

Hosea 14

King James Version (KJV)

14 O Israel, return unto the LORD thy God; for thou hast fallen by thine iniquity. (Repent and be saved. It's not too late)

(Some people believe that they have gone too far and cannot be saved. That's not true. God can save anyone who repents and sets things right. He is extremely patient with us. Our Lord is long suffering) see Numbers-14:18, 2Peter-3:9

²Take with you words, and turn to the LORD: say unto him, Take away all iniquity, and receive us graciously: so will we render the calves of our lips. (words = God's Word) (Ask Him to take you back. Repent for your sins. Learn His Word and live by it; and you will be blessed with peace of mind and a happy life)

³Asshur shall not save us; we will not ride upon horses: neither will we say any more to the work of our hands, Ye are our gods: for in thee the fatherless findeth mercy. (Asshur = antichrist – better translation) (Satan's lies and your idols cannot have mercy on you and save you. Only Almighty God can do that)

(The idols that your craftsmen make for you will not save you. They are just lifeless trinkets. Only the true God – the living God of heaven and earth can save you and set you right)

⁴I will heal their backsliding, I will love them freely: for mine anger is turned away from him. (When they wake up from their delusion and return to God, He will save them and return His blessings upon them)

⁵I will be as the dew unto Israel: he shall grow as the lily, and cast forth his roots as Lebanon. (Pleasant, fragrant and insect free; the cedars of Lebanon repel harmful insects)

(God can give us the water of life – eternal life with Him in the Third Age)

⁶His branches shall spread, and his beauty shall be as the olive tree, and his smell as Lebanon. (The fragrance of cedar; the fruitfulness of the olive tree) (We thrive when we live by God's Word, because His Holy Spirit is in us)

⁷They that dwell under his shadow shall return; they shall revive as the corn, and grow as the vine: the scent thereof shall be as the wine of Lebanon. (Those who return to God will prosper because of His grace, His protection and His blessings)

⁸Ephraim shall say, What have I to do any more with idols? I have heard him, and observed him: I am like a green fir tree. From me is thy fruit found. (This is God speaking. A green fir tree does not go dormant in winter. It stays alive and green. God is eternal. HE is the Alpha and the Omega – the first and the last) Revelation-1:8

⁹Who is wise, and he shall understand these things? prudent, and he shall know them? for the ways of the LORD are right, and the just shall walk in them: but the transgressors shall fall therein. (All wisdom comes from learning the Word of God) Proverbs-1:7

(God gave us all a conscience. We all know what is right from what is wrong. If we study God's Word, He opens our spiritual eyes and ears. We become wise on a whole new level. He gives us understanding to recognize the work and progress of the Kenites; as they try to destroy Christianity. They will fail miserably, as will antichrist)

NOTES: (God told Hosea to go marry Gomer the harlot. Gomer means – full of sin. When your son is born, name him Jezreel – which means to scatter and to sow)

(Because of their great sins, Israel was taken captive by the Assyrians. After they were freed, they migrated over the Caucasus Mountains and settled Europe and North America. They became known as Caucasians)

(This Book is a warning to us. Today, most of us have no idea where we came from. Traditions of men, idolatry and atheism are returning in the Christian nations; and we are losing our blessings and our prosperity because of it)
