

Jeremiah 15

King James Version (KJV)

15 Then said the LORD unto me, Though Moses and Samuel stood before me, yet my mind could not be toward this people: cast them out of my sight, and let them go forth. (That's because the people of Israel worshipped the idols of the heathen, and refused God and His Word)

(Although Moses and Samuel, those two great prophets and intercessors, convinced God to give the people another chance; He won't do it at this time for these people. By now, they had worn out their welcome)

(God is very patient with us; but there comes a time when it's too late to repent) see 2Peter-3:9

²And it shall come to pass, if they say unto thee, Whither shall we go forth? then thou shalt tell them, Thus saith the LORD; Such as are for death, to death; and such as are for the sword, to the sword; and such as are for the famine, to the famine; and such as are for the captivity, to the captivity. (They will get everything that they deserve. They will be judged for their evil, and punished accordingly)

(Each person must choose his or her own fate – to be a captive to God; or to be a captive to the world. Salvation is a personal choice and no longer a national choice)

Revelation-10:9-11 (And I went unto the angel, and said unto him, Give me the little book. And he said unto me, Take it, and eat it up; and it shall make thy belly bitter, but it shall be in thy mouth sweet as honey.

And I took the little book out of the angel's hand, and ate it up; and it was in my mouth sweet as honey: and as soon as I had eaten it, my belly was bitter.

And he said unto me, Thou must prophesy again before many peoples, and nations, and tongues, and kings)

³And I will appoint over them four kinds, saith the LORD: the sword to slay, and the dogs to tear, and the fowls of the heaven, and the beasts of the earth, to devour and destroy. (The sword of the LORD is the Word of God – the truth) Revelation-1:16

(The dogs = male prostitute <in Hebrew> – a term of degradation; the dog describes the sexual position of homosexual sodomy)

(The devourer is one of the 4 stages of the locust – this is the locust army of the end times)

(The destroyer of the end times is antichrist. He murders souls by getting them to turn away from God; and to worship him instead)

⁴And I will cause them to be removed into all kingdoms of the earth, because of Manasseh the son of Hezekiah king of Judah, for that which he did in Jerusalem. (Manasseh means forgetting <in Hebrew>)

(He was one of the most evil kings of Judah. He sacrificed children to Moloch through the fire)

(He closed the temple of God. He returned Judah to worshipping all the heathen idols that his father had removed. And the people went along with it) see 2Kings-21:3

⁵For who shall have pity upon thee, O Jerusalem? or who shall bemoan thee? or who shall go aside to ask how thou doest? (No one will care about them. The people of Jerusalem were seen as fools. They had all of God's blessings; and they threw them all away; in order to worship idols)

NOTE: (The US had God's blessings also. We threw them all away for political correctness, multi-culturalism and false religious doctrines. Now we are the biggest debtor nation. Our enemies no longer respect us and our allies no longer trust us)

⁶Thou hast forsaken me, saith the LORD, thou art gone backward: therefore will I stretch out my hand against thee, and destroy thee; I am weary with repenting. (God is weary of His repenting and giving them yet another chance. They refuse to change, and He has had it)

(God destroyed the nation of Israel, not the people. The people who choose to remain loyal to God are still saved and protected by Him. Those who choose the ways of the world are on their own)

⁷And I will fan them with a fan in the gates of the land; I will bereave them of children, I will destroy my people since they return not from their ways. (The fan is a winnowing fan that scatters the chaff away)

from the grain. God sees these habitual sinners as the chaff. HE always remains faithful to those who remain faithful to Him)

(bereave = to deprive of – God took away their children. After a while, enough is enough. God removed all of His blessings from these losers)

NOTES: (After their captivity, the 10 tribes migrated over the Caucasus Mountains and settled Europe. They became known as Caucasians. Today most of these people think that they are Gentiles. They have lost their heritage through stupidity)

(Today, birth rates in all western Christian countries are way down. They have turned their backs on God. Christian people, in these countries, are mocked and ridiculed; while Muslims are accepted with open arms)

(Democracy has fallen to Socialism and atheism. Prosperity is gone because of corrupt politicians, who only enrich themselves and their rich corporate donors)

⁸Their widows are increased to me above the sand of the seas: I have brought upon them against the mother of the young men a spoiler at noonday: I have caused him to fall upon it suddenly, and terrors upon the city. (This was about Nebuchadnezzar in those days. He came across the Euphrates River. He conquered Judah and all of the surrounding nations – including the Assyrians, who had conquered Israel, 200 years earlier) Jeremiah-27:6-8

(In the future, this will be antichrist coming to seduce people away from God; and into his one world system. He will deceive the whole world for 5 months)

Matthew-24:22 (Jesus shortened the days of Satan's tribulation from 7 years to 5 months – the season of the locust)

⁹She that hath borne seven languisheth: she hath given up the ghost; her sun is gone down while it was yet day: she hath been ashamed and confounded: and the residue of them will I deliver to the sword before their enemies, saith the LORD. (This is spiritual deception, shame and death of the soul. And yet they will eagerly run to worship antichrist because they are Biblically ignorant. They were never taught God's Word – chapter by chapter, verse by verse)

(Jesus said – Let no man deceive you) Matthew-24:4-5

(They will be deceived by the first messiah at the 6th Trump. He is antichrist. Jesus returns as the true Messiah at the 7th Trump)

¹⁰ Woe is me, my mother, that thou hast borne me a man of strife and a man of contention to the whole earth! I have neither lent on usury, nor men have lent to me on usury; yet every one of them doth curse me. (This is an honest man, who remains faithful to God. The world will hate him for his loyalty to God)

NOTE: (In the end days, the world will hate the Elect who remain faithful to God and obey the Ten Commandments. Those who teach the true Word of God will be hated by Christian churches who teach traditions of men)

¹¹ The LORD said, Verily it shall be well with thy remnant; verily I will cause the enemy to entreat thee well in the time of evil and in the time of affliction. (The enemy will afflict the faithful, just as they hated and murdered Jesus)

(But God loves the faithful ones. HE will protect them, even in the end days when antichrist takes over the whole world) See Revelation-9:4

¹² Shall iron break the northern iron and the steel? (Am I made of iron to withstand them? – Moffet translation)

(The antichrist and his minions will come, and no weapons or armies will prevent him. God will allow this to happen; so that the people can be tested; to separate the faithful ones from the deceived ones)

¹³ Thy substance and thy treasures will I give to the spoil without price, and that for all thy sins, even in all thy borders. (Antichrist will take everything from the people. He will even take their worship away from God)

¹⁴ And I will make thee to pass with thine enemies into a land which thou knowest not: for a fire is kindled in mine anger, which shall burn upon you. (This is foretelling of Babylonian captivity. The nation will be completely destroyed by the enemy)

(But even in their captivity, God protected the faithful. They prospered, even in the land of Babylon) See Deuteronomy-32:22; (The song of Moses) Second witness: see Revelation-15:3

¹⁵ O LORD, thou knowest: remember me, and visit me, and revenge me of my persecutors; take me not away in thy long suffering: know that for thy sake I have suffered rebuke. (The nation hated Jeremiah because he prophesied the truth to them)

(This is also a prayer to God, by the Elect who will remain faithful to Him. The world will hate them and persecute them)

¹⁶ Thy words were found, and I did eat them; and thy word was unto me the joy and rejoicing of mine heart: for I am called by thy name, O LORD God of hosts. (The Word of God is uplifting, enlightening and rejuvenating to Christians)

¹⁷ I sat not in the assembly of the mockers, nor rejoiced; I sat alone because of thy hand: for thou hast filled me with indignation. (The Elect will be very few in numbers during the time of Satan's deception. Their indignation will be towards the world and how they treat true Christians)

¹⁸ Why is my pain perpetual, and my wound incurable, which refuseth to be healed? wilt thou be altogether unto me as a liar, and as waters that fail? (These are the deceived people, after having lost the blessings of God. They wonder why they are no longer blessed)

¹⁹ Therefore thus saith the LORD, If thou return, then will I bring thee again, and thou shalt stand before me: and if thou take forth the precious from the vile, thou shalt be as my mouth: let them return unto thee; but return not thou unto them. (Yet God will take them back – IF they repent and return to Him. We all have free will. We need to use it wisely)

(The Elect will prophecy in the end times. Many will wake up and join them – as written in the Book of Joel. It is also written in Acts-2)

²⁰ And I will make thee unto this people a fenced brasen wall: and they shall fight against thee, but they shall not prevail against thee: for I am with thee to save thee and to deliver thee, saith the LORD. (God will make the Elect unshakable and undefeated - even against the whole world of the deceived peoples who are following antichrist. Just as He gave Jeremiah the victory for standing for truth against the people of Judah)

²¹ And I will deliver thee out of the hand of the wicked, and I will redeem thee out of the hand of the terrible. (God redeemed Jeremiah

from the Babylonian captivity. He was allowed to take the daughters of Zedekiah into Egypt, and then to the British Isles. They called him Olin Fallah in Britain)
