

John 10

King James Version (KJV)

10 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that entereth not by the door into the sheepfold, but climbeth up some other way, the same is a thief and a robber. (Those who enter illegally are - antichrist, false preachers or religionists. They infiltrate into the churches to steal souls with their false doctrines. They do it for money and for power)

² But he that entereth in by the door is the shepherd of the sheep. (This is Jesus Christ. HE is our Shepherd. HE walked into the synagogues and taught openly and boldly)

³ To him the porter openeth; and the sheep hear his voice: and he calleth his own sheep by name, and leadeth them out. (The sheep recognize the shepherd's voice, just as Christians recognize the Living Word. The shepherd calls the sheep, just as Jesus calls the Elect to service)

NOTE: (The apostles didn't volunteer to follow Jesus. Jesus called them and they came. They were approved by Him during the First Age)

⁴ And when he putteth forth his own sheep, he goeth before them, and the sheep follow him: for they know his voice. (They go willingly with the shepherd)

⁵ And a stranger will they not follow, but will flee from him: for they know not the voice of strangers. (know = to know intuitively; not having needed to be taught; to know the right Word from false doctrines)

NOTE: (Antichrist's "worship me and I'll give you free stuff" won't fly with those who know the truth. It will fly with those who sat in pews and listened to a preacher spout off sermons and traditions of men)

⁶ This parable spake Jesus unto them: but they understood not what things they were which he spake unto them. (The disciples didn't understand most of Jesus' parables. Their spiritual eyes were still shut)

⁷ Then said Jesus unto them again, Verily, verily, I say unto you, I am the door of the sheep. (Jesus is the only way to salvation) (Jesus = Yeshua = Yahoveh's Savior <in the Hebrew>)

(God lived in the flesh as Jesus. Therefore, He is the only one qualified to judge us; because He also lived as a man in this Age)

NOTES: (Today, through political correctness, we hear words like accepting and inclusive. This is all false doctrine. We even have gay preachers with gay congregations. We have pedophile priests being protected by the Catholic Church. God called these things an abomination)

(The truth is absolute. You either believe it or you don't. It is not "inclusive" of all. Right is right and wrong is wrong)

⁸All that ever came before me are thieves and robbers: but the sheep did not hear them. (These are Kenites, Pharisees, Sadducees or false teachers pretending to teach God's Word)

(They couldn't deceive the Elect; because the Elect know the truth. Those are the sheep that didn't hear them)

⁹I am the door: by me if any man enter in, he shall be saved, and shall go in and out, and find pasture. (The truth sets us free from lies and confusion. It leads us to salvation)

(Pasture is symbolic for the sheep finding food and rest. A pastor is supposed to feed the sheep and give them knowledge and rest)

(And yet, it is difficult to find a pastor that teaches God's Word, chapter by chapter, verse by verse. Most preach sermons, written out of their own imagination)

¹⁰The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly. (Christianity gives us life – in this world and in the next. It gives us happiness and peace of mind)

(Cults enslave people and don't allow them to leave. Muslims even threaten death to anyone who tries to leave. Antichrist will go as far as to not allow anyone to buy or sell who doesn't worship him. He will starve them into submission, if he can) Revelation-13:17

¹¹I am the good shepherd: the good shepherd giveth his life for the sheep. (Jesus died for our sins, to buy our salvation. HE gives us the choice to join Him or not. We are free to decide)

¹² But he that is an hireling, and not the shepherd, whose own the sheep are not, seeth the wolf coming, and leaveth the sheep, and fleeth: and the wolf catcheth them, and scattereth the sheep. (When trouble comes, the false shepherds will always grab the money and run. They'll abandon the sheep at the drop of a hat)

¹³ The hireling fleeth, because he is an hireling, and careth not for the sheep. (He's only there for the money)

¹⁴ I am the good shepherd, and know my sheep, and am known of mine. (Even the communists of the USSR and of China could not destroy Christianity; although they tried to)

¹⁵ As the Father knoweth me, even so know I the Father: and I lay down my life for the sheep. (Who but a loving God would do that for us? HE didn't have to do that for us. We certainly didn't deserve it. HE did it because He loves us; and He wants to give us eternal life in the Third Age)

¹⁶ And other sheep I have, which are not of this fold: them also I must bring, and they shall hear my voice; and there shall be one fold, and one shepherd. (After the crucifixion, Jesus went to paradise to save many people who had lived their lives under the law; before Jesus came. They didn't have the same chance as we do. So, He taught them His Word and saved many) 1Peter-3:18-20

NOTE: (HE expects Christians to also help others who need help in understanding the Word. Christianity is open to whosoever will believe in Jesus and live by His Word)

¹⁷ Therefore doth my Father love me, because I lay down my life, that I might take it again. (Jesus is God, in the flesh. God, as Jesus, lived a perfect life and defeated death – by His crucifixion, resurrection and ascension into heaven)

(God, as Jesus, was a flesh man just like us. HE had the same emotions as we do. It took an enormous amount of courage for Him to go through the crucifixion. HE could have called an army of angels to save Him if He wanted) Matthew-26:52-54

¹⁸ No man taketh it from me, but I lay it down of myself. I have power to lay it down, and I have power to take it again. This commandment have I received of my Father. (Jesus taught us as a flesh man, just

like the rest of us. HE didn't come down as some supernatural being to look down on us. HE came as one of us to show us the way)

¹⁹ There was a division therefore again among the Jews for these sayings. (the Jews - Pharisees vs. Sadducees. These "Jews" were mostly a bunch of Kenites)

(Pharisees believed in life after death; Sadducees did not. They thought that, once you die, it's over)

²⁰ And many of them said, He hath a devil, and is mad; why hear ye him? (They couldn't intelligently argue against Jesus, so they resorted to name calling and innuendo)

(We see the same today with liberals who defend crimes like abortion and censoring anyone who disagrees with them. They can't argue facts, so they resort to false accusations and smearing peoples' character)

²¹ Others said, These are not the words of him that hath a devil. Can a devil open the eyes of the blind? (That's just common sense. What about all the miracles that Jesus performed? That's difficult to argue against)

²² And it was at Jerusalem the feast of the dedication, and it was winter. (This was a man-made feast - The feast of lights) Joshua-23:13

²³ And Jesus walked in the temple in Solomon's porch. (The Gentiles were only allowed to go this far. They couldn't enter the temple itself)

²⁴ Then came the Jews round about him, and said unto him, How long dost thou make us to doubt? If thou be the Christ, tell us plainly. (The many miracles weren't enough to convince them. What more signs did they need?)

²⁵ Jesus answered them, I told you, and ye believed not: the works that I do in my Father's name, they bear witness of me. (His miracles were His testimony. It's also all written in the manuscripts of the Old Testament. Nothing was hidden from them. They just refused to believe)

²⁶ But ye believe not, because ye are not of my sheep, as I said unto you. (Kenites - sons of Cain; the son of Satan & Eve) see Chapter-8

NOTE: (Abel, Cain's fraternal twin brother, was the son of Adam and Eve)

²⁷ My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me: (Willingly)

²⁸ And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand. (They cannot be deceived by false doctrines because they know the truth)

(perish = to die. Hell is the death of the soul <the second death>) see Revelation-20:14-15

NOTE: (False doctrine tells people that they burn forever in agony. That's a lie. God is merciful. They die quickly, without any pain. They cease to exist. The lake of fire is symbolic only. It just means that their fate is permanent. When you burn something, it cannot be unburned)

²⁹ My Father, which gave them me, is greater than all; and no man is able to pluck them out of my Father's hand. (There is only one God. HE is all powerful)

³⁰ I and my Father are one. Genesis-1:26 (Jesus is God's begotten <God in the flesh>, not His "son". He is God with us – Immanuel) see Isaiah-7:14, John-1:1

(Jesus called Himself "the son of man"; men called Him "the son of God". When Jesus prayed to the Father, He was teaching us who to pray to)

NOTE: (This is the verse that most Christians never understand. I have heard Christians ask – What kind of God would send His own son to be crucified? They never studied the Bible. They listened to the sermons of preachers, instead; so they are ignorant of the truth. The early church invented the "trinity". There is only ONE GOD – He has many offices – the Father <himself>, Jesus <the Savior>, the Holy Spirit <the Comforter>, Melchizedek <the man who walked with Abraham>, the Angel of the Lord <God in angelic form>, etc) Genesis-1:26

³¹ Then the Jews took up stones again to stone him. (This was instigated by Kenites that were mixed into the crowd. Just like Cain, they resort to murder when they are out of arguments)

³² Jesus answered them, Many good works have I shewed you from my Father; for which of those works do ye stone me? (Jesus did not commit any crimes nor did He break any laws. Just the opposite – He did all good works of teaching and healing people)

³³ The Jews answered him, saying, For a good work we stone thee not; but for blasphemy; and because that thou, being a man, makest thyself God. (They never read Isaiah-7:14)

³⁴ Jesus answered them, Is it not written in your law, I said, Ye are gods? (Ye are gods = Ye are god's – bad translation)

(We all belong to God. He owns our souls because He created us)
Psalms-82:6

NOTE: (Ignorant people have started whole new religions from this verse. The saying, properly translated is – We are God's; not we are Gods. It just means that all of our souls belong to God, because he created us) Ezekiel-18:4

³⁵ If he called them gods, unto whom the word of God came, and the scripture cannot be broken;

³⁶ Say ye of him, whom the Father hath sanctified, and sent into the world, Thou blasphemest; because I said, I am the Son of God? (All people are the children of God) Ecclesiastes-12:6-7

NOTE: (Son = begotten; God begat Himself into the flesh as Jesus. By the power of God, we begat ourselves into the flesh; in these flesh bodies. We return into our spiritual bodies when we die) see Ecclesiastes-12:6-8

³⁷ If I do not the works of my Father, believe me not. (Miracles)

³⁸ But if I do, though ye believe not me, believe the works: that ye may know, and believe, that the Father is in me, and I in him. (If you can't believe His words, then believe His miracles. They are undeniable)

³⁹ Therefore they sought again to take him: but he escaped out of their hand, (These people are hopeless. They mean to murder Jesus, no matter what He can prove)

⁴⁰ And went away again beyond Jordan into the place where John at first baptized; and there he abode.

⁴¹ And many resorted unto him, and said, John did no miracle: but all things that John spake of this man were true. (John's witnessing of Jesus bared out and convinced many people)

⁴² And many believed on him there. (The Kenites couldn't stop Jesus' ministry from going forward into the world)
