

Genesis 3

King James Version (KJV)

3 Now the serpent was more subtle than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. And he said unto the woman, Yea, hath God said, Ye shall not eat of every tree of the garden? (Serpent = the beautiful whisperer; the hisser, the deceiver – the Hebrew translation; this is Satan) (beast of the field = all living creatures, all flesh – better translation) (eat = to partake of – better translation)

NOTES: (Why didn't God destroy Satan when he rebelled in the First Age? That's because God is using him to test us. We are all born in the flesh to make a life choice – to live in God's laws and blessings; or to live in the lusts and perversions of Satan and of this world)

(That is the meaning of life that so many philosophers try to learn. It's all plainly written for us in the Bible; but most people never read it)

2 And the woman said unto the serpent, We may eat of the fruit of the trees of the garden: (This serpent is Satan; the beautiful deceiver, the whisperer, the liar. This is not about a snake)

(These trees are the word ets in the Hebrew manuscripts – fruit and nut trees as we know them today)

3 But of the fruit of the tree which is in the midst of the garden, God hath said, Ye shall not eat of it, neither shall ye touch it, lest ye die. (Touch = naga <naw-gah - Hebrew> = to lie with a woman, to have sexual intercourse. This is a very specific word in the manuscripts. It doesn't mean to touch - as it was badly translated in the English)

4 And the serpent said unto the woman, Ye shall not surely die: 2Corintians-11:2-3 (Paul said Eve was beguiled <expatio - Greek>; which means to be wholly seduced; to have sexual intercourse)

5 For God doth know that in the day ye eat thereof, then your eyes shall be opened, and ye shall be as gods, knowing good and evil. (This is the loss of innocence. Once she loses her innocence, Eve will know the difference between good and evil because she will have done evil in the sight of God)

(The word tree = <ets - Hebrew>, comes from the root Aw-tsah <Hebrew> – which means to fasten; make firm. It also means - to close the eyes – to lie or deceive)

(Aw-tseh <Hebrew> means the spine, the backbone - where the limbs are the arms and legs. It is derived from the root Awt-sah. Satan is the “tree” of the knowledge of good and evil because he is the poster child for evil)

(In other Books, God has also referred to people as His plantings or His trees) see Isaiah-61:3

In Hosea (God called Himself – a great Fir Tree; a metaphor for – His leaves don’t die during winter; He is eternal)

Judges-9:17-15 (Satan was the bramble tree – the thorn bush)

⁶ And when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was pleasant to the eyes, and a tree to be desired to make one wise, she took of the fruit thereof, and did eat, and gave also unto her husband with her; and he did eat. (tree was good for food = Satan was handsome, appealing and seductive; he was desirable to partake of - better translation)

(eat = also means to partake of – this is a bad translation – out of context. She partook of Satan – they had sex)

(Satan was as the archangels. He was very good looking to Eve)
(Afterwards, Adam then also “partook of Satan” – in a homosexual affair)

NOTE: (God wasn’t angry because they ate an apple. That’s ridiculous. God was angry because they both immediately fell to sexual perversion – with Satan, of all people)

⁷ And the eyes of them both were opened, and they knew that they were naked; and they sewed fig leaves together, and made themselves aprons. (This happened in a fig grove. They used fig leaves to cover their genitals – the “walk of shame”. This sin is the beginning of the parable of the fig tree)

⁸ And they heard the voice of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day: and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God amongst the trees of the garden. (They were ashamed of what they had done. They were afraid to face God)

⁹ And the LORD God called unto Adam, and said unto him, Where art thou?

¹⁰ And he said, I heard thy voice in the garden, and I was afraid, because I was naked; and I hid myself.

¹¹ And he said, Who told thee that thou wast naked? Hast thou eaten of the tree, whereof I commanded thee that thou shouldest not eat? (eaten = to partaken of) (God knows what they did. HE is testing Adam to see if he will tell the truth)

¹² And the man said, The woman whom thou gavest to be with me, she gave me of the tree, and I did eat. (Adam blames the woman for the whole thing – nothing new here)

¹³ And the LORD God said unto the woman, What is this that thou hast done? And the woman said, The serpent beguiled me, and I did eat. (beguiled = wholly seduced sexually) (eat = to partake of)

(The serpent is one of Satan's names. Serpent – 5175 Hebrew> the hisser or whisperer<of lies>, the charmer; from 5172 – prime root – to hiss or whisper<of magic or a magic spell>, to deceive)

¹⁴ And the LORD God said unto the serpent, Because thou hast done this, thou art cursed above all cattle, and above every beast of the field; upon thy belly shalt thou go, and dust shalt thou eat all the days of thy life: (Satan is called the great serpent all over the Bible. This is not a snake as people are taught by ignorant preachers)

(To crawl in the dust is a statement of degradation. Satan will be considered the lowest of the low – crawling in the dust of the earth)

¹⁵ And I will put enmity between thee and the woman, and between thy seed and her seed; it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his heel. (Their seed is their offspring; their children)

Mathew-13:37-39, John-8:42-44 (Satan's seed begins with Cain, and goes onto his descendants. Satan got Eve pregnant. His descendants are known as the Kenites. They are still around today)

(They will bruise the heel of her seed on the cross <Jesus was descended from Adam and Eve>. HIS heel was bruised on the Roman cross. HE will bruise their heads <Satan's seed> at judgment when He condemns them into the lake of fire – the death of the soul)

NOTE: (This is the first prophecy written in the Bible)

¹⁶ Unto the woman he said, I will greatly multiply thy sorrow and thy conception; in sorrow thou shalt bring forth children; and thy desire shall be to thy husband, and he shall rule over thee. (She will conceive fraternal twins – Cain from Satan, and Abel from Adam)

¹⁷ And unto Adam he said, Because thou hast hearkened unto the voice of thy wife, and hast eaten of the tree, of which I commanded thee, saying, Thou shalt not eat of it: cursed is the ground for thy sake; in sorrow shalt thou eat of it all the days of thy life; (God is not letting Adam blame Eve for all this. He also partook of Satan. He is just as guilty as she is)

¹⁸ Thorns also and thistles shall it bring forth to thee; and thou shalt eat the herb of the field; (He will be a farmer – it's a hard life without farming machinery)

¹⁹ In the sweat of thy face shalt thou eat bread, till thou return unto the ground; for out of it wast thou taken: for dust thou art, and unto dust shalt thou return. (They will both have a difficult life in the flesh because of what they did. Their descendants today, the 12 tribes of Israel, are still persecuted by the other races)

²⁰ And Adam called his wife's name Eve; because she was the mother of all living. (Through Eve would come Jesus, 14 generations later. If you are not in Jesus Christ – a believer - you will not have eternal life)

(Jesus said – I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me) John-14:6

NOTES: (People mistakenly believe that all peoples and races were descended from Eve. That makes no sense. A man and woman cannot have children of different races)

(Some ignorant preachers invented “Lilith” because they can’t understand God’s Word. Cain married a woman from the land of Nod in chapter 4. She was from the 6th day creation. People had been living in the world long before this man Adam and this woman Eve were created. They were not the first man and woman on earth)

²¹ Unto Adam also and to his wife did the LORD God make coats of skins, and clothed them.

²² And the LORD God said, Behold, the man is become as one of us, to know good and evil: and now, lest he put forth his hand, and take also

of the tree of life, and eat, and live for ever: (take – This is a different word in the manuscripts. It's not touch<naga - to lie with a woman>)

(To take of the tree of life is to learn the Word of God and to live it. Christians will have eternal life in the Third Age; if they choose to follow God; and not to follow the ways of the world)

²³ Therefore the LORD God sent him forth from the garden of Eden, to till the ground from whence he was taken. (Adam's progeny would be farmers and herdsmen)

²⁴ So he drove out the man; and he placed at the east of the garden of Eden Cherubims, and a flaming sword which turned every way, to keep the way of the tree of life. (The tree of life is Jesus Christ. In Revelation, His tongue is called a two edged sword. His Word <the Bible> guards Him and His Word. It fights the deceptions of the world) Revelation-1:15-16

NOTE: (If you don't understand how this Age began, you won't understand how it will all end, in Revelation. The Bible is the story of one man's family and of this Second Age)
