King James Version (KJV)

(John = gift of God)

(John penned the Gospel of John, the three epistles of John and the Book of Revelation. John was the only Apostle who didn't leave Jesus when he was crucified. Jesus gave Mary <His earthly mother> to John, to care for, just before He died)

(These three Epistles are not sent to any one church. John penned them for all people)

1 That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked upon, and our hands have handled, of the Word of life; (Jesus Christ is the Word of Life) see the Gospel of John-1:1

See John-8:44 (was from the beginning – Good and evil. This Age began because of Satan's rebellion against God in the First Age. Those who sided with Satan are born into the world as Kenites. Their progeny has been in the world since Cain, on through today. Down through the centuries they are known as builders of cities and money handlers

bankers, lenders, money changers, developers, merchants, etc...)

NOTES: (The fallen angels are also with Satan. As angels, they mated with the daughters of Adam and were sentenced to die for it at the beginning of the Millennium period) see Jude & Genesis-6

(We are born here to pass through the flesh once to decide – do we follow the ways of God <the good>; or do we follow the ways of this world <the wicked>. That, in a nutshell, is the "meaning of life" that so many people seek to learn)

- ²(For the life was manifested, and we have seen it, and bear witness, and shew unto you that eternal life, which was with the Father, and was manifested unto us;) (Jesus <Immanuel> = God with us) see Isaiah-7:14
- ³That which we have seen and heard declare we unto you, that ye also may have fellowship with us: and truly our fellowship is with the Father, and with his Son Jesus Christ. (John was an eye witness to Jesus' ministry)

(Son = begotten; God begat Himself into the flesh, through Mary. Jesus is God, in the flesh; not His son. Jesus said – If you've seen me, you've seen the Father. Jesus called Himself the son of man. Men called Him the Son of God)

- ⁴And these things write we unto you, that your joy may be full. (John was an eye witness, helping other Christians to believe in Jesus. Our ministry as Christians is also to help others to reinforce their faith)
- ⁵This then is the message which we have heard of him, and declare unto you, that <u>God is light</u>, and in him is no darkness at all. (<u>God <as Jesus > lived a perfect life in the flesh</u>, without any sin. HE did that to teach us; and to show us how to live our lives. Jesus said I am the light of the world) John-8:12
- ⁶ If we say that we have fellowship with him, and walk in darkness, we lie, and do not the truth: (If we truly fellowship with Jesus Christ, darkness <evil> has no hold on us. We are free through Jesus' salvation. Jesus said they shall know the truth and the truth shall set them free) John-8:32
- ⁷ But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin. (The light is the truth, as it is all outlined in the Bible. Jesus is the Living Word of God, who came here to teach us the truth)

NOTE: (Don't let the made up doctrines of false preachers rob you of God's gift to us – the truth, salvation, eternal life with God. Many call themselves Christian preachers, yet they never get around to teaching the Bible chapter by chapter, verse by verse. Instead, they preach sermons that they wrote out of their own imaginations)

- If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. (We all sin. The key is to repent, be forgiven, and try to do better going forward)
- ⁹ If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. (Our sins are forgiven upon repentance, if we truly mean it. Don't try to con God. HE knows what we are thinking)
- If we say that we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us. (We make ourselves a liar also. God hates liars. God's Word is only truth)
