Psalm 145

David's Psalm of Praise

King James Version (KJV)

- **145** I will extol thee, my God, O king; and I will bless thy name for ever and ever.
- ²Every day will I bless thee; and I will praise thy name for ever and ever.
- ³ Great is the LORD, and greatly to be praised; and his greatness is unsearchable. (We cannot even imagine God's greatness)
- ⁴One generation shall praise thy works to another, and shall declare thy mighty acts.
- ⁵I will speak of the glorious honour of thy majesty, and of thy wondrous works.
- ⁶ And men shall speak of the might of thy <u>terrible</u> acts: and I will declare thy greatness. (terrible- awesome)
- ⁷They shall abundantly utter the memory of thy great goodness, and shall sing of thy righteousness.
- *The LORD is gracious, and full of compassion; slow to anger, and of great mercy. (Similar to the words of Moses in Numbers-14)
- The LORD is good to all: and his tender mercies are over all his works. (to all that wait on Him in the Septuagint)
- ¹⁰ All thy works shall praise thee, O LORD; and thy saints shall bless thee.
- 11 They shall speak of the glory of thy kingdom, and talk of thy power;
- ¹²To make known to the sons of men his mighty acts, and the glorious majesty of his kingdom.
- ¹³Thy kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and thy dominion endureth throughout all generations. (generations= ages)
- 13.5 Faithful is Yahoveh in all His words and holy in all His works.

- ¹⁴The LORD upholdeth all that fall, and raiseth up all those that be <u>bowed down</u>. (Prophetically, bowed down to antichrist Jesus will raise them up again)
- ¹⁵ The eyes of all wait upon thee; and thou givest them their meat in due season. (Meat, not milk -> see the teachings of Paul in 1Corinthians-5)
- ¹⁶ Thou openest thine hand, and satisfiest the desire of every living thing.
- ¹⁷The LORD is righteous in all his ways, and <u>holy</u> in all his works. (holybountiful, kind, gracious better translation)
- ¹⁸ The LORD is nigh unto all them that call upon him, to all that call upon him <u>in truth</u>. (Means there to study God's word. Not going to church to socialize or make business contacts) also see 1Corinthians-2
- ¹⁹ He will fulfil the desire of them that <u>fear</u> him: he also will hear their cry, and will save them. (fear= revere)
- ²⁰ The LORD preserveth all them that love him: but all the wicked will he destroy.
- ²¹ My mouth shall speak the praise of the LORD: and let all flesh bless his holy name for ever and ever.

An acrostic Psalm – each verse starts with a Hebrew letter, except the letter N, which is missing between verse 13 & 14. That verse may have been lost in a copyist error. See verse between 13 & 14, above in red.
