Psalm 115

King James Version (KJV)

- **115** Not unto us, O LORD, not unto us, but unto thy name give glory, for thy mercy, and for thy truth's sake.
- ² Wherefore should the heathen say, Where is now their God? (Also prophetic of the end days, when antichrist is here)
- ³ But our God is in the heavens: he hath done whatsoever he hath pleased.
- ⁴Their idols are silver and gold, the work of men's hands. (God made the gold and silver they worship the created, not the Creator)
- ⁵They have mouths, but they speak not: eyes have they, but they see not:
- They have ears, but they hear not: noses have they, but they smell not:
- ⁷They have hands, but they handle not: feet have they, but they walk not: neither speak they through their throat.
- ⁸They that make them are like unto them; so is every one that trusteth in them. (Spiritually, the worshippers are as dead as their idols)
- ⁹O Israel, trust thou in the LORD: he is their help and their shield. Ephesians-6:16
- ¹⁰ O house of Aaron, trust in the LORD: he is their help and their shield.
- ¹¹ Ye that <u>fear</u> the LORD, trust in the LORD: he is their help and their shield. (fear- revere) Verse 9-10-11->three times for emphasis
- ¹²The LORD hath been mindful of us: he will bless us; he will bless the house of Israel; he will bless the house of <u>Aaron</u>. (Aaron-teacher)
- ¹³ He will bless them that <u>fear</u> the LORD, both small and great. (fear- revere)
- ¹⁴ The LORD shall increase you more and more, you and your children.
- ¹⁵Ye are blessed of the LORD which made heaven and earth.

- ¹⁶ The heaven, even the heavens, are the LORD's: but the earth hath he given to the children of men.
- ¹⁷ The dead praise not the LORD, neither any that go down into silence. (This refers to the flesh. Once it dies, it is nothing)
- ¹⁸ But we will bless the LORD from this time forth and for evermore. Praise the LORD. (Our spiritual bodies will live on)
