

## Isaiah 12

King James Version (KJV)

**12** And in that day thou shalt say, O LORD, I will praise thee: though thou wast angry with me, thine anger is turned away, and thou comfortedst me. (Hallelujah = Praise ye the Lord) (God forgives us when we repent and do right)

<sup>2</sup>Behold, God is my salvation; I will trust, and not be afraid: for the LORD JEHOVAH is my strength and my song; he also is become my salvation. (Lord Jehovah = Yah Yahoveh – bad translation)

(Yah = I Am; Yahoveh = I Am That I Am - proper translation. There is no "J" in the Hebrew alphabet; 3068 in the Hebrew dictionary)

(This is God's name; properly documented in this verse <in the Hebrew>) Also see Exodus-3:14

<sup>3</sup>Therefore with joy shall ye draw water out of the wells of salvation. (This is the water of life – the living water that Jesus spoke of) see John-4:10-14

<sup>4</sup>And in that day shall ye say, Praise the LORD, call upon his name, declare his doings among the people, make mention that his name is exalted. (Praise ye the LORD = Hallelujah <Hebrew>)

(Declare all of God's love and blessings upon the people who love Him – down through the ages. We have a lot to be grateful for, and people need to realize that)

<sup>5</sup>Sing unto the LORD; for he hath done excellent things: this is known in all the earth. (God's blessings are there for everyone who wants to love Him and to follow Him)

(God gave us all life, and a beautiful planet to live on. If we choose Him during the time of teaching <the Millennium>, He will give us eternal life with Him in Heaven)

<sup>6</sup>Cry out and shout, thou inhabitant of Zion: for great is the Holy One of Israel in the midst of thee. (God is with us, if we want Him to be) Revelation-3:20 (Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me)
