

1 John 2

King James Version (KJV)

2 My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not. And if any man sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous: (This is about a habitual sinner < in the Greek>; not like a normal sin that we all can commit)

(A habitual sinner doesn't care to stop the sin. They repeat the same sin over and over; thinking that it's OK because they can repent as often as they like. They are taking God for a fool)

² And he is the propitiation for our sins: and not for ours only, but also for the sins of the whole world. (propitiation = the atonement) (To whosoever will believe on Him as our Lord and Savior, and repents for their sins)

³ And hereby we do know that we know him, if we keep his commandments. (Do your best to obey the Ten Commandments and live a good honest life. If you fail, then repent, and get right with God)

⁴ He that saith, I know him, and keepeth not his commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him. (Those who deliberately don't follow the Ten Commandments really don't know God)

(When we fail, repent, receive forgiveness, and go on with your life. Try to do better next time)

⁵ But whoso keepeth his word, in him verily is the love of God perfected: hereby know we that we are in him. (perfected= matured, fully grown – better translation)

⁶ He that saith he abideth in him ought himself also so to walk, even as he walked. (Stay in the light; stay in the Word; do what is right. We all have a conscience to know right from wrong)

⁷ Brethren, I write no new commandment unto you, but an old commandment which ye had from the beginning. The old commandment is the word which ye have heard from the beginning. (God gave Moses the Ten Commandments. Those are God's laws. They never change) Exodus-20

(Jesus said – Love God above all else = Commandments 1-5. Love your neighbor as yourself = Commandments 6-10. HE said – I change

not one jot or tittle of the Law <the Ten Commandments>) see Matthew-5:18

See Ecclesiastes-1:9 (There's nothing new under the sun)

⁸ Again, a new commandment I write unto you, which thing is true in him and in you: because the darkness is past, and the true light now shineth. (Jesus' sacrifice of the crucifixion for us opened salvation to the world. HE defeated death, which is one of Satan's names. That is the New Testament) Hebrews-2:14-15

⁹ He that saith he is in the light, and hateth his brother, is in darkness even until now. (His brother - this is a true brother, of the same womb; not a figurative "brother")

2Thessalonians-3:6-on (tells us how to handle a difficult brother. Don't hate him as Cain hated Abel. If he is impossible to get along with, set him aside and pray for him. Tough love is not hate. Don't be an enabler for someone who does evil)

¹⁰ He that loveth his brother abideth in the light, and there is none occasion of stumbling in him. (Hate can cause us to fail) (The light is Jesus Christ. Obeying His teachings is to be in the light)

¹¹ But he that hateth his brother is in darkness, and walketh in darkness, and knoweth not whither he goeth, because that darkness hath blinded his eyes. (Cain hated Able) (Hate, like anger, is a form of insanity. Hateful or angry people aren't thinking straight)

¹² I write unto you, little children, because your sins are forgiven you for his name's sake. (Jesus is the Savior of the world. When we repent, we are forgiven by the Father, in the name of Jesus <God the Savior; God who walked in the world as a flesh man>)

¹³ I write unto you, fathers, because ye have known him that is from the beginning. I write unto you, young men, because ye have overcome the wicked one. I write unto you, little children, because ye have known the Father. (In these three epistles)

(We were there with God during the First Age. We were in our spiritual bodies, living with God, long before this Age began)

See 2Peter (He speaks of the three Ages)

¹⁴ I have written unto you, fathers, because ye have known him that is from the beginning. I have written unto you, young men, because ye are strong, and the word of God abideth in you, and ye have overcome the wicked one. (In the Gospel of John)

(Satan is working hard even today to temp people into turning away from God. We will see him try again when he shows up as antichrist in the end days of this Age)

Matthew-4 (Satan tempted Jesus twisting Bible scriptures. He is a scripture lawyer. Jesus didn't argue with him, He told him to get lost. That's how we will deal with antichrist in the end days)

NOTE: (Later, John also penned the Book of Revelation)

¹⁵ Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him. (A person can only have one following. The ways of the world are opposite the ways of God. We must choose one or the other)

¹⁶ For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world. (Lust, vanity, envy, greed, pride – these are the ways of the world)

¹⁷ And the world passeth away, and the lust thereof: but he that doeth the will of God abideth for ever. (We will live with God in the eternity, if we choose God; instead of the world)

¹⁸ Little children, it is the last time: and as ye have heard that antichrist shall come, even now are there many antichrists; whereby we know that it is the last time. (The word anti <in the Greek> means instead of. Satan will come first at the 6th Trump, instead of Christ. He will deceive the whole world into worshipping him. Christ will come afterwards, at the 7th Trump) see Matthew-24:24

NOTE: (This verse should be enough to convince people that the rapture is a false doctrine. No one is flying away first. The antichrist will come first. We will be here on the earth to be witnesses for God before the whole world) also see Mark-13:5-6, Luke-21

¹⁹ They went out from us, but they were not of us; for if they had been of us, they would no doubt have continued with us: but they went out, that they might be made manifest that they were not all of us. (These are the Kenites – the sons of Cain) John-8:44-47

²⁰ But ye have an unction from the Holy One, and ye know all things.
(an unction= charisma = a gift from God) (ye know all things – you have a conscience to intuitively discern good from evil)

²¹ I have not written unto you because ye know not the truth, but because ye know it, and that no lie is of the truth. (Jesus said – you shall know the truth and the truth will set you free) John-8:32

John-8:44-47 (Jesus dresses down the Kenites. They pretend to be Jews, even today. They are not. They re the descendants of Cain – the son of Satan and Eve)

1Samuel-15:6 (The Kenites infiltrated Israel long before Jesus came into the world. They eventually became Israel's scribes – their accountants, book keepers and record keepers)

²² Who is a liar but he that denieth that Jesus is the Christ? He is antichrist, that denieth the Father and the Son. (To stand against the truth is to be a liar. It's really that simple)

²³ Whosoever denieth the Son, the same hath not the Father: he that acknowledgeth the Son hath the Father also. (The Father and the Son are one God, in two different forms. You can't have one without the other. There is only one God. He has many offices)

(Jesus said – If you've seen me, you've seen the Father) John-14:9

Isaiah-7:14 (Immanuel = God with us – that is Jesus Christ)

²⁴ Let that therefore abide in you, which ye have heard from the beginning. If that which ye have heard from the beginning shall remain in you, ye also shall continue in the Son, and in the Father.

(Spiritually - From the beginning - not by a verse here and there, out of context; but by the complete Word of God, chapter by chapter, verse by verse, beginning to end)

(Physically – We existed in the First Age; we are here in the Second Age; and will continue in the Third Age <if we pass on judgment day>)

²⁵ And this is the promise that he hath promised us, even eternal life. (If we choose to follow God, instead of the world)

²⁶ These things have I written unto you concerning them that seduce you. (False teachers, the fallen angels, the Kenites, antichrist)

See 2Corinthians-11:1-3 (Paul spelled it out in plain writing. Satan wholly seduced Eve to produce Cain <his son; the first of the Kenites>) (Beguiled = wholly seduced <Greek>)

(God said to Eve – I will multiply thy conception – Cain and Abel were fraternal twins. Cain from Satan, Abel from Adam) Genesis-3:16

(That's why Cain's genealogy is in a different chapter than Adam's genealogy. Cain was not Adam's son. Abel & Seth were Adam's sons)

²⁷ But the anointing which ye have received of him abideth in you, and ye need not that any man teach you: but as the same anointing teacheth you of all things, and is truth, and is no lie, and even as it hath taught you, ye shall abide in him. (When we will be delivered to testify against antichrist, God will teach us in that moment, what we will say. HE will speak through the Elect) Mark-13:9-11

²⁸ And now, little children, abide in him; that, when he shall appear, we may have confidence, and not be ashamed before him at his coming. (Do not let the evil ones seduce you before Jesus returns. Prepare now, in order to be ready and well taught when Jesus returns as Messiah)

²⁹ If ye know that he is righteous, ye know that every one that doeth righteousness is born of him. (To be a Christian is to try to live righteously, as Jesus did)
