

Hebrews 13

King James Version (KJV)

13 Let brotherly love continue. (brotherly love = Philadelphia) see Revelation-3

(The church of Philadelphia exposed who the Kenites are. They are the sons of Cain. He was the son of Satan and Eve) see Genesis-3

NOTE: (That is the key of David – to know the genealogy that brought Jesus <God in the flesh>; from the genealogy that perpetuated the seed of the serpent <the Kenites>. They will lead people right into the arms of antichrist, in the end days. That is called the great apostasy)

² Be not forgetful to entertain strangers: for thereby some have entertained angels unawares. (be vigilant) (angels = fallen angels)

(These strangers will infiltrate any Bible teaching in order to destroy it with false doctrine. This is the Kenites' M.O.)

(entertained angels unawares - In the end days, the fallen angels will return with antichrist. They will mate with Biblically ignorant women, just as they did in Noah's days) see Genesis-6, Jude

³ Remember them that are in bonds, as bound with them; and them which suffer adversity, as being yourselves also in the body. (These are people who are in prison for teaching the word of God; not for committing any crimes)

⁴ Marriage is honourable in all, and the bed undefiled: but whoremongers and adulterers God will judge. (whoremongers = male and female prostitutes; pornographers)

(In the end days, Jesus will return for the great spiritual wedding with His Church. Those who have fallen away to antichrist will have defiled themselves on a spiritual level)

("Woe to those who are with child and give suck in those days." This is speaking spiritually of the Christians who believe antichrist is Messiah. They will worship him and nurse his false religion along to other deceived people) Matthew-24:19

NOTES: (The western Christian nations have all fallen into adultery, prostitution, pornography, homosexuality and other perversions. The

filth that comes out of the "entertainment" industry is disgusting. It pollutes the minds of young people into thinking that accepting perversion is being "open minded". It's not)

(We need to return to God and Christianity in order to set our nation back on the right track. The perverts need to be taken out of our schools and replaced with Christian teachers)

⁵Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have: for he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee. (Do not envy other people. God loves all people equally, provided that they do not forsake Him. That is His promise)

(Fame and fortune are traps set up by Satan. It feeds peoples' egos into putting the ways of the world above the ways of God. If you forsake God for the ways of the world, then He will forsake you)

⁶So that we may boldly say, The Lord is my helper, and I will not fear what man shall do unto me. (God is our source of strength and courage. Have faith in Him. Unlike man, God will never let you down)

⁷Remember them which have the rule over you, who have spoken unto you the word of God: whose faith follow, considering the end of their conversation. (Remember those who teach the Word of God, chapter by chapter, verse by verse. Stay away from the false preachers who preach sermons from their own imagination. God didn't send them) Jeremiah-23:16 & 23:25

⁸Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever. See John-1:1 (Jesus is the Living Word. God's Word never changes. It doesn't need to be updated by the politically correct "prophets" of the modern world. Live by His Word and you cannot go wrong)

Ecclesiastes-1:9 (The thing that hath been, it *is that* which shall be; and that which is done *is* that which shall be done: and there is nothing new under the sun)

⁹Be not carried about with divers and strange doctrines. For it is a good thing that the heart be established with grace; not with meats, which have not profited them that have been occupied therein. (Stay away from false religion. It profits no one in the end)

(Stay away from the ways of the "modern world". Abortion is murder; homosexuality is a sin; prostitution is a sin; perversion destroys the Christian family unit)

NOTE: (The Ten Commandments will stand forever as the law of God. The blood ordinances were fulfilled by Jesus, on the cross)

¹⁰ We have an altar, whereof they have no right to eat which serve the tabernacle. (Jesus fulfilled all the blood sacrifices for all time. HE was the perfect sacrifice for all time. There are no more animal sacrifices or other blood offerings to God)

¹¹ For the bodies of those beasts, whose blood is brought into the sanctuary by the high priest for sin, are burned without the camp. (Even in the Old Testament, the sacrifice was not burned within the temple. It was burned outside on the sacrificial altar)

(That's because burned animal sacrifices were not worthy. They were not capable of bringing salvation to anyone. Only God can give us salvation)

¹² Wherefore Jesus also, that he might sanctify the people with his own blood, suffered without the gate. (As the sacrificial lamb, HE was crucified outside of the temple, on Mount Golgotha)

¹³ Let us go forth therefore unto him without the camp, bearing his reproach. (If you follow Jesus, you will see reproach from the world)

(The Kenites have been trying to destroy Christianity since the beginning. They use atheists and heathen people <Muslims, Taoists, Marxists, Hindus, etc> to work against Christians. They have even tried to turn Jews against us)

¹⁴ For here have we no continuing city, but we seek one to come. (In the afterlife) Revelation-21:20-24

¹⁵ By him therefore let us offer the sacrifice of praise to God continually, that is, the fruit of our lips giving thanks to his name. (God wants our love. That is our offering to Him. That's how we can bless God, like He blesses us)

¹⁶ But to do good and to communicate forget not: for with such sacrifices God is well pleased. (Do good works and help other people to learn the truth about God's Word)

¹⁷ Obey them that have the rule over you, and submit yourselves: for they watch for your souls, as they that must give account, that they may do it with joy, and not with grief: for that is unprofitable for you. (Be a good citizen. Lead others by your good example)

¹⁸ Pray for us: for we trust we have a good conscience, in all things willing to live honestly. (Pray for those who honestly teach God's Word – chapter by chapter, verse by verse)

¹⁹ But I beseech you the rather to do this, that I may be restored to you the sooner.

²⁰ Now the God of peace, that brought again from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant, (God, in the flesh as Jesus, gave us a New Covenant that gives us salvation; if we choose to accept it. That will give us happiness and peace of mind as we go through life)

²¹ Make you perfect in every good work to do his will, working in you that which is well pleasing in his sight, through Jesus Christ; to whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen. (perfect = mature)

Learn God's Word in depth, and be mature in His doctrine; so that you may help others. God will be pleased with you and reward you for your good works)

²² And I beseech you, brethren, suffer the word of exhortation: for I have written a letter unto you in few words. (Use this letter as a reminder)

²³ Know ye that our brother Timothy is set at liberty; with whom, if he come shortly, I will see you. (Paul would see them through Timothy's eyes. At this time, Paul was in a Roman prison. He was under arrest for teaching God's Word)

²⁴ Salute all them that have the rule over you, and all the saints. They of Italy salute you. (Paul had converted many people into Christianity in Rome by this time)

²⁵ Grace be with you all. Amen. (God's grace be with you) (Amen = that's that, so be it)

(Written to the Hebrews by Paul; scribed by Timothy)
