

## Isaiah 62

King James Version (KJV)

(God's love for Zion < New Jerusalem> in the eternity)

**62** For Zion's sake will I not hold my peace, and for Jerusalem's sake I will not rest, until the righteousness thereof go forth as brightness, and the salvation thereof as a lamp that burneth. (The light of the world is the truth of God's Word. It brings knowledge and wisdom)

<sup>2</sup>And the Gentiles shall see thy righteousness, and all kings thy glory: and thou shalt be called by a new name, which the mouth of the LORD shall name. (Gentiles = nations, ethnic peoples)

(God will rename Jerusalem. HE will set His throne there)

<sup>3</sup>Thou shalt also be a crown of glory in the hand of the LORD, and a royal diadem in the hand of thy God. (This crown is a bridal crown <in the Hebrew>)

<sup>4</sup>Thou shalt no more be termed Forsaken; neither shall thy land any more be termed Desolate: but thou shalt be called Hephzibah, and thy land Beulah: for the LORD delighteth in thee, and thy land shall be married. (Hephzibah = my delight is in her<Hebrew>) (Beulah = married <Hebrew>)

Ezekiel-48:35 (The LORD is there = Yahoveh-Shamah <in the Hebrew> = God Dwells There)

<sup>5</sup>For as a young man marrieth a virgin, so shall thy sons marry thee: and as the bridegroom rejoiceth over the bride, so shall thy God rejoice over thee. (The marriage of a good man to a good woman is a blessing in this life – the Second Age)

(The marriage of Messiah to His church will be a much greater blessing in the eternity – the Third Age)

<sup>6</sup>I have set watchmen upon thy walls, O Jerusalem, which shall never hold their peace day nor night: ye that make mention of the LORD, keep not silence, (Teach the truth to the people. Teach them the Word of God – chapter by chapter, verse by verse)

<sup>7</sup>And give him no rest, till he establish, and till he make Jerusalem a praise in the earth. (Be a vigilant watchman in order to warn the people of coming danger so that they are prepared. Forewarned is

forearmed. Remind God about His promises, so that He knows that you have read them)

(The reason that Jerusalem will become a praise in the earth, is because God will dwell there)

Ezekie-16 (God made a spiritual covenant with Jerusalem for the eternity. That is where he will set His throne forever)

<sup>8</sup>The LORD hath sworn by his right hand, and by the arm of his strength, Surely I will no more give thy corn to be meat for thine enemies; and the sons of the stranger shall not drink thy wine, for the which thou hast laboured: (We raise it; it's ours to enjoy. There will be no more political and religious parasites to take the fruits of other peoples' labor)

<sup>9</sup>But they that have gathered it shall eat it, and praise the LORD; and they that have brought it together shall drink it in the courts of my holiness. (People will work together, in harmony, under God's fair and just rule)

<sup>10</sup>Go through, go through the gates; prepare ye the way of the people; cast up, cast up the highway; gather out the stones; lift up a standard for the people. (Our standard is the Lord Jesus Christ. We are a Christian nation)

<sup>11</sup>Behold, the LORD hath proclaimed unto the end of the world, Say ye to the daughter of Zion, Behold, thy salvation cometh; behold, his reward is with him, and his work before him. (God's plan will happen just as it was all prophesied; and no one can stop Him)

<sup>12</sup>And they shall call them, The holy people, The redeemed of the LORD: and thou shalt be called, Sought out, A city not forsaken. (Because God will dwell there)
