

Ezekiel 1

King James Version (KJV)

(Ezekiel = God (El) strengthens me - Circa 484 BC)

1 Now it came to pass in the thirtieth year, in the fourth month, in the fifth day of the month, as I was among the captives by the river of Chebar, that the heavens were opened, and I saw visions of God. (This Book is during the Babylonian captivity. Judah has been taken by Babylon) (Ezekiel's ministry will last 21 years) (Chebar = a lenth <of time>)

2 In the fifth day of the month, which was the fifth year of king Jehoiachin's captivity, (Jehoiachin was in prison in Babylon. He was re-named Jeconiah <whom Yah has appointed> by Babylon; and later re-named Coniah <appointed>; because he offended God so much. They took God's name out of his. His reign in Judah only lasted 3 months)

3 The word of the LORD came expressly unto Ezekiel the priest, the son of Buzi, in the land of the Chaldeans by the river Chebar; and the hand of the LORD was there upon him. (Ezekiel was a Levite priest)

4 And I looked, and, behold, a whirlwind came out of the north, a great cloud, and a fire infolding itself, and a brightness was about it, and out of the midst thereof as the colour of amber, out of the midst of the fire. (colour of amber= Khash-mal' <Hebrew 2830> - polished bronze or brass. Hebrew language had no words for colors. This is a bad translation)

(God was visiting Ezekiel in person. God's throne was on this flying vehicle)

5 Also out of the midst thereof came the likeness of four living creatures. And this was their appearance; they had the likeness of a man. (These creatures are Cherubim's – from KRB <Hebrew> means to grasp, or to guard. These are the honor guard of God's throne)

6 And every one had four faces, and every one had four wings.

7 And their feet were straight feet; and the sole of their feet was like the sole of a calf's foot: and they sparkled like the colour of burnished brass. (Like landing gear?) (The vehicles looked like polished brass)

8 And they had the hands of a man under their wings on their four sides; and they four had their faces and their wings.

⁹ Their wings were joined one to another; they turned not when they went; they went every one straight forward. (Animals look where they go and turn their heads when they turn. These were machines, not animals. Ezekiel had never seen a flying machine so he had trouble describing it)

¹⁰ As for the likeness of their faces, they four had the face of a man, and the face of a lion, on the right side: and they four had the face of an ox on the left side; they four also had the face of an eagle.

Numbers-2:10->on (These are the four standards of the main tribes of Israel when they were encamped in the desert: Dan – eagle - North; Judah – lion - East; Reuben – man - South; Ephraim – ox - West)

¹¹ Thus were their faces: and their wings were stretched upward; two wings of every one were joined one to another, and two covered their bodies.

¹² And they went every one straight forward: whither the spirit was to go, they went; and they turned not when they went. (They flew in formation)

¹³ As for the likeness of the living creatures, their appearance was like burning coals of fire, and like the appearance of lamps: it went up and down among the living creatures; and the fire was bright, and out of the fire went forth lightning. (Bright lights) (The Shekinah Glory – means that God is there. When people saw God in any of His forms <the Angel of God, Jesus resurrected, etc>, there was a bright radiance around them)

¹⁴ And the living creatures ran and returned as the appearance of a flash of lightning. (They were very fast)

¹⁵ Now as I beheld the living creatures, behold one wheel upon the earth by the living creatures, with his four faces. (One landed on earth)

¹⁶ The appearance of the wheels and their work was like unto the colour of a beryl: and they four had one likeness: and their appearance and their work was as it were a wheel in the middle of a wheel. (they- the vehicles, not the creatures) (Beryl = sapphire)

¹⁷ When they went, they went upon their four sides: and they turned not when they went. (Unlike an animal pulling a cart, they didn't look when they turned. An ox cart was Ezekiel's only point of reference)

¹⁸ As for their rings, they were so high that they were dreadful; and their rings were full of eyes round about them four. (Windows)

¹⁹ And when the living creatures went, the wheels went by them: and when the living creatures were lifted up from the earth, the wheels were lifted up.

²⁰ Whithersoever the spirit was to go, they went, thither was their spirit to go; and the wheels were lifted up over against them: for the spirit of the living creature was in the wheels. (They were inside the craft)

²¹ When those went, these went; and when those stood, these stood; and when those were lifted up from the earth, the wheels were lifted up over against them: for the spirit of the living creature was in the wheels. (The vehicles moved in formation)

²² And the likeness of the firmament upon the heads of the living creature was as the colour of the terrible crystal, stretched forth over their heads above. (terrible = awesome – better translation) (In old English, terrible also meant awesome)

(this could be the bright rainbow above God's head as described in Revelation)

²³ And under the firmament were their wings straight, the one toward the other: every one had two, which covered on this side, and every one had two, which covered on that side, their bodies.

²⁴ And when they went, I heard the noise of their wings, like the noise of great waters, as the voice of the Almighty, the voice of speech, as the noise of an host: when they stood, they let down their wings. (landing gear)

²⁵ And there was a voice from the firmament that was over their heads, when they stood, and had let down their wings. (God's voice in Exodus frightened the Israelites; Revelation describes it as the sound of many rushing waters)

²⁶ And above the firmament that was over their heads was the likeness of a throne, as the appearance of a sapphire stone: and upon the

likeness of the throne was the likeness as the appearance of a man above upon it. (This was God, in person, upon His throne)

²⁷ And I saw as the colour of amber, as the appearance of fire round about within it, from the appearance of his loins even upward, and from the appearance of his loins even downward, I saw as it were the appearance of fire, and it had brightness round about.

Revelation-1:15-16 (The appearance of Jesus. Jesus said – If you have seen the Son, you have seen the Father)

(The trinity is not in the Bible. It was invented by the early church. There is only one God. HE has many offices <Father, Son, His Holy Spirit, Melchizedek, the Angel of God, etc>; not a “trinity” of three Gods as the church teaches)

²⁸ As the appearance of the bow that is in the cloud in the day of rain, so was the appearance of the brightness round about. This was the appearance of the likeness of the glory of the LORD. And when I saw it, I fell upon my face, and I heard a voice of one that spake. (There is a rainbow above God’s head) See Revelation-4

(When people are in the presence of God, they all react this way. They are overwhelmed by His greatness)
