Isaiah 27

King James Version (KJV)

27 In that day the LORD with his sore and great and strong sword shall punish leviathan the piercing serpent, even <u>leviathan</u> that crooked <u>serpent</u>; and he shall slay <u>the dragon</u> that is in <u>the sea</u>. (The sea of peoples) Revelation-17

(The serpent, the leviathan and the dragon are names for Satan) Revelation-12

- ²In that day sing ye unto her, A vineyard of red wine. (The good people will enjoy God's blessings)
- ³ I the LORD do keep it; I will water it every moment: lest any hurt it, I will keep it night and day. (God will care for the vineyard Himself)

(This is a peek into how the Millennium will be. God will rule and He will provide. No one can stand against Him and prevail)

- ⁴Fury is not in me: who would set the briers and thorns against me in battle? I would go through them, I would burn them together. (No one can stand against God. HE protects the good people and He punishes the evil ones)
- Or let him take hold of my <u>strength</u>, that he may make peace with me; and he shall make peace with me. (strength = protection better translation)

(Let the enemy repent and make peace with God, or he won't be around any more. The word hell in the Bible is a mistranslation. The Hebrew word in the manuscripts should be translated grave. Those who refuse to repent and join God will die – along with Satan and his fallen angels. They won't be around in the 3rd Age)

- ⁶He shall cause them that come of Jacob to take root: Israel shall blossom and bud, and fill the face of the world with fruit. (Israel will produce spiritual fruit by bringing the people of the world into God's grace; by teaching them to live by God's Word)
- ⁷Hath he smitten him, as he smote those that smote him? or is he slain according to the slaughter of them that are slain by him? (Did God Smite Israel? Or was Israel slain by his enemies?)

- *In measure, when it shooteth forth, thou wilt debate with it: he stayeth his rough wind in the day of the east wind. (God tempered His punishment of Israel, because many of them had stayed true to Him)
- ⁹ By this therefore shall the iniquity of Jacob be purged; and this is all the fruit to take away his sin; when he maketh all the stones of the altar as chalkstones that are beaten in sunder, the groves and images shall not stand up. (By this chastisement shall all false teachings end. The traditions of men will be purged from the worship of God. Only God's Word will be taught in churches)
- ¹⁰ Yet the defenced city shall be desolate, and the habitation forsaken, and left like a wilderness: there shall the calf feed, and there shall he lie down, and consume the branches thereof. (The defenced city is Jerusalem. It will be desolate when antichrist is there. He will turn it into a wasteland of filth, perversion, selfishness, greed, pride and confusion)
- ¹¹ When the boughs thereof are withered, they shall be broken off: the women come, and set them on fire: for it is a people of no understanding: therefore he that made them will not have mercy on them, and he that formed them will shew them no favour. (The dead wood on a tree harms the tree. It uses up nutrients, but produces no fruit. In fact, it diminishes the tree's ability to produce good healthy fruit on the healthy branches. That's why the dead wood is cut off and burned)

(The evil will be gone. God will prune off the dead wood from the vineyard – these are the evil people & the fallen angels. They lead good people into confusion and sin with their false doctrines)

(for it is a people of no understanding – these are the Kenites – the descendants of Cain. They are the ones who rebelled against God and sided with Satan in the First Age. They will side with Satan again; against God; right to the very end. They will die, along with their evil leader)

¹² And it shall come to pass in that day, that the LORD shall beat off from the channel of the river unto the stream of Egypt, and ye shall be gathered one by one, O ye children of Israel. (These rivers are the Euphrates and the Nile Rivers – the borders of Israel. God will return His people back to Israel)

¹³ And it shall come to pass in that day, that the great trumpet shall be blown, and they shall come which were ready to perish in the land of Assyria, and the outcasts in the land of Egypt, and shall worship the LORD in the holy mount at Jerusalem. (This is the 7th trump and the return of Jesus Christ as Messiah. The whole world will wake up and realize that Jesus is God)

(There is only one God. HE has many offices – the Father <the Creator of all>; Jesus <the Savior>; God's Holy Spirit <the Comforter>; Melchizedek <the man with no parents who walked with Abraham>; the Angel of the Lord <God in angelic form>. God is whoever and whenever He wishes to be)
