

Matthew 21

King James Version (KJV)

21 And when they drew nigh unto Jerusalem, and were come to Bethphage, unto the mount of Olives, then sent Jesus two disciples, (Bethphage = house of figs)

²Saying unto them, Go into the village over against you, and straightway ye shall find an ass tied, and a colt with her: loose them, and bring them unto me. (God plans everything ahead of time. Nothing is left to chance. That should give all Christians comfort. No one can stop God's plan from coming to fruition)

³And if any man say ought unto you, ye shall say, The Lord hath need of them; and straightway he will send them. (It was pre-arranged with the owner of the colt – possibly through a dream or a vision)

⁴All this was done, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophet, saying, (God fulfills the prophecies. This prophecy was spoken by Zechariah, 500 years earlier)

⁵Tell ye the daughter of Sion, Behold, thy King cometh unto thee, meek, and sitting upon an ass, and a colt the foal of an ass. Zechariah-9:9 (This is the First Advent)

(Jesus came in humbly on an ass as savior and teacher)

Zechariah-9:10 (Foretells of the Second Advent, at the end of this Age)

(Jesus will come in on a great stallion, as King of kings, Lord of lords; HE will end the corruption of the heathen; and put an end to the persecution of Christians by the Kenites and by antichrist, himself)

⁶And the disciples went, and did as Jesus commanded them,

⁷And brought the ass, and the colt, and put on them their clothes, and they set him thereon.

⁸And a very great multitude spread their garments in the way; others cut down branches from the trees, and strawed them in the way. (People welcomed Jesus as a king. This is going to rile up the Kenites and the corrupt Jews – the Pharisees, the Sadducees, and the temple priests)

⁹ And the multitudes that went before, and that followed, cried, saying, Hosanna to the son of David: Blessed is he that cometh in the name of the Lord; Hosanna in the highest. (Hosanna = save us now)

Psalms-118:21 (Jesus is the stone that the builders <the Kenites> rejected. HE is the Head Stone or corner stone of God's Kingdom)

(The builders of cities are the Kenites) see Genesis-4:17

¹⁰ And when he was come into Jerusalem, all the city was moved, saying, Who is this? (Now it was time for Jesus to become the Passover Lamb – to be sacrificed for the salvation of all who will believe in Him and follow His teachings)

¹¹ And the multitude said, This is Jesus the prophet of Nazareth of Galilee. (Jesus was much more than a prophet. HE was God in the flesh)

¹² And Jesus went into the temple of God, and cast out all them that sold and bought in the temple, and overthrew the tables of the moneychangers, and the seats of them that sold doves, (The Kenites were doing commerce in the temple)

(People were supposed to bring the best that they had to sacrifice to God. Instead they had Kenites selling doves for sacrifice. They were also making big profits, changing money with interest) John-2:14-16

¹³ And said unto them, It is written, My house shall be called the house of prayer; but ye have made it a den of thieves. Jeremiah-7:11

¹⁴ And the blind and the lame came to him in the temple; and he healed them. (This will totally anger the fake Kenite priests. Jesus ruined their money scams; and is healing the sick in the temple)

¹⁵ And when the chief priests and scribes saw the wonderful things that he did, and the children crying in the temple, and saying, Hosanna to the son of David; they were sore displeased, (Hosanna= save us now)

NOTE: (They were all fakes. They couldn't do any of what Jesus was doing. Jesus was taking customers away from them and thus; He was ruining their profits. The Kenites are all about money. They never cared about God or about salvation. They serve Satan)

¹⁶ And said unto him, Hearest thou what these say? And Jesus saith unto them, Yea; have ye never read, Out of the mouth of babes and sucklings thou hast perfected praise? **Psalms-8:2, 1Samuel-17:44-46**

¹⁷ And he left them, and went out of the city into Bethany; and he lodged there. **(Bethany= house of dates)**

¹⁸ Now in the morning as he returned into the city, he hungered.

¹⁹ And when he saw a fig tree in the way, he came to it, and found nothing thereon, but leaves only, and said unto it, Let no fruit grow on thee henceforward for ever. And presently the fig tree withered away. **(Figs were out of season. Jesus knew that there wouldn't be any figs on the tree)**

(This teaching has to do with the parable of the fig tree – the good figs and the bad figs; the children of God <Christians> & the children of Satan <Kenites>; the wheat and the tares)

²⁰ And when the disciples saw it, they marvelled, saying, How soon is the fig tree withered away!

²¹ Jesus answered and said unto them, Verily I say unto you, If ye have faith, and doubt not, ye shall not only do this which is done to the fig tree, but also if ye shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; it shall be done. **(Figs are symbolic of Israel; bad figs are symbolic of the Kenites. Mountains are symbolic of nations. One word in the name of God can move the Kenite nation – if we have the faith)**

²² And all things, whatsoever ye shall ask in prayer, believing, ye shall receive. **(When you are doing the work of God, He will provide what you need to get it done)**

NOTE: (Ignorant people think that this refers to getting things of this world for free from God. It's good to ask God for help in getting work. But He expects us to work to earn the money honestly; so that we can get what we need in this world)

²³ And when he was come into the temple, the chief priests and the elders of the people came unto him as he was teaching, and said, By what authority doest thou these things? and who gave thee this authority? **(These false preachers didn't even know that they were speaking to Immanuel – God with us) see Isaiah-7:14**

(Jesus ruined their money schemes and was now healing people. They couldn't help anyone but themselves. And even then, they could only do that by stealing tithes and temple gifts from the people. Jesus exposed them for what they were)

²⁴ And Jesus answered and said unto them, I also will ask you one thing, which if ye tell me, I in like wise will tell you by what authority I do these things.

²⁵ The baptism of John, whence was it? from heaven, or of men? And they reasoned with themselves, saying, If we shall say, From heaven; he will say unto us, Why did ye not then believe him? (Good question)

²⁶ But if we shall say, Of men; we fear the people; for all hold John as a prophet. (People who spin lies always trip themselves up when they are confronted with the truth)

²⁷ And they answered Jesus, and said, We cannot tell. And he said unto them, Neither tell I you by what authority I do these things. (They can't answer because they are caught up in their own lies)

²⁸ But what think ye? A certain man had two sons; and he came to the first, and said, Son, go work to day in my vineyard. (A parable)

²⁹ He answered and said, I will not: but afterward he repented, and went. (Stubborn, but honest)

³⁰ And he came to the second, and said likewise. And he answered and said, I go, sir: and went not. (a hypocrite)

³¹ Whether of them twain did the will of his father? They say unto him, The first. Jesus saith unto them, Verily I say unto you, That the publicans and the harlots go into the kingdom of God before you. (Because like the second son, they are hypocrites, pretending to do the work of God. But they only pretend to do so in order to get rich from the tithes and their other money schemes)

³² For John came unto you in the way of righteousness, and ye believed him not: but the publicans and the harlots believed him: and ye, when ye had seen it, repented not afterward, that ye might believe him.

³³ Hear another parable: There was a certain householder, which planted a vineyard, and hedged it round about, and digged a winepress in it, and built a tower, and let it out to husbandmen, and

went into a far country: (The householder is God; the vineyard is Israel)

³⁴ And when the time of the fruit drew near, he sent his servants to the husbandmen, that they might receive the fruits of it. (The spiritual harvest)

NOTE: (This is like share cropping in the US. The owner and the workers share the profit)

³⁵ And the husbandmen took his servants, and beat one, and killed another, and stoned another. (These are the prophets that God sent to us. They were abused and murdered by the Kenites)

³⁶ Again, he sent other servants more than the first: and they did unto them likewise. (This is John the Baptist. They imprisoned him and beheaded him)

³⁷ But last of all he sent unto them his son, saying, They will reverence my son. (This is Jesus – the only begotten. They will soon beat Him and crucify Him)

³⁸ But when the husbandmen saw the son, they said among themselves, This is the heir; come, let us kill him, and let us seize on his inheritance. See Psalms-2:1-10

³⁹ And they caught him, and cast him out of the vineyard, and slew him. (They crucified Jesus)

⁴⁰ When the lord therefore of the vineyard cometh, what will he do unto those husbandmen?

⁴¹ They say unto him, He will miserably destroy those wicked men, and will let out his vineyard unto other husbandmen, which shall render him the fruits in their seasons. (They knew the scriptures, and got it right. Yet, they couldn't see that they were the wicked husbandmen in the parable)

⁴² Jesus saith unto them, Did ye never read in the scriptures, The stone which the builders rejected, the same is become the head of the corner: this is the Lord's doing, and it is marvellous in our eyes? Psalms-118 (The cornerstone of salvation is Jesus. HE is now the head stone of Christianity. HE has become a stumbling block to those who reject Him; and to those who have never studied the scriptures)

(Most will be deceived by antichrist. They will end up worshipping him as if he was Jesus)

Also see Genesis-4:11-17 (God told Cain that his progeny would be builders of cities who could no longer farm. The earth will no longer yield her food to them)

⁴³ Therefore say I unto you, The kingdom of God shall be taken from you, and given to a nation bringing forth the fruits thereof.

(Christianity will be the way to salvation, because Judaism failed. It failed because of the corruption by these fake rabbis in all the temples)

(The new Covenant is Jesus and Christianity. It has also become corrupt in most churches. But Jesus left a remnant down through the generations. They continue to teach the Word totally and correctly; chapter by chapter, verse by verse)

⁴⁴ And whosoever shall fall on this stone shall be broken: but on whomsoever it shall fall, it will grind him to powder. **Isaiah-8:14-19**

⁴⁵ And when the chief priests and Pharisees had heard his parables, they perceived that he spake of them. **(They got the message)**

⁴⁶ But when they sought to lay hands on him, they feared the multitude, because they took him for a prophet. **(Instead of repenting, they plotted to commit murder. These false preachers had no redeeming values. They were evil through and through)**
