

Isaiah 26

King James Version (KJV)

26 In that day shall this song be sung in the land of Judah; We have a strong city; salvation will God appoint for walls and bulwarks. (The Lord's Day) (God is our wall of protection, even today)

²Open ye the gates, that the righteous nation which keepeth the truth may enter in. (Truth is the key to the gates. Only those who keep the truth of God's Word are going in. The gates are locked for everyone else)

³Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee: because he trusteth in thee. (The Elect will make the first resurrection because they never fell for Satan's lies. They were the minority who waited for the return of Jesus, as the Messiah at the 7th Trump) see Revelation-20:4-5

⁴Trust ye in the LORD for ever: for in the LORD JEHOVAH is everlasting strength: (JEHOVAH = YAHOVEH - Bad translation; there is no J in the Hebrew) (everlasting strength = the rock of ages – in the Hebrew manuscripts)

⁵For he bringeth down them that dwell on high; the lofty city, he layeth it low; he layeth it low, even to the ground; he bringeth it even to the dust. (The arrogant and prideful will be abased and shamed. The prideful city will be cleansed) see Matthew-24:2-4

⁶The foot shall tread it down, even the feet of the poor, and the steps of the needy. (God will abase the lofty and egoists. HE will elevate the poor and the needy who humble themselves and follow God)

⁷The way of the just is uprightness: thou, most upright, dost weigh the path of the just. (the just = Zadok <Hebrew> - The just are the Elect) (To weigh the path is to make the path level and easy to travel)

⁸Yea, in the way of thy judgments, O LORD, have we waited for thee; the desire of our soul is to thy name, and to the remembrance of thee.

⁹With my soul have I desired thee in the night; yea, with my spirit within me will I seek thee early: for when thy judgments are in the earth, the inhabitants of the world will learn righteousness. (Seek to learn God's Word now. Don't wait until antichrist shows up)

(During the Millennium, everyone will learn God's Word. Some will accept it and live by it; others won't)

¹⁰ Let favour be shewed to the wicked, yet will he not learn righteousness: in the land of uprightness will he deal unjustly, and will not behold the majesty of the LORD. (The wicked ones <Satan and the people who follow him> will never change. They will act just as they did when they were in the flesh. They believed that the right way was to gain an advantage over others; so that they could enrich themselves. They will revert to what they know) Proverbs-1:7

¹¹ LORD, when thy hand is lifted up, they will not see: but they shall see, and be ashamed for their envy at the people; yea, the fire of thine enemies shall devour them. (The evil will envy the Elect; because the Elect will receive God's blessings)

¹² LORD, thou wilt ordain peace for us: for thou also hast wrought all our works in us. (Peace of mind; God does His good works through the Elect)

(People fear the unknown. When we learn God's Word, we know what will happen in the end days. That gives us peace of mind)

¹³ O LORD our God, other lords beside thee have had dominion over us: but by thee only will we make mention of thy name. (We will stay true to God; even through the corrupt leadership of men and the false doctrines of ignorant preachers)

¹⁴ They are dead, they shall not live; they are deceased, they shall not rise: therefore hast thou visited and destroyed them, and made all their memory to perish. (deceased = Raphiam – the fallen angels; This word should not have been translated because it is a proper name)

(The fallen angels have already been judged to death) see Jude & Revelation-11:13 (The instant that Messiah returns, the fallen angels will die)

¹⁵ Thou hast increased the nation, O LORD, thou hast increased the nation: thou art glorified: thou hadst removed it far unto all the ends of the earth. (Many people will finally join Almighty God, at the end of this Age)

¹⁶ LORD, in trouble have they visited thee, they poured out a prayer when thy chastening was upon them. (a prayer = a secret speech – bad translation)

(They only remember God when disaster hits them; but they go right back to their selfish ways as soon as the trouble passes)

¹⁷ Like as a woman with child, that draweth near the time of her delivery, is in pain, and crieth out in her pangs; so have we been in thy sight, O LORD. (When they're in trouble, they cry out like a woman in labor. When things are good, they completely ignore God)

¹⁸ We have been with child, we have been in pain, we have as it were brought forth wind; we have not wrought any deliverance in the earth; neither have the inhabitants of the world fallen. (They are in it for themselves. They never help anyone else. They produce nothing helpful where other people are concerned)

¹⁹ Thy dead men shall live, together with my dead body shall they arise. Awake and sing, ye that dwell in dust: for thy dew is as the dew of herbs, and the earth shall cast out the dead. (Thy dead – the spiritually dead – they will rise to be judged)

(They sparkle as the dew in sunlight; but they will pay for their sins. They will have the Millennium to straighten out and have a chance at the second resurrection)

(the dead = Raphiam – the fallen angels; they have been judged, so that's the end for them. They lost their chance for redemption when they refused to be born in the flesh. Instead, they came as angels to seduce women and to spread their perversion to all people) see Jude & Revelation-11:13

²⁰ Come, my people, enter thou into thy chambers, and shut thy doors about thee: hide thyself as it were for a little moment, until the indignation be overpast. (God protects His people. HE tells them to hide a short time while he cleans out the evil ones)

²¹ For, behold, the LORD cometh out of his place to punish the inhabitants of the earth for their iniquity: the earth also shall disclose her blood, and shall no more cover her slain. (There will be no more murder or wars after God takes over)
