bedchamber from Athaliah, so that he was not slain. (Jehosheba's father was Joram, but her mother was not Athaliah)

(Joash was the son of Joram and would become next in line to rule Judah, when he was older. God kept the seed line of David alive through all of this mayhem)

2Chronicles-22:11 (Jehosheba was the wife of Jehoiadah, the high priest of Yahoveh, in Jerusalem)

³ And he was with her hid in the house of the LORD six years. And Athaliah did reign over the land. (During this time, the temple of the Lord was stripped bare, and all the utensils were sent to the house of Baal)

⁴ And the seventh year Jehoiada sent and fetched the rulers over hundreds, with the captains and the guard, and brought them to him into the house of the LORD, and made a covenant with them, and took an oath of them in the house of the LORD, and shewed them the king's son. (He had the Levites also gather there as well)

(Jehoiada, husband to Jehosheba, was the high priest of Yahoveh in Jerusalem. He brought in the Levite priests to also care for; and to teach Joash about the Lord) see 2Chronicles-23:2

(The temple of God was a safe place to keep Joash safe. There was no way that Athaliah would ever enter God's temple)

⁵ And he commanded them, saying, This is the thing that ye shall do; A third part of you that enter in on the sabbath shall even be keepers of the watch of the king's house; (He commanded the military leaders as well as the Levites who served in the temple on the Sabbaths)

⁶And a third part shall be at the gate of Sur; and a third part at the gate behind the guard: so shall ye keep the watch of the house, that it be not broken down. (He was positioning them so that they could protect Joash from Athaliah)

⁷And two parts of all you that go forth on the sabbath, even they shall keep the watch of the house of the LORD about the king. (These are the porters or door keepers)

⁸And ye shall compass the king round about, every man with his weapons in his hand: and he that cometh within the ranges, let him be slain: and be ye with the king as he goeth out and as he cometh in. (As he goes about his day to day activities)

⁹And the captains over the hundreds did according to all things that Jehoiada the priest commanded: and they took every man his men that were to come in on the sabbath, with them that should go out on the sabbath, and came to Jehoiada the priest. (They would rotate duty shifts on the Sabbath days. The Levites were armed as were the soldiers)

¹⁰And to the captains over hundreds did the priest give King David's spears and shields, that were in the temple of the LORD. (They couldn't bring their own weapons to the Temple without raising suspicion, so they used the weapons that were already there. If Athaliah had found out, she would have killed them all)

¹¹And the guard stood, every man with his weapons in his hand, round about the king, from the right corner of the temple to the left corner of the temple, along by the altar and the temple.

¹²And he brought forth the king's son, and put the crown upon him, and gave him the testimony; and they made him king, and anointed him; and they clapped their hands, and said, God save the king. (Every king was instructed to learn the Word of God; and to write his own copy of the Torah) see Deuteronomy-17

¹³And when Athaliah heard the noise of the guard and of the people, she came to the people into the temple of the LORD. (Hey, what's going on here?)

¹⁴And when she looked, behold, the king stood by a pillar, as the manner was, and the princes and the trumpeters by the king, and all the people of the land rejoiced, and blew with trumpets: and Athaliah

rent her clothes, and cried, Treason, Treason. (By now, Athaliah had been ruling Judah for 6 years)

¹⁵ But Jehoiada the priest commanded the captains of the hundreds, the officers of the host, and said unto them, Have her forth without the ranges: and him that followeth her kill with the sword. For the priest had said, Let her not be slain in the house of the LORD. (Don't defile the House of the Lord with the blood of this murderess. Kill her and anyone who sides with her outside; not in the temple)

¹⁶ And they laid hands on her; and she went by the way by the which the horses came into the king's house: and there was she slain.

¹⁷ And Jehoiada made a covenant between the LORD and the king and the people, that they should be the LORD's people; between the king also and the people. (They made a covenant to abandon idolatry and return to Yahoveh as their only God) see Exodus-24

¹⁸ And all the people of the land went into the house of Baal, and brake it down; his altars and his images brake they in pieces thoroughly, and slew Mattan the priest of Baal before the altars. And the priest appointed officers over the house of the LORD. (They were re-establishing the 24 courses of the priests of the temple of God)

¹⁹ And he took the rulers over hundreds, and the captains, and the guard, and all the people of the land; and they brought down the king from the house of the LORD, and came by the way of the gate of the guard to the king's house. And he sat on the throne of the kings. (Joash was 7 years old by then)

²⁰ And all the people of the land rejoiced, and the city was in quiet: and they slew Athaliah with the sword beside the king's house.

²¹ Seven years old was Jehoash when he began to reign. (Jehoash= Joash – Like Jim and James – two versions of the same name)

NOTE: (Athaliah was a type for antichrist in the end times. He will set himself up as god, and rule the world for 5 months. When Jesus returns, antichrist will be brought down and thrown into the pit for 1000 years) See Isaiah-14
