

## Isaiah 11

King James Version (KJV)

**11** And there shall come forth a rod out of the stem of Jesse, and a Branch shall grow out of his roots: (This is Jesus Christ as Messiah. He was descended from David, who was Jesse's youngest son)

(Jesus will return as King of kings, Lord of lords at the 7<sup>th</sup> Trump. HE will rule with a rod of iron. The enemy will be subdued forever)

<sup>2</sup>And the spirit of the LORD shall rest upon him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD; (The 7 spirits of the LORD)

(Jesus is God, in the form of a flesh man. There is only one God. HE has many offices. The office of Jesus is one of them. God is who He wants; when He wants; and where He wants to be at any time)

<sup>3</sup>And shall make him of quick understanding in the fear of the LORD: and he shall not judge after the sight of his eyes, neither reprove after the hearing of his ears: (God doesn't need 2 witnesses in order to judge, as men do; because HE knows what we are thinking)

(HE knew us from the First Age, and He knows us now. HE can see us down to our very soul; because He created us)

<sup>4</sup>But with righteousness shall he judge the poor, and reprove with equity for the meek of the earth: and he shall smite the earth: with the rod of his mouth, and with the breath of his lips shall he slay the wicked. (breath = ruach <Hebrew> = the breath of life, God's Holy Spirit)

(HE will judge by the truth of God's Word) Revelation-1:15-16

<sup>5</sup>And righteousness shall be the girdle of his loins, and faithfulness the girdle of his reins. (God is always faithful to those who love him and follow his Word)

(Living by God's Word gives us a happy, peaceful and prosperous life. It's simply the right way to live. It gives us peace of mind. God doesn't force this on us. The choice is ours to make; but only a fool would choose else wise)

<sup>6</sup>The wolf also shall dwell with the lamb, and the leopard shall lie down with the kid; and the calf and the young lion and the fatling together; and a little child shall lead them. (This is the Millennium. There will be no carnivores on the Lord's Day. There will be no flesh of any kind)

(a child shall lead them – this means that there will be no danger to anyone or anything. All will live in safety and security when God rules)

<sup>7</sup>And the cow and the bear shall feed; their young ones shall lie down together: and the lion shall eat straw like the ox. (All of God's creatures will be in spiritual bodies in the Millennium. There will be no flesh for animals to consume)

<sup>8</sup>And the sucking child shall play on the hole of the asp, and the weaned child shall put his hand on the cockatrice' den. (a figure of speech, because there are no children in spiritual bodies. We are all the same age)

<sup>9</sup>They shall not hurt nor destroy in all my holy mountain: for the earth shall be full of the knowledge of the LORD, as the waters cover the sea. (Everyone will know God. In our spiritual bodies we will have total recall of the First Age and of this Age)

1Corinthians-15:35-44 (We have two bodies - a temporary flesh body, and a spiritual body that never ages. When we die, our flesh body is gone forever. We return to our spiritual bodies)

Ecclesiastes-12:6-7 (Or ever the silver cord be loosed, or the golden bowl be broken, or the pitcher be broken at the fountain, or the wheel broken at the cistern. Then shall the dust return to the earth as it was: and the spirit shall return unto God who gave it)

<sup>10</sup>And in that day there shall be a root of Jesse, which shall stand for an ensign of the people; to it shall the Gentiles seek: and his rest shall be glorious. (This is Jesus. HE is the Lord of all peoples) (His rest = His Sabbath)

<sup>11</sup>And it shall come to pass in that day, that the Lord shall set his hand again the second time to recover the remnant of his people, which shall be left, from Assyria, and from Egypt, and from Pathros, and from Cush, and from Elam, and from Shinar, and from Hamath, and from the islands of the sea. (This is the Second Advent of Jesus, on the Lord's Day. HE gathers the remnant from the north, south, east,

and west. The remnant is the people who stay true to Jesus; against the antichrist)

(They stayed loyal and true to God in the First Age, when Satan rebelled <the Catabole>. They will stay true to God again, in this Age, when Satan <as antichrist> rules the world for 5 months)

<sup>12</sup> And he shall set up an ensign for the nations, and shall assemble the outcasts of Israel, and gather together the dispersed of Judah from the four corners of the earth. (They are still two separate houses – Israel & Judah) (Our ensign <our standard> is Jesus Christ, Himself)

<sup>13</sup> The envy also of Ephraim shall depart, and the adversaries of Judah shall be cut off: Ephraim shall not envy Judah, and Judah shall not vex Ephraim. (They are all the 12 tribes of Israel. They will finally get along together – under Jesus Christ)

<sup>14</sup> But they shall fly upon the shoulders of the Philistines toward the west; they shall spoil them of the east together: they shall lay their hand upon Edom and Moab; and the children of Ammon shall obey them. (They will subdue Islam, because Jesus will lead all people)

(All people are the children of God, regardless of which religion that they followed when they were living in the flesh)

John-14:6-7 (Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me. If ye had known me, ye should have known my Father also: and from henceforth ye know him, and have seen him)

(Jesus is God, in the form of a flesh man)

<sup>15</sup> And the LORD shall utterly destroy the tongue of the Egyptian sea; and with his mighty wind shall he shake his hand over the river, and shall smite it in the seven streams, and make men go over dryshod. (The Suez Canal, the river Euphrates – People will walk on dry land across them. There will be no more borders – peace will be everywhere)

<sup>16</sup> And there shall be an highway for the remnant of his people, which shall be left, from Assyria; like as it was to Israel in the day that he came up out of the land of Egypt. (This is God's protection, day and night; as when Israel walked out of Egypt. There was a cloud for shade in the day; a pillar of fire for light and heat at night)
