- **143** Hear my prayer, O LORD, give ear to my <u>supplications</u>: in thy faithfulness answer me, and in thy righteousness. (<u>supplications</u>= request or petition)
- ²And enter not into judgment with thy servant: for in thy sight shall no man living be justified.
- ³ For the enemy hath <u>persecuted</u> my soul; he hath smitten my life down to the ground; he hath made me to dwell in darkness, as those that have been long dead. (Persecuted- also means pursued)
- ⁴Therefore is my spirit overwhelmed within me; my heart within me is desolate.
- ⁵I remember the days of old; I meditate on all thy works; I <u>muse</u> on the work of thy hands. (<u>muse-review</u>, <u>contemplate</u>)
- ⁶I stretch forth my hands unto thee: my soul thirsteth after thee, as a thirsty land. Selah. (Spiritually speaking the living waters)
- ⁷Hear me speedily, O LORD: my spirit faileth: hide not thy face from me, lest I be like unto them that go down into the pit.
- ⁸ Cause me to hear thy lovingkindness in the morning; for in thee do I trust: cause me to know the way wherein I should walk; for I lift up my soul unto thee. (Let my affliction be ended by morning. Cause me to walk in the light. Better translation)
- ⁹ Deliver me, O LORD, from mine enemies: I flee unto thee to hide me.
- Teach me to do thy will; for thou art my God: thy spirit is good; lead me into the land of uprightness. (Teach = to goad or guide) (Pray for things to be by God's will, not yours) Also see Galatians-5:22
- ¹¹ Quicken me, O LORD, for thy name's sake: for thy righteousness' sake bring my soul out of trouble.
- ¹² And of thy mercy cut off mine enemies, and destroy all them that afflict my soul: for I am thy servant.
