Isaiah 59

King James Version (KJV)

- **59** Behold, the LORD's hand is not shortened, that it cannot save; neither his ear heavy, that it cannot hear: (God is not weak, nor is He deaf)
- ²But your iniquities have separated between you and your God, and your sins have hid his face from you, that he will not hear. (Our sins cause the separation. Sinners leave God, HE doesn't leave them)
- ³ For your hands are defiled with blood, and your fingers with iniquity; your lips have spoken lies, your tongue hath muttered perverseness. (Go against God's Word and evil will walk right in. It will ruin your life)

(Taking God's Word out of our schools and our government has caused us to spiral downward, morally. Look at the world today; rampant crime, abortions, gang violence, gay marriage, false religion, atheism, lying and corrupt government officials, crooked judges, false preachers)

(The only way back into God's graces and blessings is to repent. Change our ways. Leave the ways of the world behind. Get back into learning God's Word and live by His Ten Commandments)

*None calleth for justice, nor any pleadeth for truth: they trust in vanity, and speak lies; they conceive mischief, and bring forth iniquity. (vanity= tuhu in the Hebrew; vanity = emptiness; it's the same word as in Genesis-1:2) (Iniquity = sin, trespass)

(The courts are bought and paid for by the rich and corrupt people. The churches are polluted by false teachers who don't teach God's Word – chapter by chapter, verse by verse)

⁵They hatch <u>cockatrice</u>' eggs, and weave the <u>spider's web</u>: he that eateth of their eggs dieth, and that which is crushed breaketh out into a viper. (cockatrice = serpents; spider's web - a web of lies and deceit)

(Stay away from Satan <the serpent> and the Kenites <his progeny>. They will lead you to a spiritual death)

⁶Their webs shall not become <u>garments</u>, neither shall they cover themselves with their works: their works are works of iniquity, and the act of violence is in their hands.

(False teaching and lies won't get you a place in heaven. Nor will it get you the garments made with fine linens of our righteous acts and our good works) Revalation-19:7-8

- Their feet run to evil, and they make haste to shed innocent blood: their thoughts are thoughts of iniquity; <u>wasting and destruction are in their paths</u>. (Physically crime, violence, destruction injustice; spiritually false teaching, misleading, lies and confusion)
- The way of peace they know not; and there is no judgment in their goings: they have made them crooked paths: whosoever goeth therein shall not know peace. (Follow man and you will be lost. Follow God. Learn the truth and no one can ever deceive you)

(Most churches today read one verse of God's Word, and then go into a 1 hour sermon written by some preacher. That is not what God wants from us. HE wants us to learn His Word, chapter by chapter, verse by verse. Men's sermons are traditions of men. They are worthless in God's eyes)

⁹Therefore is judgment far from us, neither doth justice overtake us: we wait for light, but behold obscurity; for brightness, but we walk in darkness.

(This is the result of following false teachings – confusion, darkness; things don't fit together well. False teaching leads you to think that you see contradictions in God's Word. That is usually due to mistranslation and ignorant preachers)

We grope for the wall like the blind, and we grope as if we had no eyes: we stumble at noon day as in the night; we are in desolate places as dead men. (Spiritually dead, spiritually blind, unable to see the truth; you won't find the truth by hearing false teachings or sermons written by men)

(You can find the truth in God's Word if it is properly translated. There are translation errors in all English language Bibles. But, there are reference books available and good teachers who can correct those errors for you)

- ¹¹ We roar all like bears, and mourn sore like doves: we look for judgment, but there is none; for salvation, but it is far off from us. (That is because of the breach between themselves and God) see verse-2
- ¹² For our transgressions are multiplied before thee, and our sins testify against us: for our transgressions are with us; and as for our iniquities, we know them; (The more we live in the ways of the world, the farther away from God we become)
- ¹³ In transgressing and lying against the LORD, and departing away from our God, speaking oppression and revolt, conceiving and uttering from the heart words of falsehood. (Those who become an enemy of God, with false religions like Islam; or no religion like atheism)
- ¹⁴ And judgment is turned away backward, and justice standeth afar off: for truth is fallen in the street, and equity cannot enter. (We used to be a nation of laws. We used to be a Christian nation that taught God's Word in our schools)

(Today, we see government officials ignoring the laws that they don't like. We see rampant greed and corruption in government and industry. The result is that there is no justice for the oppressed people who want to live a moral and good life)

¹⁵ Yea, truth faileth; and he that departeth from evil maketh himself a prey: and the LORD saw it, and it displeased him that there was no judgment. (There was no judgment for true justice)

(If someone tries to leave the deception and get right with God, the rest of them go after him to destroy him. In Islam, they actually murder anyone who tries to leave that cult)

- ¹⁶ And he saw that there was no man, and wondered that there was no intercessor: therefore his arm brought salvation unto him; and his righteousness, it sustained him. (God came to us as Jesus Christ; to set things right for us. If we believe and follow Him, He saves us)
- ¹⁷ For he put on righteousness as a breastplate, and an helmet of salvation upon his head; and he put on the garments of vengeance for clothing, and was clad with zeal as a cloak. (This is the gospel armor as Paul stated) Ephesians-6:10-18

(Spiritually speaking, Jesus Christ will make war with Satan and all evil, for our benefit. HE will end all evil quickly and for good)

- ¹⁸ According to their deeds, accordingly he will repay, fury to his adversaries, recompence to his enemies; to the islands he will repay recompence. (Everyone everywhere will get exactly what they deserve)
- ¹⁹ So shall they fear the name of the LORD from the west, and his glory from the rising of the sun. When the enemy shall come in like <u>a flood</u>, the Spirit of the LORD shall lift up <u>a standard</u> against him. (Our standard is our Lord Jesus Christ)

Past: (The Kenites told a flood of lies against Jesus. They brought false witnesses to ensure that the Romans would crucify Him)

Future: (The flood is the flood of lies that will be spewed by antichrist and his loyal Kenites. Their lies will confuse and deceive the whole world; except for the Elect who have remained true to God) See Revelation-12:15-17

(NOTE: The prophecy in this verse was foretold 600 years before God came into the world as Jesus Christ; and 2,600 years before the end days before antichrist appears)

Also see verse-17 (There is no rapture. We will all be here. The dragon <Satan> will make war against the remnant <the Elect>. They will stand against him in the end days)

(The Holy Spirit of God will speak through them, to destroy Satan's lies and false doctrine. Many people will wake up out of their stupor from their testimony. This happened once before as stated in Acts-2)

- ²⁰ And the Redeemer shall come to Zion, and unto them that turn from transgression in Jacob, saith the LORD. (Christ is the Kinsman Redeemer of all Christians. All we need to do is to abandon the ways of the world and turn back to Jesus Christ; in repentance, and in learning His Word)
- ²¹ As for me, this is my covenant with them, saith the LORD; My spirit that is upon thee, and my words which I have put in thy mouth, shall not depart out of thy mouth, nor out of the mouth of thy seed, nor out of the mouth of thy seed's seed, saith the LORD, from henceforth and for ever. (God provides a remnant to teach the truth of His Word from

generation to generation. God's Word never changes) see Romans-11, Mark-13:31
