- **25** Unto thee, O LORD, do I lift up my soul.
- ²O my God, I trust in thee: let me not be <u>ashamed</u>, let not mine enemies triumph over me. (<u>ashamed</u>= confused)
- ³Yea, let none that wait on thee be ashamed: let them be ashamed which transgress without cause.
- ⁴Show me thy ways, O LORD; <u>teach</u> me thy paths. (teach= goad)
- ⁵Lead me in thy truth, and <u>teach</u> me: for thou art the God of my salvation; on thee do I wait all the day. (teach= goad)
- ⁶Remember, O LORD, thy tender mercies and thy lovingkindnesses; for they have been ever of old.
- ⁷Remember not the sins of my youth, nor my transgressions: according to thy <u>mercy</u> remember thou me for thy goodness' sake, O LORD. (mercy- also means grace)
- *Good and upright is the LORD: therefore will he teach sinners in the way. (Those who wish to learn)
- The meek will he guide in judgment: and the meek will he teach his way. 2Peter-3:9
- ¹⁰ All the paths of the LORD are mercy and truth unto such as keep his covenant and his testimonies.
- ¹¹ For thy name's sake, O LORD, pardon mine iniquity; for it is great.
- ¹² What man is he that <u>feareth</u> the LORD? him shall he teach in the way that he shall choose. (fear also means revere same word in Hebrew)
- ¹³ His soul shall dwell at ease; and his seed shall inherit the earth. (God is the inheritance of the Elect Ezekiel-44)
- ¹⁴The <u>secret</u> of the LORD is with them that <u>fear</u> him; and he will shew them his covenant. (secret= hidden counsel) (fear= revere)
- ¹⁵ Mine eyes are ever toward the LORD; for he shall pluck my feet out of the net. (The net of deception)

- ¹⁶ Turn thee unto me, and have mercy upon me; for I am desolate and afflicted.
- ¹⁷The troubles of my heart are enlarged: O bring thou me out of my distresses.
- ¹⁸ Look upon mine affliction and my pain; and forgive all my sins.
- ¹⁹ Consider mine enemies; for they are many; and they hate me with cruel hatred.
- ²⁰ O <u>keep</u> my soul, and deliver me: let me not be <u>ashamed</u>; for I put my trust in thee. (keep= guard, or hedge, or surround) (ashamed-> see 2Timothy-2:15)
- ²¹ Let integrity and uprightness preserve me; for I wait on thee.
- ²² Redeem Israel, O God, out of all his troubles.
