King James Version (KJV)

- **114** When Israel went out of Egypt, the house of Jacob from a people of strange language; Exodus-13:3
- <sup>2</sup> Judah <u>was</u> his sanctuary, and Israel his dominion. (was-became)
- <sup>3</sup>The sea saw it, and fled: Jordan was driven back. (God moved both these waters for Israel the Red Sea at the beginning, and the Jordan at the end of Israel's exodus)
- <sup>4</sup>The mountains skipped like rams, and the little hills like lambs. Exodus-19:18
- <sup>5</sup>What ailed thee, O thou sea, that thou fleddest? thou Jordan, that thou wast driven back?
- <sup>6</sup>Ye mountains, that ye skipped like rams; and ye little hills, like lambs?
- <sup>7</sup>Tremble, thou earth, at the presence of the Lord, at the presence of the God of Jacob;
- <sup>8</sup> Which turned the rock into a standing water, the flint into a fountain of waters. (The stone of Destiny Jacob's pillar. God, through Moses, gave them water in the desert for 40 years)
