- **13** How long wilt thou forget me, O LORD? for ever? how long wilt thou hide thy face from me? (David is very low at this time the LORD shall never forsake the faithful.) see Hebrews-13:2-3
- ²How long shall I take counsel in my soul, having sorrow in my heart daily? how long shall mine enemy be exalted over me? (See Psalms 37 The wicked don't get ahead)
- ³ Consider and hear me, O LORD my God: <u>lighten</u> mine eyes, lest I sleep the sleep of death; (<u>lighten-revive</u>. Asking for eyes that see the truth.)
- ⁴Lest mine enemy say, I have prevailed against him; and those that trouble me rejoice when I <u>am moved</u>. (am moved- stumble)
- ⁵ But I have trusted in thy mercy; my heart shall rejoice in thy salvation.
- ⁶I will sing unto the LORD, because he hath dealt bountifully with me. (God blesses those who serve Him)
