

## Luke 20

King James Version (KJV)

**20** And it came to pass, that on one of those days, as he taught the people in the temple, and preached the gospel, the chief priests and the scribes came upon him with the elders, (came upon - suddenly, with hostility, as to ambush or confront)

(They were trying to entrap Him. The chief priests, the scribes and the elders were all corrupt temple officials. They hated Jesus because the people were leaving the temple and flocking to learn from Him. That was negatively affecting their tithe profits)

<sup>2</sup>And spake unto him, saying, Tell us, by what authority doest thou these things? or who is he that gave thee this authority? (They are standing before God in the flesh, and asking Him who gave Him the authority)

(The real question should be - who gave them their authority to corrupt the temple; and to replace the Word of God with their made up doctrines?)

NOTE: (The same thing is happening today in Christian churches. They don't teach God's Word chapter by chapter, verse by verse. Instead they preach sermons written by the preacher. So the people learn nothing. They remain Biblically ignorant)

<sup>3</sup>And he answered and said unto them, I will also ask you one thing; and answer me:

<sup>4</sup>The baptism of John, was it from heaven, or of men? (Both John's and Jesus' authority was given directly from Almighty God)

<sup>5</sup>And they reasoned with themselves, saying, If we shall say, From heaven; he will say, Why then believed ye him not? (They knew John was a prophet, but they couldn't admit it; because he was also preaching the true Word of God. They were not)

<sup>6</sup>But and if we say, Of men; all the people will stone us: for they be persuaded that John was a prophet. (These crooks are tripping themselves up on their own lies. They know that they are guilty. They can't admit that because they want their ill gotten gains back)

<sup>7</sup> And they answered, that they could not tell whence it was. (They have no defense for their lies, so they won't answer at all)

<sup>8</sup> And Jesus said unto them, Neither tell I you by what authority I do these things. (You won't answer me, I won't answer you)

<sup>9</sup> Then began he to speak to the people this parable; A certain man planted a vineyard, and let it forth to husbandmen, and went into a far country for a long time. (The vineyard is symbolic for God's planting in the Garden of Eden. It's about the lineage from Adam and Eve down through the ages to Jesus)

NOTE: (The Bible never said that Adam and Eve were the first people on earth. They were the first people in the family that brought us Messiah. There were other people in the world before them. In fact, Cain went to the land of Nod to get a wife)

<sup>10</sup> And at the season he sent a servant to the husbandmen, that they should give him of the fruit of the vineyard: but the husbandmen beat him, and sent him away empty. (The servants are symbolic for God's prophets. They were sent to teach the people about god's Word. That is the fruit of their labor. Instead, they were beaten and killed by the Kenites and by the Israelites)

<sup>11</sup> And again he sent another servant: and they beat him also, and entreated him shamefully, and sent him away empty. (Prophet after prophet down through the years; they were ignored, beaten and killed)

<sup>12</sup> And again he sent a third: and they wounded him also, and cast him out. (They got more and more hostile towards the prophets. They beheaded John the Baptist)

<sup>13</sup> Then said the lord of the vineyard, What shall I do? I will send my beloved son: it may be they will reverence him when they see him. (This is Jesus – God in the flesh; His only begotten)

<sup>14</sup> But when the husbandmen saw him, they reasoned among themselves, saying, This is the heir: come, let us kill him, that the inheritance may be ours. (This is the crucifixion of Jesus. They murdered Him so that they could get back to making money from the temple. Most organized religion today is all about money)

<sup>15</sup> So they cast him out of the vineyard, and killed him. What therefore shall the lord of the vineyard do unto them? (A death sentence would be justice for the murderers of Jesus)

<sup>16</sup> He shall come and destroy these husbandmen, and shall give the vineyard to others. And when they heard it, they said, God forbid. (The priests realize Jesus is speaking about them. The Second Advent of Messiah will not be pleasant for these Kenites)

<sup>17</sup> And he beheld them, and said, What is this then that is written, The stone which the builders rejected, the same is become the head of the corner? (Jesus is the cornerstone for the eternal temple of God. This temple is not a building. It is made up of the Father and the Son <the Begotten – God in the flesh>) Psalms-118:22-26

Also see Revelation-21:22 (That is when it will all be fulfilled)

<sup>18</sup> Whosoever shall fall upon that stone shall be broken; but on whomsoever it shall fall, it will grind him to powder. Psalms-110

<sup>19</sup> And the chief priests and the scribes the same hour sought to lay hands on him; and they feared the people: for they perceived that he had spoken this parable against them. (And they were right. But instead of repenting and changing their ways, they will now plot on how to murder Jesus)

<sup>20</sup> And they watched him, and sent forth spies, which should feign themselves just men, that they might take hold of his words, that so they might deliver him unto the power and authority of the governor. (feign = to fake, play acting. They will make false accusations against Jesus in order to frame Him for crimes that He never committed)

NOTE: (This is how the Kenites work – back then, and still today. You can see them working in their propaganda and their cancel culture of political correctness)

<sup>21</sup> And they asked him, saying, Master, we know that thou sayest and teachest rightly, neither acceptest thou the person of any, but teachest the way of God truly: (Don't fall for flattery. It's the method that Satan uses to entrap people)

<sup>22</sup> Is it lawful for us to give tribute unto Caesar, or no? (They are trying to set Jesus up against Caesar. That would be treason)

<sup>23</sup> But he perceived their craftiness, and said unto them, Why tempt ye me? (God can read minds. Only a fool would try to con Him)

<sup>24</sup> Shew me a penny. Whose image and superscription hath it? They answered and said, Caesar's.

<sup>25</sup> And he said unto them, Render therefore unto Caesar the things which be Caesar's, and unto God the things which be God's. (Pay your taxes to the government. Live lawfully and peacefully in the world. But, give your soul to God by learning and living His Word. There is no conflict between the two)

(Jesus' kingdom is a spiritual one. HE didn't come to us to overthrow the Romans. He came to save souls for the afterlife)

<sup>26</sup> And they could not take hold of his words before the people: and they marvelled at his answer, and held their peace. (HE answered them in front of witnesses; so that the Kenites couldn't lie and twist His words to use against Him)

<sup>27</sup> Then came to him certain of the Sadducees, which deny that there is any resurrection; and they asked him, (The Sadducees didn't believe in an afterlife)

<sup>28</sup> Saying, Master, Moses wrote unto us, If any man's brother die, having a wife, and he die without children, that his brother should take his wife, and raise up seed unto his brother.

<sup>29</sup> There were therefore seven brethren: and the first took a wife, and died without children.

<sup>30</sup> And the second took her to wife, and he died childless.

<sup>31</sup> And the third took her; and in like manner the seven also: and they left no children, and died.

<sup>32</sup> Last of all the woman died also.

<sup>33</sup> Therefore in the resurrection whose wife of them is she? for seven had her to wife. (The Sadducees don't even believe in an afterlife. This is a total setup, trying to entrap Jesus. They are fools if they think that they can out maneuver God's wisdom)

<sup>34</sup> And Jesus answering said unto them, The children of this world marry, and are given in marriage: (world = eon, age <Greek>)

<sup>35</sup> But they which shall be accounted worthy to obtain that world, and the resurrection from the dead, neither marry, nor are given in marriage: (world = eon, age <Greek>)

(These are the people who will make it to eternity – the Third Age. In the Third Age, we will be back in our spiritual bodies, like we were in the First Age. There will be no marriages, nor any children)

<sup>36</sup> Neither can they die any more: for they are equal unto the angels; and are the children of God, being the children of the resurrection. (Spiritual bodies don't age or get sick. Those will be our bodies for the eternity. Moses knew that) see Ecclesiastes-12:6-7

<sup>37</sup> Now that the dead are raised, even Moses shewed at the bush, when he calleth the Lord the God of Abraham, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob. (They died in the flesh, but they live in their spiritual bodies in Paradise)

<sup>38</sup> For he is not a God of the dead, but of the living: for all live unto him. (There are no dead. After we die in the flesh, we all live in Spirit bodies, in Paradise, until judgment. At that time, those who pass judgment will live forever with God in the Third Age. Those who fail will die in the lake of fire) see Matthew-10:28

<sup>39</sup> Then certain of the scribes answering said, Master, thou hast well said. (If they truly agree with Him, why don't they repent and get right with God? They're making a choice to continue to side against God)

NOTE: (This is their chance. They could repent and make the cut on judgment day. Instead, they will murder Jesus to seal their fate – all over money and power. That is pathetic. We see the same thing today with the corrupt rich holding on to their ill gotten gains and power; while losing their salvation)

<sup>40</sup> And after that they durst not ask him any question at all. (They realized that they can't outsmart God. Instead, they will bring in false witnesses to try to frame Him for treason against Caesar)

<sup>41</sup> And he said unto them, How say they that Christ is David's son?

<sup>42</sup> And David himself saith in the book of Psalms, The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit thou on my right hand, **Psalms-110 (David called Christ my Lord)**

<sup>43</sup> Till I make thine enemies thy footstool.

<sup>44</sup> David therefore calleth him Lord, how is he then his son? **(Jesus is God in the flesh. HE is not just a prophet. God came to us in the flesh through the lineage of David – through his son Nathan)**

<sup>45</sup> Then in the audience of all the people he said unto his disciples,

<sup>46</sup> Beware of the scribes, which desire to walk in long robes, and love greetings in the markets, and the highest seats in the synagogues, and the chief rooms at feasts; **(These are the self-righteous hypocrites; powerful in government and in the temple; and rich from ill-gotten gains. They accept tithes, but they don't teach the Word of God. They teach traditions of men instead)**

<sup>47</sup> Which devour widows' houses, and for a shew make long prayers: the same shall receive greater damnation. **(God is speaking of the Kenites. They are only after money and prestige. They pretend to be righteous followers of God in order to get the tithes from the people. They have no mercy on the people whom they rip off. They have no love for God)**
