- **12** Help, LORD; for the godly man ceaseth; for the faithful fail from among the children of men. (Help= save) (for the faithful fail- the faithful vanish. There are less and less every year)
- <sup>2</sup>They speak vanity every one with his neighbour: with flattering lips and with a <u>double heart</u> do they speak. (double heart two faced, undependable)
- <sup>3</sup>The LORD shall cut off all flattering lips, and the tongue that speaketh proud things:
- <sup>4</sup> Who have said, With our tongue will we prevail; our lips are our own: who is lord over us?
- For the oppression of the poor, for the <u>sighing</u> of the needy, now will I arise, saith the LORD; I will set him in safety from him that puffeth at him. (puffeth- speaks vanity, but also means to ensnare. Refers to antichrist) (sighing= to scream or screech loudly)
- <sup>6</sup>The words of the LORD are pure words: as silver tried in a furnace of earth, purified seven times.
- <sup>7</sup>Thou shalt <u>keep</u> them, O LORD, thou shalt preserve them from this generation for ever. (keep= to protect, to shield)
- <sup>8</sup>The wicked walk on every side, when the vilest men are exalted.
